Family photos have turned up with unusual blurring and discoloration, confounding our photo experts.

During our initial investigation, paranormal researcher Howard Heim felt and recorded strange sensations of cold and electromagnetism.

Sighting's camera operator Phil Lampkin was startled when an intense charge of static electricity began swirling around him.

At first, they were fragments of memory. As a child, Claire Hockam had pastoral visions. Sometimes they were strange.

She never knew what it meant until she was an adult.

Her interview with ranch owner Diana Graves was a turning point.

It was sort of, I know this person and she was very comfortable around the horses and it was sort of an instant recognition and I hired her that day.

I felt when I first met Diana that I must have met her somewhere before or seen her somewhere before.

I felt that I knew her quite well but I couldn't explain that.

Claire worked at the ranch for four years before she and Diana figured out their connection. It started on a dark country road.

And for some reason I knew we needed help, I knew I could no longer handle it.

They got that help through the Fund for UFO Research, an organization that investigates extraterrestrial events and tries to separate fact from fantasy.

They felt Claire was exhibiting signs of a classic abduction.

The fundamental one being missing time and there are others, the markings, the very strange medical problems that they often develop.

Along with Claire's health problems Diana noticed that her employee was also seen some health benefits.

Claire's eyesight dramatically improved after her first abduction.

Strangely Diana's health started following the same course.

My eyes had improved dramatically and I could think of no other rational explanation why my eyesight was also improving unless I too was being abducted.

But the next morning all the skin on the bottom of my feet had been burned off from sticking to the ice.

My conscious memory abductions are very fragmentary.

The women could not escape the relentless fear that accompanied their abduction experiences.

Coming up next, documenting a rare encounter with UFOs.

And later, angels rescue children from the clutches of a madman.

The most recent roper poll suggests that a staggering 96% of all Americans have heard or read about the existence of UFOs.

And as our awareness grows, so do reported sightings.

Many viewers have written to ask what they should do in the event of a UFO sighting.

The number of UFO sightings has grown dramatically in the past 50 years.

And so has the number of people actively searching the skies.

Every night, thousands of people turn their attention to the heavens, hoping for a glimpse of what might be a UFO.

175

Unfortunately, most of these sightings are just wishful thinking.

176

We can explain and have explained, not explaining away, but explain good 70, 75%, maybe even 80%.

177

Bill Pitts hands a consortium of former military personnel who evaluate UFO sightings.

178

The group, the new Project Blue Book, takes its name from the famed government UFO study, but there the similarity ends.

179

The purpose of Project Blue Book is to reevaluate the classic cases which we've been doing

180

and also to even look at new cases as they come along that really come to our attention and we get excited over.

181

And we have had several of those.

182

00:18:46,000 --> 00:18:49,000

Would you know what to do if you saw a UFO?

183

The new Project Blue Book offers these guidelines for documenting your sighting.

184

Watch closely the object you're observing and try to remember as much as you can about that object.

185

00:19:00,000 --> 00:19:05,000

Check to see if any noises seem to be emanating from the particular object.

186

00:19:05,000 --> 00:19:14,000

Write it down as soon as you can and remembering what it looked like to you initially, any changes made during the observation.

187

See also if it seems to be going along at a straight trajectory, if it's zig-zagging or any type of emotion up or down, sideways or otherwise,

188

try to pinpoint the time as closely as possible while you're observing the object or light source.

189

If you have a camera or camcorder available, take as many shots as possible and footage as possible of the object.

190

Being careful with a camcorder or camera, if it's a motion picture camera especially, don't pan the object so fast that you're losing the object.

191

You should notify your local police department or your sheriff's department or if they don't have any record of somebody else making a sighting report to them,

192

then check with your FAA control tower operators for someone else to turn it into or send it to us at Project Blue Book.

Why is the new Project Blue Book so interested in evaluating new sightings?

194

I think it would be a wonderful thing to find something extraterrestrial visiting our shores and meeting with us.

195

I don't know it'll ever happen in our lifetime, if ever, that matter.

196

Maybe we have to go there to meet them on their grounds.

197

And here's one more tip from the new Project Blue Book.

198

If you sight what you believe to be a UFO and you have a video camera at the ready, remember that most camcorders have a built-in microphone.

199

So while you're videotaping, record a running description of events as you see them.

After the event, interview any other witnesses and, if possible, get their full names and addresses.

