Three photographs were taken, and this sighting was just the first of many reported aboard

the ship.

Despite vehement denials from the Navy, many people who served on the USS FDR believe that

she was a UFO magnet.

Sometime in late July or early August of 1952, as an ensign, I saw a bright light and

The ship was on a shakedown cruise near Gitmo, Cuba.

On September 20, the newspaper reporter was on the flight deck of the carrier, had a color

camera with him, and he said he turned down the flight deck and noticed a group of guys

They are on the train.

448

And it's dark.

And it's crowded and there's children.

452

Do you know where this train is going?

Buchenwald.

455

To Buchenwald.

Yes.

This is all important to remember and then to let it go.

In these scenes from Star Trek, the shortcut is a cosmic anomaly called a wormhole.

We might have just discovered the first stable wormhole known to exist.

In science fiction, time travel is possible because cosmic anomalies not only warp space,

they also warp time.

But does science support the existence of these interstellar superhighways?

The average scientist says that the distances between stars is so great, four light years to the nearest star,

Michio Kaku is a professor of theoretical physics at the City University of New York.

In his book, *Hyperspace*, Kaku suggests that there is a mechanism capable of warping time.

And Kaku does not rule out the possibility that another, more advanced civilization may have already found that mechanism,

the unified field that Einstein dreamt about.

The new wrinkle, which has caused quite a bit of excitement among theoretical physicists,

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00:34:49,520 --> 00:34:54,520

is that perhaps this river of time can have eddy currents, whirlpools,

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00:34:54,520 --> 00:34:59,520

and perhaps may even fork at a crucial juncture in history.

But where those forks and eddies are, no one knows.

The cosmic highway isn't marked with signs saying, wormhole next right, or this way to ancient Egypt.

At this point, just finding holes in space is more of a stumbling block than traveling through them.

Perhaps an outer space extraterrestrials may have the capability, with the technology thousands of years beyond our own,

to open a hole in space and to begin to manipulate the fabric of space and time.

And that is precisely how Mark Davenport explains his belief that many UFO sightings are, in fact, extraterrestrial spacecraft.
