The perception most of us have of ghosts was manufactured in Hollywood,

One of Hollywood's most recent attempts at treating the paranormal in a more sophisticated fashion

resulted in the surprise blockbuster Ghost.

TV and movies are chock-full of eerie and eye-opening effects,

and you'll share the real-life experiences of people who have witnessed apparitions, hauntings, and poltergeists.

They were ordinary people leading ordinary lives until they were touched by an unexplainable force.

And obviously, it frightened me, though I just stood there and looked at it and it disappeared into the wall.

I saw a silhouette of somebody watching my room.

From this farmhouse all the way to the White House, we have a fascination with ghosts.

The search for photographic evidence has produced many hoaxes, but a handful of pictures defy explanation.

Startling images, spectral apparitions, are these people from the past trying to make contact with the present?

There is a lot of fraud in this, there is a lot of imagination, there is a lot of wishful thinking,

but when you strip that all out, there is about 20% hardcore stuff that is exceedingly difficult to explain.

Within that 20% haunted longleaf castle in England.

In 1965, a film crew in search of a ghost set up an infrared movie camera.

After hundreds of hours of filming, they captured this extremely rare moment,

a light emerging from one door and disappearing into another.

All the lighting conditions were controlled, the windows were blacked out,

57

there was no possibility of moonlight or car headlight, so anything coming through.

When we saw the stuff later, there was this shaft of light, which to me is completely unexplainable.

And indeed, this paranormal phenomenon has remained unexplained for 35 years.

This New Orleans mansion's haunted history is chronicled in diaries written over 100 years ago.

The family that originally lived here buried their dead infant in the wall of the nursery.

The ghost of that baby's nanny is said to haunt the house to this day,

63

a benevolent spirit watching over the people who live here now.

I've had dinner parties since she'd walked through the room, everybody at the dinner table would see her.

65

She just ignores you, she just walks through us, oh no one's there.

66

She never looks at you, nothing's just walks through.

67

But there's a darker side to the hauntings here.

68

Other ghosts who the residents say are not kind but malevolent.

Two family dogs, a male and a female, have been recent victims.

and the male was dead in the cellarium.

No marks or anything else, he was just dead.

But there was obvious signs of them trying to get out,

Something had frightened them to that point of mass hysteria.

When the apparition resembles somebody who used to live in the house,

and the only way is that it's just energy recorded in the environment

80

that gets played back by our brains, kind of acting like a needle on a phonograph.

And perhaps that's what may be happening on this abandoned aircraft carrier, the USS Cabot.

82

The ghostly forms of crewmen who met with violent death in World War II have been seen again and again.

One witness who had a chilling encounter on board was Jill Alexander.

When I turned, I was looking at a man in a uniform.

85

It was an incredible feeling, and I couldn't speak, I couldn't move,

86

and my friend kept pulling me to go up the stairs, and I said,

87

Barry, you're going to think I'm crazy, but I think I'm looking at a ghost.

88

And when I said that, he just took off with me and we flew down the boat.

89

The evidence we have is as strong as the witnesses that we have.

90

You have to take a look, start taking a look at witness testimony.

Now, many people in social science will say that a human witness is not a good witness,

And interestingly, the one place where ghosts have been proven to exist is in a court of law.

When Jeff and Patrice Stambofsky bought this house in NIAC, New York,

95

the owner didn't tell them her house was haunted.

96

Two weeks after buying the house, they wanted out.

97

They sued to get their money back, and a New York appellate court ruled in their favor.

98

They scared me. I can't live in any place that someone's telling me that it's haunted

99

00:08:30,000 --> 00:08:35,000

and ghosts leave things around for people and close doors and shake beds and things.

100

In New York State, there really is not a disclosure law for the seller.

101

It's about beware. And when you buy a house and there's something wrong,

102

if you haven't checked it out, then that has to be your responsibility.

103

In this case, clearly, ghosts fall into a different category.

104

The owner had claimed for years that her house was haunted, and that was proof enough for the court.

105

Their definition of a haunted house is, if the owner says it's haunted, then it's haunted.

106

She can't come back to court to dispute that fact later on.

107

So to my knowledge, it is America's only legally haunted house.