201

When sightings continues, schoolmates are rescued from the brink of death by other worldly forces.

She had been sent to help me. She wasn't like our new angel.

Then a bizarre mystery continues and later new evidence that mythological creatures are real.

Young gave each teacher a copy of a bizarre manifesto outlining his apocalyptic plan for the children of Cokeville.

He said God equals infinity. Infinity equals zero. Therefore, God does not exist.

David Young was insane, incoherent and unreasonable. He was a human bomb with a hair trigger.

232

The ultimate plan was he was going to, after he got the money, blow the building, the children, the adults, himself and his wife, everything.

He was going to blow it all out and take us to this place that he referred to as the brave new world.

While the local police, sheriffs and the FBI were outside, inside the sense of panic was escalating.

He said that he was sitting there and all of a sudden these angels came down through the ceiling.

And he just looked at me and he says, Dad, you wouldn't believe me.

Whether or not there were angels in the room that day, some unseen force was at work.

300

Investigators of the scene reported that the bomb was fully functional and should have been lethal.

301

Should have been 160 people dead.

302

Bomb technician Richard Haskell says the bomb should have been much more destructive.

303

From where this window is down here to the north, everything on this side should have been gone.

304

This wall should have been just literally laying down on the grass.

305

00:30:07,000 --> 00:30:11,000

All the bricks and everything, it shouldn't even have been here. It should have been gone.

306

In the aftermath, police videotaped the bombed out classroom.

307

And images clearly visible on the southeast wall.

Another photo of the area captures what looks like the silhouette of an angelic figure.

309

The children say, this is where one of the angels stood.

That was a sign showing us, you know, that yes, this was a miracle. Be grateful.

I think there probably were angels in the room when the bomb went off.

And so like the image was just impacted on the wall.

There was an angel for everybody watching over him that day.

There's absolutely no way that we could have made it through that without some kind of help.

But you won't find angel t-shirts and coffee mugs for sale in Cokeville.

For the people of Cokeville, including children, parents, even the police,

318

their angelic encounter has been a profound experience that's deeply personal and can never be trivialized.

Next, are these bizarre deaths the result of alien experimentation or biotech warfare?

320

I'm still scared as to what can happen in the future.

The world's first documented case of livestock mutilation occurred more than 25 years ago.

322

And the bizarre mutilations continue to this day.

Theories about what could be causing these mutilations range from alien experimentation to covert military testing.

324

Law enforcement agencies have investigated, but many ranch owners feel they still don't know who or what is killing their livestock.

325

I lost 49-headed cattle to the mutilations.

326

I lost them in less than three weeks.

327

00:32:03,000 --> 00:32:09,000

At that time of the mutilations and later on we saw many lights up in the sky.

We could not interpret where they were coming from.

The eye was gone. The rectal area had a perfect round cut.

I believe this to be the greatest single unsolved serial crime spree of the 20th century.

They come at night. Mysterious craft piloted by an unseen crew.

The morning light reveals yet another mutilated steer.

State investigators have come and gone.

Natural predators, they insist, but cattle ranchers are not satisfied.

They've seen things no known predator could do.

Field researcher Chris O'Brien has gained their trust.

339

This animal is obviously a roadkill, but any report of a downed animal in the area I'd like to check out

340

00:32:58,000 --> 00:33:02,000

because of the ongoing problem that we have with the mutilations.

341

In September of 1967, the first documented animal mutilation occurred in this field

342

00:33:08,000 --> 00:33:13,000

and drew worldwide attention. Researchers came from far and wide to investigate.

343

Thirty years later, interest is waned, but local ranchers are still forced to cope with dead animals.

344

The night before I saw the cow alive and she had a calf with her and they look healthy to me

345

by next morning, really in the morning she was mutilated.

346

Eli Hornick has been running cattle in northern New Mexico for more than 14 years.

347

00:33:36,000 --> 00:33:40,000

His cattle have been the most recent victims of the mutilation mystery.

348

00:33:40,000 --> 00:33:45,000

Last two years we've lost 10 head of cattle and nine yearlings and one cow.

349

00:33:45,000 --> 00:33:48,000

And you know, you're talking about quite a bit of money.

350

00:33:48,000 --> 00:33:55,000

Something that's pretty interesting, if a human doesn't mess with it or something doesn't disturb it,

351

00:33:55,000 --> 00:34:00,000

the birds, coyotes, they'll just leave it alone.

