The Hunter incident marked the last time any active duty military personnel would be allowed to speak freely to the media about their UFO sightings,

after Hunter the Pentagon slammed the door on speaking out.

Among the historic landmarks in and around the graceful southern city of Savannah, Georgia,

is Fort Stewart and Hunter Army Airfield.

It was here, in the early morning hours of September the 8th, 1973, that a watershed UFO event occurred.

The sighting of a brilliant oval craft by military police patrolmen was to be the first in a series of UFO encounters

over a number of military bases throughout the United States.

The Hunter event was also significant because it seemed to sound a death knell

28

for the government's open door policy regarding UFOs.

It's 2.30 a.m.

31

Specialists' fourth class Bart Burns and Randy Schade are on a routine patrol of the base perimeter.

It's easy duty. The base will be closed in just a few weeks and nearly everyone and everything has been shipped out.

Suddenly, a bright light catches Sergeant Burns' attention.

It hovers just above the treetops, then suddenly dives directly at the MP's car.

The craft missed them by a whisker.

Burns' radio transmission to the base dispatcher was picked up by the local media.

Their requests for interviews were quickly granted and for two days,

Burns and Schade's close encounter was front page news.

Then, two days after the event, the MPs stopped talking

and within two weeks, both were transferred to different bases.

That only tells me one thing. When they can find these MPs to the base

Something very spectacular occurred there.

Investigator Lawrence Fawcett has been researching reported UFO intrusions at military bases for

over 30 years.

He has co-written a book on the subject titled The UFO Cover-Up.

A former police lieutenant, Fawcett believes Hunter was the first in a series of incidents

48

where vocal military personnel were punished.

I've seen this numerous times in other cases where in the beginning

50

the people involved would begin talking only to be shut up later on or shipped out.

The government gagged should have kept the Hunter UFO safely shrouded in obscurity,

52

but the MPs were not the only people who saw the UFO.

Savannah News Press editor Marcus Holland was an eyewitness.

He reported seeing an oval craft streak across the sky, emitting red, green and white light.

I've never seen a plane moving at that type speed and there's just no plane that could fly that fast.

I didn't know whether to be scared or not.

57

I just said to myself, you know, could this be a UFO?

You know, is that what I'm seeing?

But I just had no idea.

It just flashed across, went down and to me it looked like it went down on the backside of Hunter Field,

On September 8th, 1973, Jerry Smith and her son Albert, who was nine years old at the time,

As I was driving, all of a sudden Albert looked up and I said, what's the matter?

Newspaper articles, eyewitness accounts and a few brief government documents

obtained through the Freedom of Information Act were all that Lawrence Fawcett could uncover

about the Hunter incident during more than 20 years of investigation.

Then in 1995, a sightings researcher made an important discovery.

He came across an article in a computer database that led him to former Sergeant Bart Burns.

75

Fawcett had wanted to talk to the Long-Sighted MP for two decades

76

and now finally he would get his chance.

77

00:06:05,320 --> 00:06:11,320

Burns, now a commercial pilot living in a suburb of Chicago, agreed to a meeting in Savannah.

78

What did you think it was at that time?

79

I had no idea what it was. I had never clue.

80

00:06:16,320 --> 00:06:20,320

I mean I had never seen anything like it before so I couldn't even compare it to anything.

You know people don't believe you if you go to tell it so I basically,

82

I really haven't told that story in 20-some years.

I just let it go. The first time I even thought about it was when I got a call from you people.

With Fawcett and a sightings investigating team, Bart Burns agreed to return to Hunter Army Airfield

85

and retrace his route.

This is where we were doing that trolling that night.

87

Actually we were doing just like this, same direction and everything.

88

Broke right over these tree tops right here.

89

And at this point here I ducked down and Randy swerved off.

90

And we went off the road right back, probably about where that sign is there.

And uh...

So you were heading in this direction?

Taken on its own, the Haunter Incident is an isolated case of a military base overflight by a UFO.

109

Witnessed by credible, highly trained military observers.

But in the two years following this incident,

111

Hunter became only the first in a series of military base overflights.

112

Between 1973 and 1975, more than 75 bases reportedly had sightings of UFOs.

113

But we will never have a full accounting of these UFO incidents,

114

00:08:35,320 --> 00:08:39,320

because of what happened at Hunter Army Airfield.

115

00:08:39,320 --> 00:08:43,320

Within the structure of the military and that,

116

00:08:43,320 --> 00:08:47,320

they're not going to reward you for reporting an incident like that.