108

Coming up next, an average American family that claims their home is haunted

109

by the ghostly victims of a murder suicide.

I haven't been alone in the house since that time.

111

By and large, people who believe that they've encountered a ghost are frightened.

So beyond gathering evidence, a critical role for the ghost investigator is crisis counselor

113

to reassure people that they're not losing their sanity.

You're about to meet a typical American family, their ordinary people, caught in the grips of an extraordinary situation.

115

In 1985, the Brown family purchased this Victorian-era home in Portland, Oregon.

116

It seemed to be a perfect place to raise a young family.

117

When we first moved into the house, I got this strange feeling like we were never alone.

118

00:10:02,000 --> 00:10:05,000

Perhaps the eerie history of the house played a role.

119

In 1973, the house was the scene of a grisly murder suicide.

120

00:10:09,000 --> 00:10:14,000

A distraught husband shot and killed his wife, and then turned the gun on himself,

121

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:18,000

a crime of passion that left their five children orphans.

122

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:23,000

I decided, okay, it happened. We'll just forget about it.

123

00:10:23,000 --> 00:10:28,000

Then when things started happening, I started really wondering, was it them?

124

00:10:28,000 --> 00:10:31,000

It had to have been them, a husband and a wife.

125

At first, the disturbances were minor, lights going on and off,

126

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:41,000

trouble with the VCR and electrical outlets, occurrences easily dismissed as typical in an old house.

127

But no one could dismiss what daughter Cassie saw.

128

Two apparitions, a woman tucking Cassie's blankets into the bed

129

00:10:48,000 --> 00:10:51,000

and a strange man lurking in the background.

130

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:55,000

There was a guy standing by the door.

131

00:10:55,000 --> 00:11:01,000

I was really sort of afraid of him because he did nothing.

132

00:11:01,000 --> 00:11:05,000

He just stood there like he was watching.

133

00:11:05,000 --> 00:11:10,000

Her tuck me in or something.

134

00:11:10,000 --> 00:11:16,000

After the third time, her coming to me with the lady tucking her in,

135

00:11:16,000 --> 00:11:22,000

I decided to kind of check while they're asleep, check their beds to see.

136

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:26,000

And it was, it was tucked in between the mattresses. I don't do that.

137

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:31,000

It sounds like that what's being reported are figures that interact.

138

00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:34,000

They are therefore seemingly self-conscious, self-aware,

139

00:11:34,000 --> 00:11:38,000

which would be replaced them in the category of apparitions or ghosts.

140

Initially, Caroline wondered if it was all in her head.

141

00:11:41,000 --> 00:11:45,000

I didn't understand why this was going on.

142

00:11:45,000 --> 00:11:50,000

It was kind of confusing. You know, you try to look for the logical explanations.

143

00:11:50,000 --> 00:11:57,000

And so to me, it had to have been me, even though it was something I didn't do.

144

00:11:57,000 --> 00:12:01,000

And then when I started really paying attention and watching, I knew I wasn't doing it.

145

00:12:01,000 --> 00:12:04,000

And I knew no one else was doing it.

146

00:12:04,000 --> 00:12:09,000

Since 1985, the Browns have experienced over two dozen ghostly episodes.

147

00:12:09,000 --> 00:12:12,000

Footsteps, voices, flying objects.

148

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:17,000

Once a space heater was mysteriously plugged in and turned on to warm the children.

149

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:20,000

Family Pets refused to stay inside when no one's home.

150

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:27,000

The family says much of the haunting occurs on or around the anniversary of the murder suicide, December the 23rd.

151

00:12:27,000 --> 00:12:33,000

I went down to the landing and I saw someone by the Christmas tree.

152

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:39,000

And I thought it was Santa, so I jumped up and slapped my hands.

153

00:12:39,000 --> 00:12:45,000

And they turned around and it surprised me.

154

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:52,000

And they disappeared somehow. I don't know.

155

00:12:53,000 --> 00:12:57,000

The hall lights always left on for the kids and everything.

156

00:12:57,000 --> 00:12:59,000

And my door was left open a little bit.

157

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:05,000

I woke up and I saw a silhouette of a man coming towards me.

158

00:13:05,000 --> 00:13:11,000

My first thought is intruder. I got to get the light on, get the guns. I had to react.