352

00:34:00,000 --> 00:34:07,000

Hornick's cattle showed the classic signs of mutilation, precise incisions, a conspicuous like a blood

353

00:34:07,000 --> 00:34:11,000

and no physical evidence of a predator, man or animal at the crime scene.

354

00:34:11,000 --> 00:34:16,000

There's never any tracks, never any blood. It's a real clean deal.

355

00:34:16,000 --> 00:34:24,000

Normally when you arrive at an animal mutilation site, you'll find basically that there's no evidence whatsoever.

356

00:34:24,000 --> 00:34:28,000

There's no blood at all. There's no tracks, no cigarette butts.

357

00:34:28,000 --> 00:34:32,000

All the evidence indicates that the animals are being dropped from the air.

358

00:34:32,000 --> 00:34:37,000

So it seems to most researchers that the animals are being taken somewhere else,

359

00:34:37,000 --> 00:34:41,000

being experimented on and then being dropped back where they were found.

360

00:34:41,000 --> 00:34:45,000

Livestock Inspector Jerry Valerio has investigated the mutilations

361

00:34:45,000 --> 00:34:48,000

and they fit the pattern he's seen in dozens of other cases.

362

00:34:48,000 --> 00:34:51,000

The incisions are done real precise.

363

00:34:51,000 --> 00:35:01,000

Every incision that we've dealt with has been almost identical to every animal that has been mutilated.

364

00:35:01,000 --> 00:35:10,000

Most of these cattle mutilations features perfectly circular cuts that have indication of high heat that has been used to make the cuts.

365

00:35:10,000 --> 00:35:18,000

Despite the consistent pattern of bloodless surgical incisions, state and federal authorities insist predators like coyotes and foxes are responsible.

366

00:35:18,000 --> 00:35:20,000

For them, case closed.

367

00:35:20,000 --> 00:35:28,000

I've seen a lot of animals that have been torn up by coyotes and other predators, birds mostly.

368

00:35:28,000 --> 00:35:33,000

And there's incisions where just like a doctor would do in the hospital.

369

00:35:33,000 --> 00:35:42,000

When you see an animal of this nature that's been mutilated, it's clean, no blood, it's not done by predators.

370

00:35:42,000 --> 00:35:50,000

Dr. John Altschuler is a pathologist who studied tissue samples from hundreds of cattle mutilations over the past five years.

371

00:35:50,000 --> 00:35:57,000

A predator even with the accuracy of gnawing and biting would have jagged borders.

372

00:35:57,000 --> 00:36:05,000

The fact that the tissue at the incisional areas is very firm and very hard and looks burned.

373

00:36:05,000 --> 00:36:13,000

And the microscopic evidence clearly indicates that heat has been applied and predators to my

knowledge cannot do that.

374

00:36:13,000 --> 00:36:19,000

What could create these burred-aged incisions is a highly sophisticated portable laser.

375

00:36:19,000 --> 00:36:25,000

Lasers have the ability to actually cauterize the wound, stop the bleeding as you're cutting.

376

00:36:25,000 --> 00:36:31,000

But no portable laser is powerful enough to cut and cauterize masses of livestock tissue.

377

00:36:31,000 --> 00:36:37,000

At Kirtland Air Force Base, Colonel Michael Prairie demonstrates the world's most precise portable laser.

378

00:36:37,000 --> 00:36:43,000

Going through a quarter of an inch of flesh, you'd have to take several passes, maybe five or ten passes to get through.

379

00:36:43,000 --> 00:36:48,000

The precision of the cut is limited to the precision of the operator.

380

00:36:48,000 --> 00:36:57,000

If you needed to make a circular cut with very tight tolerances, you'd have to find some other way, some kind of mechanical system to make such a cut.

381

00:36:57,000 --> 00:37:04,000

If our government doesn't have laser technology capable of these mutilations, who or what does?

382

00:37:04,000 --> 00:37:08,000

The causes behind these mutilations is absolutely unknown.

383

00:37:08,000 --> 00:37:11,000

I believe that there's multiple groups involved in this for various reasons.

384

00:37:11,000 --> 00:37:24,000

The tissue that is being excised from these animals is the fastest regenerating tissue in the bodies and have residual elements of their environment in them.

