A CE2 includes physical evidence left behind. And the third kind, or CE3, describes face-to-face encounters.

A few years ago, ufologists added CE4 to describe reported alien abductions of humans.

And now there's a new category, close encounters of the fifth kind, CE5, in which humans and aliens actively communicate with each other through light and sound.

The Center for the Study of Extraterrestrial Life, or CSETI, is pioneering the study of CE5s. Dr. Stephen Greer is CSETI's director.

121

A close encounter of the fifth kind is a term that we have coined to describe humans deliberately attempting to vector a spacecraft into an area with the intention of interacting with it.

122

00:12:27,500 --> 00:12:42,500

Most encounters in all the other categories are passive. In a CE5, we take the initiative to communicate in some fashion, whether it be with sound or light or thought, to try and get a response.

123

00:12:42,500 --> 00:12:46,500

Rather than just being passive observers, we want to interact.

124

00:12:46,500 --> 00:13:02,500

And some of these are sometimes quite serendipitous. For example, an individual might be out at night driving along a highway and see an extraterrestrial spacecraft or a UFO, and we'll take the initiative to get a flashlight and begin to signal to it.

125

And many times, it will come over and then signal back.

126

00:13:05,500 --> 00:13:19,500

The purpose of our work is for peaceful communication, mutual respect. We absolutely assume non-hostility on the part of any visitors until it's proven to us beyond a shadow of a doubt.

127

In their field research, CSETI has developed a specific set of protocols for initiating contact with alien spacecraft. Their goal is a successful CE5.

128

The different methods of initiating a CE5 include using sound, which are at this point we're using anomalous sounds that were recorded inside of crop circles in England.

129

We use light. When we go out into the field, we go with half million candle power halogen lights that are portable.

130

00:13:49,500 --> 00:14:08,500

The lights are used signaling to the UFO, either in a series of flashes or by drawing shapes in the sky, usually a large triangle or large circle. It's meant to encourage the UFO to participate and to interact with the project.

131

We also use thought in the form of meditative thought or thought projection. We call it coherent thought sequencing.

132

00:14:16,500 --> 00:14:30,500

So we are using these, what we call the contact trilogy, in a protocol fashion with the express intention of a boarding party, a CSETI train boarding party, going on board and having a meeting with these visitors.

133

In the spring of 1992, Dr. Greer took a CSETI group to one UFO hotspot, Gulf Breeze, Florida. This computer simulation is based on CSETI's own footage, supposedly showing communication with the UFO.

134

We began signaling to them with these lights and they would signal back so that we would flash to them two flashes and off and they would flash back two times and off.

135

00:14:52,500 --> 00:15:00,500

They disappeared briefly and during that time period we were making an equilateral triangle in the sky with these high powered lights.

136

00:15:00,500 --> 00:15:15,500

At that point, shortly after we did that, they reappeared in a perfect equilateral triangle. Over 40 people witnessed a definite close encounter of the fifth kind between the CSETI group and these UFOs.

137

With their apparent success at Gulf Breeze, CSETI expanded their field research to include an investigation in Great Britain. They combined forces with British researchers who were interested in investigating if alien spacecraft could be responsible for England's famous crop circles.

138

We wanted to try and prove once and for all if a link really did exist between the UFO phenomenon and the crop circle phenomenon.

139

We picked the Wiltshire area because the majority of the crop circle formations in England are forming in that particular county.

140

The site there is very close to Stonehenge. It's a very prolific area for aerial phenomena and for the ground patterns.

141

During our protocol that evening of July 23rd, we focused on our thought process for this particular formation for 20 minutes. We all held in our minds the thought of a triangle with a circle at each point of the triangle.

142

And we were of course very astonished to find that the next day precisely that shape appeared in a field.

143

We walked out onto the end of this long land formation and as we got to the very end, their glistening in the sun below us was the perfect formation identical to what we had envisioned.

We clearly do have an intelligence involved which is what would appear to be reading the brain patterns of the human psyche.

Exhilarated by their success, the CECETI team mounted another investigation nearby at Alton Barnes. Bad weather forced most of the team to abandon the overnight surveillance.

But Dr. Greer and three others persevered.

At approximately 12.20 am, Chris Mansell was banging on my window and I opened the door and I said, what is wrong?

151

And he said there is a spaceship coming right to the bloody field.

152

It must have been 80 to 100 feet across, very large.

153

And at this point, we were able to extricate one of these high powered lights and we began to signal to it.

154

So I took the light and I hit it twice with this very high powered light, two flashes and paws.

155

The ultimate surprise, it actually flashed back.

156

00:17:53,500 --> 00:18:01,500

And it flashed back again. It's just amazing. And can you really?

157

This event certainly ranks as one of the most significant human initiated encounters in history.

158

And I think it speaks to the possibilities which await us in the future.

One such possibility is accurately predicting when and where a CE5 will occur.

160

Roy Dutton is a British aerospace engineer who has amassed records on thousands of reported UFO sightings.

161

Given a specific location, Dutton believes he can predict the date and time of the area's next sighting.

162

I can very, very quickly produce a predictions graph for any place on earth.

163

00:18:34,500 --> 00:18:39,500

Roy Dutton did predict the events that occurred at Halton Barnes.

164

00:18:39,500 --> 00:18:42,500

I had just met him that day, the day of the 26th.

165

00:18:42,500 --> 00:18:49,500

And he had, for that part of England, had stated that there would be high likelihood of sightings at around 1030,

166

00:18:49,500 --> 00:18:53,500

which is when we did have the first sightings, and then again at 1230.

167

00:18:53,500 --> 00:18:57,500

The sightings which occurred that night were congruent with his predictions.

168

We, in our C-CETI work, have communicated to them and they've answered,

169

well, what are the boundaries of this? This is a new chapter in interspecies communication.

170

The C-CETI members believe that the increasing number of UFO sightings reported over the past 40 years are more than coincidence.

171

They believe the growing number of sightings are part of an extraterrestrial master plan to prepare us, they say, for formal contact in the near future.

Coming up, a landmark that's become the site of an investigation after a psychic channeling.

Robert, the pirate, spoke through me and he spoke about underground tunnels and buried treasure.