159

00:13:11,000 --> 00:13:18,000

So I'm watching. I'm watching this and we have the lights that have the rope down from the ceiling.

160

00:13:18,000 --> 00:13:24,000

So I'm scrambling, looking for that, keeping this sight, you know, this person in sight,

161

00:13:24,000 --> 00:13:30,000

ready to fight, ready to do anything I needed to do. Got the light on. It was gone.

162

00:13:30,000 --> 00:13:34,000

The incidents in the house have not been limited to the immediate family.

163

00:13:34,000 --> 00:13:40,000

I was on the second floor cleaning and I was to take some boxes of excess toys up to the third floor.

164

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:45,000

I was sleeping on the couch. I think it was like a kitty corner from the door.

165

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:51,000

I was upstairs. A kid had taken the two children to school and there was no one in the house.

166

00:13:51,000 --> 00:13:55,000

I heard a woman shriek. I heard shouting that woke me up.

167

00:13:55,000 --> 00:14:00,000

I heard the footsteps, fairly heavy ones going upstairs to the third floor.

168

00:14:00,000 --> 00:14:06,000

And then there was some movement on top of a box that was already sitting there on the floor.

169

00:14:06,000 --> 00:14:11,000

I saw the silhouette of a man and a woman.

170

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:14,000

I haven't been alone in the house since that time.

171

00:14:14,000 --> 00:14:19,000

It was hard for me to, you know, accept because it was so real.

172

00:14:19,000 --> 00:14:22,000

You know, when you're so positive someone is there.

173

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:24,000

I know I'm.

174

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:27,000

I know I'm very unusual.

175

00:14:27,000 --> 00:14:31,000

But for all the occurrences, the family has never really felt threatened.

176

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:35,000

Nothing's happened that's been real negative.

177

00:14:35,000 --> 00:14:42,000

It's been nerve-wracking. But anything that's happened to the kids has been positive.

178

00:14:42,000 --> 00:14:48,000

It's like taking care, you know, making sure watching over them.

179

00:14:48,000 --> 00:14:54,000

Me, it, even though you get nervous, you just decide, hey, this is my house.

180

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:58,000

I want to live here and you deal with it.

181

00:14:58,000 --> 00:15:03,000

Lloyd Auerbach is the co-founder of the Office of Paranormal Investigations.

182

00:15:03,000 --> 00:15:07,000

He specializes in helping families through haunting situations.

183

00:15:07,000 --> 00:15:09,000

And he recently investigated this case.

184

00:15:09,000 --> 00:15:12,000

This is a real interesting case because the sheer number of witnesses that we have,

185

00:15:12,000 --> 00:15:15,000

the testimony from them seems very good.

186

The folks are very, very normal.

187

00:15:17,000 --> 00:15:20,000

And I like their attitude that, you know, they've been a little uncomfortable,

188

00:15:20,000 --> 00:15:26,000

but they're living with it and are taking control that they have really done all the right things

189

00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:30,000

without us even being here to begin with, just intuitively.

190

00:15:30,000 --> 00:15:33,000

Caroline's first instinct was to comfort her children

191

00:15:33,000 --> 00:15:37,000

and to try to eliminate the anxiety that comes with the unknown.

192

00:15:37,000 --> 00:15:42,000

What Cassie does to deal with her fear, we have Bales hanging up.

193

00:15:42,000 --> 00:15:45,000

She rings this before climbing into bed.

194

00:15:45,000 --> 00:15:52,000

Then she comes up here, rings this bell.

195

00:15:52,000 --> 00:15:57,000

With the children, Auerbach stresses the importance of treating the haunting as a game.

196

00:15:57,000 --> 00:15:59,000

Special toys can help alleviate fears.

197

00:15:59,000 --> 00:16:03,000

Caroline has devised her own combination of lavender and water

198

00:16:03,000 --> 00:16:05,000

that Cassie can use to fend off ghosts.

199

00:16:05,000 --> 00:16:08,000

It's important to set ground rules both with the ghosts,

200

00:16:08,000 --> 00:16:12,000

but certainly with the kids so they understand how to deal with ghosts.

201

00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:14,000

Yeah, well, I've told the ghosts.