385

00:37:24,000 --> 00:37:31,000

Anonymous groups with advanced technology mutilating livestock? Sounds impossible, but consider this new theory.

386

00:37:31,000 --> 00:37:37,000

Biotech companies are fighting a super-secret war to be the first to find an artificial substitute for human blood.

387

00:37:37,000 --> 00:37:41,000

A lot of them are using the hemoglobin in cattle blood as their base.

388

00:37:41,000 --> 00:37:47,000

The first company to develop this artificial blood could have a ten billion dollar market all to themselves.

389

00:37:47,000 --> 00:37:53,000

The stakes are high and they don't want the competition to know what they're doing.

390

00:37:53,000 --> 00:38:00,000

Whenever these mutilations occur, there was always a sighting of helicopters around the area.

391

00:38:00,000 --> 00:38:08,000

In a lot of cases, strange lights have been seen around mutilation sites and most often helicopters are seen in and around mutilation sites.

392

00:38:08,000 --> 00:38:13,000

It's like someone is monitoring these areas where these animal deaths are occurring.

393

People ask me, why are they leaving these carcasses lying around these pastures?

394

I think these carcasses are taken and then returned is somehow to instill fear in the rancher.

395

I am over my anger, but I'm still very confused and I'm still scared as to what can happen in the future.

396

There's somebody somewhere that knows what's doing this. You know, we need to get it out in the open and try to get stopped.

397

Until we get people to report these cases and get the help of state and federal law enforcement officials, we're spinning our wheels.

There are no answers. There are just thousands of questions and thousands of dead animals.

399

Since our report, rancher Eli Hornak has discovered yet another mutilated steer on his property.

400

Like the livestock in our report, this animal appears to have died from laser precise incisions and an enormous loss of blood.

Next, a rare discovery leads experts to believe that monsters exist.

There may be far more species on the planet than we thought previously.

Until recently, most biologists thought science had discovered all the big obvious animals with warm blood and fur.

They contend therefore that Bigfoot and Yeti must be simply mythological creatures.

But last spring, biologists on a field trip along the Vietnam-Laos border proved their colleagues wrong.

They found not one, but three new species of mammal.

408

Just a year old, she's a legend come to life.

409

The creature locals have described as an antelope with gills now has a scientific name, the Vugh Quang Aux.

410

In the same region, biologists found the remains of two additional new species.

411

The giant mungak is a saber-toothed deer, and the slow-running deer is a creature who should have been as easy to catch up with as the name implies.

412

This is in North Vietnam, in the mountainous, very mountainous region.

413

00:40:17,000 --> 00:40:22,000

Very few people have been in the region to begin with. It's an extremely rich area.

414

And one of the things that intrigued me was the suggestion that all these new creatures are very ancient.

415

00:40:29,000 --> 00:40:36,000

The mammals found in Southeast Asia are not the only ancient creatures to resurface after their supposed extinction.

416

The sila canth is a sort of fish that was discovered off the coast of South Africa.

417

00:40:44,000 --> 00:40:50,000

And that is a fish that belongs to a group of fish which was thought to have become extinct about 80 million years ago.

418

It is now thought by some people that there may be as many as 30 million species of organisms on the planet or more.

419

The point is, is that we have reason to believe now that there may be far more species on the planet than we thought previously.

420

Cryptozoologists like Roy Mackle believe the clues to discovering some of these 30 million undiscovered species can be found in legends and persistent folktales.

421

Back in the 60s, when we first took seriously perhaps behind such things as Loch Ness Monster, Bigfoot, the Sasquatch, there might be real animals. We were just laughed at.

422

I am a zoologist. I study creatures which are known to exist and I also discover new unknown creatures.

423

00:41:35,000 --> 00:41:43,000

But every time we go out and we discover something new, the cryptozoologists treat this somehow as being a victory for their side.

But the new kinds of animals that turn up are turned up by people like me.

425

But cryptozoologists feel there's a kind of conceit in a mainstream scientific community that won't acknowledge the thousands of fantastic sightings reported by laymen every year.

426

Is it possible that among the millions of undiscovered species, we may find dinosaurs and the humanoid primate legend has named Sasquatch and Yeti?

427

There have been mainstream zoologists who have said that no more large quadrupeds, that is

four-legged animals, are going to be discovered. They've been proved wrong over and over again.

428
