The F-4 approached Mach 1 in its pursuit of the UFO.

object 75 miles ahead of him.

His actual radio transmissions are heard here publicly for the first time outside Iran.

Again the instruments failed.

Major Jopper 8 reported that the smaller UFO appeared to be landing on a mountain top just

Somehow the government doesn't want to open up to the public.

Despite media dismissals of the event as a joke, our sources report that a full-scale

military investigation continued to search for answers.

The general who headed that search still lives in Tehran and denied repeated requests for

But others who were present told sightings that no physical evidence of a UFO was found

on the mountaintop where so many had reported seen a small craft landing.

The DSP satellite is, in fact, a spy satellite that monitors airspace in military hotspots.

183

00:14:20,280 --> 00:14:27,200

On the night of September 19, 1976, the satellite was scanning the skies over Tehran.

184

00:14:27,200 --> 00:14:32,240

That's an independent confirmation that an event of some type occurred at that time and

185

00:14:32,240 --> 00:14:33,240

place.

00:14:33,240 --> 00:14:35,800

What it was, we don't know.

187

Sightings asked the experts to explain the meaning of two 38 scans possible SR.

188

In Desalette, Elko County, Nevada, two rock collectors found her body.

213

At the time, no one knew that she was just one of many or that it would take a psychic

214

to name her killer.

I was notified on November 16, 1993 that we had a body in the desert off of Interstate

216

80, about 23 miles west of the Utah state line.

When we got out there, we found a white female unidentified, completely stripped of all

218

00:16:52,080 --> 00:16:57,240

her clothing, jewelry, and had been killed by a gunshot.

An enhanced sketch of the victim was released in the hope that a loved one would come forward

220

00:17:01,480 --> 00:17:02,840

to claim her.

221

00:17:02,840 --> 00:17:03,840

No one did.

222

00:17:17,840 --> 00:17:22,120

The town of Elko adopted the unknown victim as one of their own.

223

00:17:22,120 --> 00:17:25,840

A local mortuary sponsored a funeral for the young woman nobody knew.

224

00:17:32,200 --> 00:17:33,640

Some dignity and respect.

225

00:17:33,640 --> 00:17:38,720

The way she died was not very pleasant and we just couldn't, in good conscience, just

226

00:17:38,720 --> 00:17:43,960

take her out and bury her without having some type of a funeral service.

227

Elko could only mourn and wonder why.

228

00:17:46,920 --> 00:17:51,680

The victim was buried just as she had been discovered, alone and anonymous.

With few clues to go on, Detective Schultz sent out a teletype describing the Elko murder

case to law enforcement agencies across the country.

Strangely, their corpses weren't haphazardly dumped.

They were plate.

240

The scenes are almost identical.

241

The way their hair was pulled up underneath them, the way their heads were turned, the

242

way their hands were laid out in a particular fashion, the way their feet were laid out

243

00:18:43,160 --> 00:18:44,560

in a particular fashion.

244

00:18:44,560 --> 00:18:48,880

We feel very strongly that the bodies were in fact posed, that there are some things

245

that are not natural, but the way the bodies were positioned.

In all, seven victims in Nevada, Utah and Wyoming have now been identified as murders

247

We have a serial killer, we believe, out there that is going to strike again.

A killer who has an uncanny knack for finding victims nobody knows and nobody misses.

It's very frustrating.

251

00:19:13,040 --> 00:19:15,320

You start wondering, you know, what else can you do?

252

00:19:15,320 --> 00:19:16,560

Things that cannot be policed at.

Her first impressions at the site were about the killer himself.

The mission on this visit was to give Peter James a chance to try to communicate with

Sightings searched town records for evidence supporting Peter James' psychic visions.

Bobby Gossett is back home now with his wife and his own dogs.

The progress he's made has far exceeded his doctor's expectations.