202

00:16:14,000 --> 00:16:20,000

In fact, it was the last time that Cassie had seen him, the man in our room.

203

00:16:20,000 --> 00:16:22,000

The next day I got up and I walked around saying,

204

00:16:22,000 --> 00:16:24,000

you will not show yourselves to the kids.

205

00:16:24,000 --> 00:16:27,000

You will not do any pranks around the kids.

206

00:16:27,000 --> 00:16:29,000

You will not scare them.

207

00:16:29,000 --> 00:16:32,000

I think that with a situation with a murder, suicide,

208

00:16:32,000 --> 00:16:35,000

you have obviously heavy emotion that's put into play here.

209

00:16:35,000 --> 00:16:37,000

If we're dealing with apparitions in this case,

210

00:16:37,000 --> 00:16:39,000

where they're a little self-conscious and self-aware,

211

00:16:39,000 --> 00:16:42,000

the reasons why they're staying around are their reasons.

212

00:16:42,000 --> 00:16:45,000

They're not because they died in a murder suicide.

213

00:16:45,000 --> 00:16:49,000

I feel like the couple is somehow grounded here.

214

00:16:49,000 --> 00:16:51,000

I'm not an expert. I don't know.

215

00:16:51,000 --> 00:16:57,000

I can just guess they like being with the kids, I think.

216

00:16:57,000 --> 00:16:59,000

I feel like maybe they miss their own kids.

217

00:16:59,000 --> 00:17:04,000

That's, you know, a lot of kids to leave behind.

218

00:17:04,000 --> 00:17:09,000

And somehow they feel a little bit more comforted maybe, being with mine.

219

00:17:09,000 --> 00:17:13,000

We're a family and I think they like family atmosphere.

220

00:17:13,000 --> 00:17:16,000

Whether they're really ghosts there or not, this taking control,

221

00:17:16,000 --> 00:17:20,000

this responsibility issue on the part of the living family that's there, has worked.

222

00:17:20,000 --> 00:17:25,000

We can't prove from the perspective of we can't point a meter at these ghosts

223

00:17:25,000 --> 00:17:27,000

and say that they're there.

224

00:17:27,000 --> 00:17:32,000

We can't say that the subjective experience of the family has been dealt with

225

00:17:32,000 --> 00:17:37,000

in a way that makes them feel comfortable and that resolves to the point that they want.

226

00:17:37,000 --> 00:17:42,000

When you're going through it, it'll make a believer out of you.

227

00:17:42,000 --> 00:17:46,000

When you have all these unexplainable things and you start seeing figures,

228

00:17:46,000 --> 00:17:50,000

you change your mind real quick.

229

Coming up next, researchers who claim they have contacted the dead

230

and captured voices from beyond.

231

In the past, people tried to make contact with ghosts through mediums and spiritualists

232

and seances that were often clearly frauds.

Today, investigators are taking a much more high-tech approach.

A worldwide organization of over 300 researchers is now working in the area of EVP,

235

an electronic voice phenomena where voices supposedly from ghosts

236

have been imprinted directly on audio recording tape.

237

Please try to speak, please try to give us a message.

238

Please tell me who is here.

239

Please try to give us your name.

According to parish records, many of the people entombed here met a violent death.

When Sarah E. Step came to the catacombs, she recorded these voices.

The catacombs are recorded in the same place.

I was here a few years ago, and I picked up the message.

We leave the soul right down here.

Point Lookout Light stands on an open promontory on the western shore of the Chesapeake Bay.

Many instances of paranormal phenomena have been reported in this desolate place,

events that may reflect the area's tragic past.

274

During the Civil War, 50,000 Confederate prisoners captured at Gettysburg were held here.

275

Forced to endure freezing cold, disease and starvation, thousands died

276

and were buried in mass graves near the lighthouse.

277

The prisoners were brought here largely by steamboats and were made to walk along the sandy beach

278

up to Fort Lincoln where they were then turned inland and marched to the prison pen.

Over 50,000 Confederate prisoners made this march and over 4,000 of them,

it was the last march they made since they died. Prisons of the war.

When I was driving, I saw a figure of a man dressed in long pants and a gray coat run across the road behind me.

