Lewis has had given me a couple pairs of his shoes and his wallet, and I spoke to her on the phone, and she indicated that those items would be fine.

I'm going to find Norman.

Reneer uses a paranormal technique called psychometry by handling some of Norman Lewis's personal effects.

228

Reneer believes she can tap into residual psychic energy that will lead her to Norman.

229

Numbers, 21, I feel miles.

230

00:25:14,000 --> 00:25:21,000

She gave us the numbers, uh, four, five, two one and two two. I remember those three specifically.

231

I see brick. I don't know what it's associated with, but I just feel the brick very strong.

232

It appears to be a bridge.

233

00:25:32,000 --> 00:25:43,000

I feel metal around me.

I feel plants.

235

Um, she talked about railroad tracks.

I'm driving for a short distance, and then something happens, and I see him in the air going downward.

It should be very simple. There's railroad tracks, the bricks, there's a bridge.

238

I'm seeing from above, and it looks like there's branches or trees or something below there.

239

Investigator Hewitt put all of Reneer's clues together, used some gut instinct of his own, and came up with one word, quarry.

He was spending a lot of time, I think, going out and checking the quarries or limerock pits to see if he could get the one that seemed more logical.

241

And he was, I don't know what all he was doing, bless his heart. He'd be out there in the brambles and whatever.

I was wondering if he didn't get hurt himself.

I walked around probably 30 quarries, climbed up and down cliffs, and cut my way through growth, and it was quite an adventure.

included, would have said, alright, we tried, but Brian wasn't that way.

And that's when Brian came up and told us that they'd found the truck and asked him, is he in it? And he said, yeah.

It was a sad day because, you know, obviously, Norman was deceased, but on the upside it was finally over.

He could get a decent burial and the family could go on with their lives. And we could kind of close it out and basically go on with ours.

Two years after he had disappeared, Norman could finally be laid to rest.

256

The Williston police had used Noreen Reneer's clues of bricks, abandoned railroad tracks and a bridge to pinpoint the quarry where Norman had drowned in his truck.

257

And what of the numbers that Reneer divined? 45, 21, 22. It turns out that the quarry where Norman was found is located just off state route 45.

258

His truck was found exactly 2.1 miles from his front door. And finally the calendar date on Norman's diving watch was stopped on the number 22.

259

The Williston police department invited Noreen Reneer to work on the Norman Lewis case because they had nothing to lose.

269

The sightings began early on the morning of January 20th, 1996. Pacaccini rushed to Varginha in eastern Brazil, where he took testimony from candle-writer Eurico Rodriguez de Fritas.

270

De Fritas claimed that he had seen a large and seemingly damaged saucer hovering at treetop level. It had panicked his herd.

271

A noise was made by the cattle and it got my attention. It was 1 a.m. and the object passed through here.

So what exactly did you see? Tell me the details. Details? Well, it was covered with smoke. It was a big object about the size of a small bus and it hovered for 40 minutes about 5 meters off the ground.

Pacaccini tried to corroborate De Fritas' account and found more eyewitnesses, including the mayor of a neighboring town.

274

It was an object almost the same size of a small bus. It was rectangular. I could see it had 5 lights. It was almost at the top of that eucalyptus tree.

275

There were also reports that the local fire department had been called out to investigate the appearance of a strange, humanoid creature on the outskirts of town.

Varsina's fire department is also its animal control agency and routinely rounds up all kinds of wild animals that stray into populated areas.

They got really scared. They thought it could be the devil.

So I was really worried and I went to meet with them.

I was on holiday. What I know is what you know.

However, Paccacini claims that a high-ranking member of the military told him off the record

303

that an alien creature was taken into custody.

They took it to Humanitas Hospital.

305

Many different doctors, over 15 of them, were in that place.

306

Intelligence people from the army, you know, that creature had this horrible smell.

307

One of the doctors came over and, you know, grabbed the creature's chin like this,

308

opened that little slit, and using tweezers, he grabbed the tongue and pulled it out a little bit.

309

It looked like a black ribbon, like some lizard, a tongue or something like that.

310

Many people saw that. We have the statements recorded.

311

And then he released this and it went back immediately.

According to this same anonymous source, at least two humanoid beings were captured

Paccacini claims his source told him that Brazil was not the only government

One of the military witnesses indicated that the United States government

not only alerted the Brazilian military that this object was coming down,

but that several American officials had showed up and were on the scene to help direct process

secretly.

320

I was quite impressed with the depth of investigation done by Mr. Paccacini.

321