117

It just doesn't behoove anybody to be passing out medals for that one.

118

Sightings has also located Alexander Murray,

119

00:08:56,320 --> 00:08:59,320

the dispatcher who received the original UFO report.

120

Sightings will bring you his interview on a future program.

Investigator Larry Fawcett is still trying to locate the second MP,

122

00:09:06,320 --> 00:09:09,320

who witnessed the UFO alongside Bart Burns.

The former MP's name is Randy Shade,

124

00:09:12,320 --> 00:09:18,320

and in 1973, Shade was a spec-4 at Hunter Army Airfield in Savannah, Georgia.

125

Next, a London police detective who knows the spirit of the law.

126

I'm questioning the spirit, and I tend to ask a lot of questions

127

of those that communicate with me.

In Great Britain, psychics have to be licensed and registered.

129

Among the roster of registered psychics is Keith Charles,

130

a man who believes that he has a sixth sense about where and how a crime has been committed.

131

00:09:45,320 --> 00:09:48,320

Charles uses this psychic ability every day in his work.

132

00:09:48,320 --> 00:09:53,320

He is the world's only registered psychic police constable.

133

00:10:01,320 --> 00:10:06,320

In Metropolitan London, detective constable Keith Charles is working his beat.

134

00:10:08,320 --> 00:10:12,320

With a badge, a notebook, and what he believes is a supernatural gift,

135

00:10:12,320 --> 00:10:16,320

Keith Charles solves crimes for his department's criminal investigation division.

136

00:10:16,320 --> 00:10:21,320

After hours, he uses those same powers in a completely different setting.

137

00:10:35,320 --> 00:10:38,320

Since he was eight, Charles has had clairvoyant visions,

138

00:10:38,320 --> 00:10:42,320

one which he believes led him to save the life of a drowning friend.

139

00:10:42,320 --> 00:10:45,320

He uses his psychic skills in seminars like this one,

140

00:10:45,320 --> 00:10:51,320

and on the job, where his uncanny powers of perception were evident the moment he started patrolling the streets of London.

141

00:10:51,320 --> 00:10:55,320

People would come up from all over the world and all over the UK,

142

00:10:55,320 --> 00:10:57,320

and I would find myself being able to say,

143

00:10:57,320 --> 00:11:03,320

I know you, you've got a sister, you've got this, or you live near a church,

144

00:11:03,320 --> 00:11:05,320

and they were saying, how'd you know this?

145

00:11:05,320 --> 00:11:08,320

And I really didn't know, but I was getting information from somewhere.

146

Charles points out that hard work and diligence drive his investigations,

147

00:11:12,320 --> 00:11:16,320

but he's not above asking for other worldly help in some cases.

148

00:11:16,320 --> 00:11:21,320

There are times when I will be investigating a crime,

149

00:11:21,320 --> 00:11:26,320

that I've come to a dead end, and then I will look towards the spirit world

150

00:11:26,320 --> 00:11:28,320

and say to him, come on, give me a clue.

151

00:11:28,320 --> 00:11:34,320

And sometimes, the spirits in Charles' world lead him down a completely unexpected path.

152

00:11:34,320 --> 00:11:41,320

It was a few years ago, whilst working in this district, that in this road here, a man was stabbed to death.

153

We formed a murder squad, and I was one of the officers,

154

00:11:44,320 --> 00:11:48,320

and we were asked to suggest the names of possible suspects.

155

00:11:48,320 --> 00:11:52,320

I linked into spirit and asked them if they could give me the name of the person responsible,

156

00:11:52,320 --> 00:11:54,320

and they did, they gave me the name of Ricky.

157

00:11:54,320 --> 00:11:58,320

However, he wasn't responsible for stabbing this man to death,

158

00:11:58,320 --> 00:12:01,320

but that same day, he killed a young lady,

159

00:12:01,320 --> 00:12:04,320

and later in the week, killed another young lady.

160

00:12:06,320 --> 00:12:09,320

Respect from fellow officers wasn't automatic.

161

00:12:09,320 --> 00:12:13,320

Charles earned their admiration after a series of startling revelations.

162

00:12:13,320 --> 00:12:17,320

Detective Inspector Alan Wilson called Charles Hale on a murder case

163

00:12:17,320 --> 00:12:21,320

after 2,000 hours of police work failed to turn up a suspect.