It was actually where many thousands of the Confederate soldiers were actually buried.

290

I immediately returned and when I got to where I'd seen him across the road,

291

Electronic voice phenomena has been recorded in several locations inside the lighthouse.

The basement seems to be the focus of this activity.

300

Some scientists believe EVP may be caused by the researchers themselves

imprinting on the tape through psychokinesis or as the result of electronic interference.

It was later popularized in a book and a film called The Entity.

But what the real investigators found when they met the victim of the hunting,

318

was more bizarre and more compelling than any movie.

When I went over to her house, we conducted about a two hour interview.

And during that time, she told us a lot of interesting experiences, but I knew she was holding something back.

And at the end of the interview, she finally admitted to us that she was attacked and raped by the ghost.

322

At that time, we thought she was probably crazy.

323

The events that then transpired over the next 10 weeks were chronicled in the Journal of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers.

Including the night, the investigators went from being skeptics to true believers.

The lady screamed out, it's in my bedroom. We ran in there. She shouted out, it's over in the corner.

We fired our Polaroid camera in the direction that she said. We didn't see anything, but the picture came out bleached out white completely.

She shouted out again, it's in the corner. Again, we fired our camera and it was bleached out completely.

At that point, I thought the camera was just malfunctioning. I waited till she said it was gone and I took two control pictures.

Those pictures are perfectly normal pictures.

Even with these pictures, Gaynor still had trouble convincing his colleagues at UCLA that he was on to something significant.

And they would say, well, then it's obviously mass hallucination.

Gaynor returned to the house a number of times, bringing more witnesses with him. And the eerie

phenomenon became even more pronounced.

And I started seeing balls of light lighting up the walls. And everybody in the room would see this.

And the lights would get bigger and bigger and brighter and brighter. And at some point I finally started talking to it.

And I said, well, if you're really here, come off the wall. Because what I was concerned was that somebody in the room was faking it.

Well, when I asked that question, the light lifted off the wall, floated into the middle of our room, started spinning and twisting and expanding in different directions simultaneously.

It had full parallax. We could see it from all sides. And I had nine professional photographers set up in the room that were shooting it from all sides.

And it came in, I kind of did a little thing in the group and then it was gone.

It was the most extraordinary thing we've ever come across. It happened over and over again. We experienced a plethora of phenomena during that investigation.

The part that interested me the most was the fact that what we saw, we were able to get on film.

The photographers at that session had only limited success capturing the entity on film, with one notable exception.

What we see here are reverse arcs of light. One arc goes right here, another arc goes right here.

357

Now, the reason this picture is so important to us is that the arc on the wall, if it were really on the wall, would be bent.

Because those two walls there are perpendicular. It's not bent, which means the arc is floating in space.

The significance of that for us as researchers is, of course, that that means it's dimensional and very, very difficult to fake.

This was not somebody with a flashlight shining it on a wall. That light is in empty space.

The negative of this photo was authenticated by popular photography and was the only alleged ghost photo ever published in the magazine.

Frank DeFelida, the author of Audrey Rose, was also witness to the phenomena.

His incredible first-hand experience in the Culver City, California house, inspired him to write The Entity, which was later made into a motion picture.

All the instruments started clicking away. So I knew everyone was seeing this at the same time that I was.

365

And we were ducking and everyone was saying, oh my God, oh my God, look at that, oh my God.

366

And then Dara started screaming. That was the woman who was being belabored by this creature.

367

So I was screaming, I don't want to see your lights. Show us yourself. Damn you.

368

Show us yourself. So I was cursing and swearing at it. And there, lo and behold, at that point, it

started to appear.

It sort of developed a kind of, a kind of arm was articulated. You could see sort of like an arm and then a neck.

And then of all things, a kind of bald head. Now this could have been our imagination, but collectively we saw the same thing.

Every one of us, we saw the same thing.

We don't consider our pictures proof of anything. We consider them part of the struggle to gather evidence to try to understand this phenomenon.

During our investigations, we spend thousands of hours trying to be in the right place at the right time.

In the entity case, for some reason we were there. We were there at the right time.

375

And we were experiencing the phenomena over and over again. Although some of the people there found it frightening,

376

I found it very exciting and exhilarating. That's what I'm in this for.

