Roswell is important because it set the tone

I mean, that was 1947.

238

It's important because it's proof

239

00:12:16,600 --> 00:12:18,440

that we're part of a galactic neighborhood.

240

00:12:18,440 --> 00:12:20,760

Aliens are coming here.

241

00:12:20,760 --> 00:12:23,400

Carl Flock is a former deputy assistant secretary

242

00:12:23,400 --> 00:12:26,440

of defense and CIA intelligence officer.

243

00:12:26,440 --> 00:12:28,840

He agrees with Friedman that there was a crash

244

00:12:28,840 --> 00:12:31,320

and a cover-up, but does not believe the incident

245

00:12:31,320 --> 00:12:34,440

was the result of extraterrestrial visitation.

246

00:12:34,440 --> 00:12:36,440

Flock's recently published study of the incident

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00:12:36,440 --> 00:12:38,400

is titled Roswell in Perspective.

248

I was not convinced one way or the other

249

about the extraterrestrial element

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00:12:43,160 --> 00:12:44,960

or precisely what was involved.

251

The only thing I was sure of or reasonably sure of

252

was that the official explanation

253

00:12:51,640 --> 00:12:53,280

of it being a weather balloon

254

and a radar target misidentified was nonsense.

255

Flock and Friedman agreed to meet near the site

256

00:12:59,480 --> 00:13:01,760

of the historic Roswell crash.

257

00:13:01,760 --> 00:13:03,280

The debate begins.

258

00:13:04,520 --> 00:13:06,600

I think after all these years of looking into this

259

00:13:06,600 --> 00:13:09,360

that what really happened was that two saucers

260

00:13:09,360 --> 00:13:12,360

were winging their way along in New Mexico,

261

00:13:12,360 --> 00:13:13,840

ran into some kind of a problem,

262

00:13:13,840 --> 00:13:16,280

maybe a radar beam, maybe a lightning bolt,

263

00:13:16,280 --> 00:13:18,840

something like that, had a mid-air collision,

264

00:13:18,840 --> 00:13:20,720

and that most of the pieces of wreckage

265

00:13:20,720 --> 00:13:22,400

came down on the Brasile Ranch.

266

00:13:22,400 --> 00:13:24,880

All we can really say for sure is

267

that Mac Brasile found something extremely unusual

268

on that ranch.

I think, frankly, that most of the testimony,

270

even from people who have testified

271

00:13:34,400 --> 00:13:37,600

to the odd nature of some of this debris,

272

00:13:37,640 --> 00:13:40,640

points towards not something extraterrestrial,

273

00:13:40,640 --> 00:13:42,840

but towards Project Mogul,

274

00:13:42,840 --> 00:13:44,600

which was a very sensitive project.

275

00:13:44,600 --> 00:13:47,360

Project Mogul was a top secret balloon program

276

00:13:47,360 --> 00:13:50,000

designed to detect Soviet nuclear activity.

277

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:52,280

Flock believes that it was Mogul balloon debris

278

00:13:52,280 --> 00:13:56,000

that Air Force Major Jesse Marcell found at the crash site.

279

00:13:56,000 --> 00:13:58,000

He said that he tried to burn it and it wouldn't burn.

280

00:13:58,000 --> 00:13:59,800

He said that it was flexible.

281

00:13:59,800 --> 00:14:02,720

Flexibility is a property necessary to,

282

00:14:02,720 --> 00:14:06,480

but not exclusive to, weather and surveillance balloons.

283

00:14:06,520 --> 00:14:08,360

So it still leaves you with the bodies.

284

00:14:08,360 --> 00:14:09,360

But where are the bodies?

285

00:14:09,360 --> 00:14:11,680

We have descriptions, yes,

286

00:14:11,680 --> 00:14:14,640

of bodies which could be alien bodies.

287

00:14:14,640 --> 00:14:16,800

That's a definite possibility, and I want to make that clear.

288

I mean, I'm certainly not excluding that

289

by any stretch of the imagination,

290

but they could also be human bodies

291

that have been put through some incredible ordeal.

There were bodies there, strange bodies.

All of these things clearly indicate

294

She was nude, lying on her back,

551

clothed only in socks and her sneakers.

552

Teresa was tracked from her residence on September 15th of 1993

553

in the Croydon area to a pharmacy, several local bars,

554

until the evening hours, like six or seven o'clock in the evening.

555

The police have suspects, but no hard evidence.

More than a year after Teresa's death,

557

Dorothy begins her psychic investigation

with the police department's cooperation.

First she reviews the facts and talks to the family.

560

I had dreams of Anna.

561

Dreams of beautiful.

564

Once she has touched both emotions and fact,

566

Secret underground bases in the southwest are not without precedent. Such bases are known to exist in Colorado and Nevada.

If a similar type of installation exists in New Mexico, what is its purpose?

When we hear from here is what they mention is the possibility of military communications with offshore submarines, with other military installations with electromagnetic waves.

Taos isn't the only American town that's humming.

Recently, divers in Monterey, California experienced an underwater Hum so strong that they felt the vibration in their lungs.

The Monterey Hum, actually more of a thump, according to divers, has no discernible source.

Tapes of the noise are now being analyzed by underwater acoustics experts.