164

00:12:21,320 --> 00:12:27,320

Our victim had left the party, had taken the girl to a taxi,

165

00:12:28,320 --> 00:12:30,320

had gone to the bank and got some money.

166

00:12:30,320 --> 00:12:32,320

None of these details were released yet.

167

00:12:32,320 --> 00:12:34,320

Keith knew them, somehow.

168

00:12:34,320 --> 00:12:38,320

He told us descriptions of people who were in the building.

169

00:12:38,320 --> 00:12:42,320

He actually came up with 20 to 25 points,

170

00:12:42,320 --> 00:12:46,320

but he came up with information that we'd never released.

171

Even the most skeptical members of a naturally reticent force had to admit,

172

Keith Charles had a way of knowing, beyond logic and reason.

173

There were a lot of skeptics in the police force,

174

00:13:02,320 --> 00:13:04,320

and when I told my other colleagues about it,

175

00:13:04,320 --> 00:13:08,320

even they, the heirs did stand up at the back of the neck, somewhere.

176

And Charles was able to turn around a skeptical British press corps,

177

00:13:14,320 --> 00:13:19,320

including one journalist who ended up co-writing Keith Charles autobiography.

178

I was extremely skeptical, yes.

179

00:13:22,320 --> 00:13:27,320

I was originally chasing what seemed to me like a very good news story.

180

00:13:27,320 --> 00:13:32,320

I mean, here you had a policeman who was also a psychic.

181

00:13:32,320 --> 00:13:34,320

It just had to be a great story.

182

00:13:34,320 --> 00:13:37,320

So I followed him around for quite a while after this

183

00:13:37,320 --> 00:13:41,320

and found him unbelievably impressive.

184

And I don't say that lightly.

185

I've opened the door here, and I have a gentleman who says he's your husband.

186

I have the name of James in the spirit world, which does.

187

In his public appearances, Charles tries to bridge the gap between this world and the next,

188

00:13:56,320 --> 00:14:00,320

reassuring the living that they're dead are in good hands.

189

00:14:00,320 --> 00:14:03,320

As a psychic detective, I'm questioning the spirit,

190

00:14:03,320 --> 00:14:07,320

and I tend to ask a lot of questions of those that are communicating with me,

191

00:14:07,320 --> 00:14:12,320

because I feel if I could give somebody that knowledge and that comfort,

192

00:14:12,320 --> 00:14:17,320

knowing that their mum, their dad, brother or son is around them in the spirit world,

193

00:14:17,320 --> 00:14:20,320

that their life continues, that's fine.

194

00:14:20,320 --> 00:14:24,320

Have you ever had a scar on your knee, please, Rachel?

195

00:14:24,320 --> 00:14:26,320

Yes.

196

00:14:26,320 --> 00:14:34,320

Yes, they are aware of this, and they are bringing you confirmation that spirit do look after you.

197

I now have a grandmother that links with you.

198

I have a scar on my knee.

199

I was in a car accident, and I've got quite a big scar on my knee,

200

and that's when I realised that it was true, and that he was telling the truth.

And then when my grandmother came through, I'd been waiting for my grandmother to come through

202

and speak to me for a long time.

In 1994, Keith Charles' 20-year-old son Matthew was killed suddenly,

204

and Charles says he had a life-changing communication with his son.

205

What I've learned from it is that it makes me more determined as a medium

206

to be as genuine and sincere as you can, because I've lost somebody close to me,

207

00:15:13,320 --> 00:15:19,320

and I know what it means, and I find it nice and comforting that Matthew can come and help me.

208

He wanted to work with me in the physical, now he's working with me in the spiritual,

209

00:15:23,320 --> 00:15:26,320

and I say thank you to him for that, because it's lovely.

210

His life is a balancing act between faith in other worldly forces

211

00:15:31,320 --> 00:15:33,320

and the cold reality of the streets.

212

It's a challenge every day.

213

I enjoy my work as a medium, I enjoy my work as a policeman,

214

and I'm very thankful that I'm able to do both,

and that I've been given the opportunity to do both, and I love both of them.

In the United States, few police officers will work with psychics,

Spencer wrote the UFO Field Investigator's Training Guide,

a study course designed to help field investigators pass Mufon's entrance examination.

He is also creating a database to catalog every reported sighting.

243

A project Mufon believes will help them solve the mystery of unidentified flying objects.

In South Korea, volunteer forces are trying to get rid of something left behind after World War II,