377

It's an opportunity to witness things that we've been taught all our life cannot be. It's a connection with the unknown.

378

Traditionally, a haunting is associated with a place, but investigators in the entity case always suspected that this haunting was somehow connected to the woman herself.

379

And in fact, when she fled the house, the entity went with her.

For five years, the haunting diminished gradually and is now completely disappeared.

When we return, a team of paranormal experts stalk ghostly apparitions in a special investigation.

And a man who claims to have contacted his dead child with his video camera and recorded it on tape.

The study of ghost phenomena is still in its most primitive stages.

Trying to gather data that will conclusively prove the existence of ghosts as a time-consuming and usually unsuccessful process,

often carried out in the shadow of disdain from the scientific mainstream.

How exactly do ghost investigators conduct their research?

387

Now, we'll take a look at the anatomy of a ghost investigation.

We'll follow one from the beginning to the end.

The investigation site is a Japanese restaurant in Georgia where customers and employees report frightening, unexplained phenomena.

390

There would be a lot of weird noises at night, footsteps, people would see things or lights would flash.

391

00:33:20,000 --> 00:33:26,000

There's certain areas in the restaurant that just kind of give you the creeps, you know, make your hair stand up.

392

00:33:26,000 --> 00:33:34,000

There's a place back in the back part of this area that is just kind of an ominous feeling where you just feel like you can't breathe.

393

00:33:34,000 --> 00:33:37,000

The air is real heavy and nobody wants to go back there.

394

00:33:37,000 --> 00:33:42,000

I mean, we even have a few chefs that when they have to go past the area, they run.

395

00:33:43,000 --> 00:33:50,000

You'll see somebody like at a corner and they just barely see them and they'll be turning walking away from you.

396

00:33:50,000 --> 00:33:56,000

And you'll think it's your friend or somebody and you'll call out their name and go over and talk to them or something and they won't be there.

397

One morning I was downstairs getting ready to open and I saw someone come down the hallway.

398

00:34:02,000 --> 00:34:08,000

I thought it was the manager at first and I said good morning and nobody answered and I thought it was strange.

399

I looked up and whoever it was just took two steps and was gone.

400

00:34:11,000 --> 00:34:20,000

At a loss to explain these eerie occurrences, the restaurant management contacted Dr. William Rawl, one of this country's foremost parapsychologists.

401

They were having disturbances that resulted in their employees leaving and their customers asking questions.

402

00:34:30,000 --> 00:34:34,000

They were seeing apparitions essentially.

403

00:34:34,000 --> 00:34:42,000

So it's a unique opportunity for us because as a haunting case, it's a sort of strong case.

404

00:34:42,000 --> 00:34:45,000

There was some definite phenomena according to witnesses.

405

00:34:45,000 --> 00:34:51,000

To investigate the restaurant haunting, Dr. Rawl brings together a team of well-respected paranormal investigators,

406

00:34:51,000 --> 00:34:55,000

each an expert in a different area of scientific inquiry.

407

00:34:55,000 --> 00:35:01,000

Dr. Michaelene Mayer, a pioneer in statistical analysis of psychic investigations.

408

00:35:02,000 --> 00:35:06,000

Christopher Chacon, co-founder of the Office of Paranormal Investigations.

409

00:35:06,000 --> 00:35:10,000

He brings a battery of high-tech instrumentation to the site.

410

00:35:10,000 --> 00:35:12,000

And psychic, Daniel Brinkley.

411

00:35:12,000 --> 00:35:17,000

Dr. Rawl believes Brinkley may have a gift for making contact with apparitions.

412

00:35:17,000 --> 00:35:28,000

Since most of the apparitions have been cited at night, the team agrees that an overnight surveillance will be the most productive way to utilize their diverse talents and equipment.

413

00:35:28,000 --> 00:35:33,000

This all-night vigil is preceded by days of information gathering.

414

00:35:33,000 --> 00:35:41,000

As in any investigation, the first step is interviewing the witnesses, in this case the workers who have seen the apparition.

415

00:35:41,000 --> 00:35:45,000

Then Dr. Mayer has them indicate on a floor plan where they saw them.

416

00:35:45,000 --> 00:35:50,000

She next brings in psychics who try to sense the presence of paranormal activity.

417

00:35:50,000 --> 00:35:57,000

Some people, psychics, and sensitives believe in ghosts, believe that they can experience these ghosts.

418

00:35:57,000 --> 00:36:11,000

And indeed, when we have these people walk through a site where a ghost has been reported, often, not always of course, but often, they're able to pick up on the very sites where something paranormal has been previously reported.

419

00:36:11,000 --> 00:36:21,000

By correlating the responses of the workers and the psychics, Dr. Mayer hopes to pinpoint the paranormal hotspots the team should concentrate on.

420

00:36:21,000 --> 00:36:28,000

Christopher Chacon's first step is to take baseline readings throughout the restaurant when no apparition is present.

421

00:36:28,000 --> 00:36:36,000

That way, he'll know if any changes in electromagnetism, atmosphere, or light do occur that could be associated with a ghost sighting.

422

00:36:36,000 --> 00:36:46,000

The idea is to monitor the environment. And that's all the equipment can do. It cannot theoretically pick up the existence of some entity.

423

00:36:46,000 --> 00:36:56,000

Since there's no way we really know how to measure the phenomena, perhaps if we were to look at the environment, we might be able to pick up something out of the ordinary.

424

00:36:56,000 --> 00:37:05,000

A good analogy might be, we're not really monitoring the person who's walking on a beach. We're looking at the footprints left on the beach after the person walks by.

425

00:37:05,000 --> 00:37:17,000

Since no one knows how, or even if, apparitions affect the physical environment, Chacon uses equipment from many different scientific disciplines, including chemistry, physics, and meteorology.

426

00:37:17,000 --> 00:37:29,000

With the hygromograph, we could utilize this instrument along with individuals who might feel a sensation if they in fact feel a cold spot or even a warmth feeling and it's not something subjective.

427

00:37:29,000 --> 00:37:39,000

It should in fact also be picked up by the instrument. The Intevac 9-10 Vision goggles will help me monitor the instruments I'll be using in total darkness.

428

00:37:39,000 --> 00:37:49,000

And it might be actually in fact possible to pick up an anomaly through the goggles because of the technology that is being utilized.

429

00:37:49,000 --> 00:38:01,000

For Dr. William Rohl, the most important piece of equipment may be a magnetometer, he believes that there may be a connection between magnetic fields and human ability to experience apparitions.

430

00:38:01,000 --> 00:38:11,000

He theorizes that electromagnetic changes affect certain super sensitive people and that this sensitivity allows them to experience the paranormal.

431

00:38:11,000 --> 00:38:24,000

The investigation begins at nightfall. The first few hours yield nothing, but then Christopher Chacon begins picking up high electromagnetic readings in and around one hallway.

432

00:38:24,000 --> 00:38:32,000

Michael E. Mayer independently confirms his readings. Her statistical analysis has already pinpointed this same hallway.

433

00:38:33,000 --> 00:38:44,000

As psychic Daniel Brinkley walks through the restaurant, he too records his strongest psychic impressions in the same hallway Mayer and Chacon have already pinpointed.

434

00:38:44,000 --> 00:38:53,000

The findings of the three team members are further confirmed by a former manager of the restaurant who witnessed apparitions in this hallway on numerous occasions.

435

00:38:53,000 --> 00:38:58,000

When asked to return to the site with Brinkley, he's reluctant, but agrees.

436

00:38:58,000 --> 00:39:05,000

And you said, I always see him here staring at me. Do we feel him?

437

00:39:05,000 --> 00:39:17,000

Unexpectedly, he feels the presence of an apparition at that moment. And at the same time, the monitor in equipment is picking up even higher levels of electromagnetism.

438

00:39:17,000 --> 00:39:31,000

Although no apparition appears that night, the fact that each of the researchers has been independently led to the identical spot using different investigative techniques is considered a victory for Dr. Roll's magnetic field theory.

439

00:39:31,000 --> 00:39:49,000

The areas where the ghosts were experienced were associated with higher magnetic fields. It seems possible that the witnesses may have been sensitive to such fields.

440

00:39:49,000 --> 00:39:55,000

All in all, the investigative team has been encouraged by the advances made this night.

441
