Mainly, I was very good in math and I was very good in science, and I did extremely well in school.

She earned top honors in medical school, graduated with distinction, and then set up her own practice based on the conservative approach to medicine she'd been taught.

I had a very traditional medical practice, really, on the outside.

I taught with University of Toronto and I taught medical students and residents.

So, I really did traditional practice.

She did practice that way, but she doesn't anymore.

Something happened to Dr. Kasen that altered not only her approach to medicine, but also fundamentally changed the way she's perceived the world around her.

Dr. Kasen, a nurse, and the pilot of a small plane were transporting a critically ill patient.

A freak blizzard caused the plane to lose power.

I thought, I'm gonna die.

113

And the plane was going in this really rough turbulence crashing down to the ground.

So, we had to very quickly get out of the plane as the plane was sinking into the water.

The plane sank very fast, taking the life of the patient with it.

I was wearing heavy clothes and there I was.

What should I do?

And a voice in my head spoke, and the voice said, swim to shore.

But the shore was 200 yards away across a heavy downstream current.

Swimming didn't seem to be the best option.

A rescue team rushed Dr. Kacin, the nurse, and pilot to the hospital.

141

They were all unconscious.

I was in this wonderful, expanded place up here, and suddenly with a noise,

143

I was sucked into my body, and all of a sudden, I was back.

The experience changed my life in a lot of ways.

145

I really wanted to figure out what it was.

That was the scientific part of me.

And so I spoke with my medical friends, the doctors,

No one knew what it was.

or maybe this was a direct effect of cold on the brain, causing a hallucination.

But none of that was good enough for me.

After much study, Dr. Kacin now believes

she had what paranormal researchers call the near-death experience.

I totally had lost my fear of death.

In that persists to this day.

Dr. Kacin also believes that since the experience,

she has acquired psychic abilities, including clairvoyance.

It seems that having a near-death experience opens your consciousness somehow,

162

and makes you more open to various sorts of other mystical and paranormal experiences,

163

such as the clairvoyant experience.

164

Captain, you see that house right there?

165

That's where Auntie Balin grew up.

166

Colleen Isherwood has been Yvonne Kacin's friend for 30 years.

167

They grew up together in this Toronto neighborhood.

Before she had her near-death experience,

169

Yvonne was not the type of person who would talk about anything mystical like that,

anything unusual.

But the more she began talking about her paranormal experiences,

172

the more she heard from others with similar stories.

So I found people over the years started coming to my office

178

so that more and more of my patients ended up being people

who'd had spiritual or paranormal experiences.

So my practice started shifting in this direction.

When I started seeing Yvonne, I said,

Today, Dr. Kacin is the director of the Spiritual Emergence Research

Along with a staff of physicians and other healthcare professionals,

188

Dr. Kacin has steered her practice towards the care and support

189

of patients like Alexis Radlin.

After about 11 years of research,

191

I really felt ready to start talking publicly to doctors

192

and to the public about what I'd come to understand

193

about mystical and paranormal phenomenon.

And in her book, *A Father's Shore*,

195

Dr. Kacin chronicles the personal stories of more than 100 of her patients,

all of whom have been transformed by a paranormal experience.

I know now to the core of my being that it's a universal human phenomenon.

198

Anyone can have a spiritually-transformative experience.

Work has begun on the most comprehensive review of alien abduction accounts ever compiled.

In Morris, Michigan, Dan Wright, former deputy director of MUFON,

is compiling data from alien abduction experiences throughout North America.

It is an unprecedented program called the MUFON Alien Abduction Transcription Project

214

and its goal is to create a comprehensive computer database of abduction experience.

equal numbers approximately of males and females,

Over 50 MUFON researchers are now working on the project,

219

Today's search for extraterrestrial intelligence is high-tech and computerized, but in 1924, one of the greatest mechanical minds in the country was an appliance builder named C. Francis Jenkins.

If there was anyone in the kind of world of invention at that time who had all the tools to do the kind of thing that Todd wanted to have done, I think Jenkins was a logical choice.

402

Jenkins had already developed an early form of television that converted radio signals into images on film.

Dr. Todd had Jenkins aim this device toward Mars on a day of national radio silence in October of 1924.

Effectively from what I understand, they used it to aim at Mars knowing that it was going to be closest to the Earth on whatever that date was, and used it to record signals of some kind coming from Mars.

405

The signals proved to be astonishing. For the first time in human history, a strange message coming from the direction of Mars was actually recorded on film.

406

They brought the film back and then had markings on the film, which were very hard to decipher.

There was apparently something that looked like a face that was constantly repeated along one edge of the film.

William Friedman is important in cryptology basically because of national security issues.

He was working for the government in a security area decoding messages.

And what happened when two of America's best scientists met the master of cryptology?

The answer has been shrouded in mystery for three-quarters of a century, until sightings finally tracked down the long-lost Mars film in Friedman's personal archives at the Virginia Military Institute.

William Friedman looked at the code, made an attempt to decipher it. There's no evidence in the files which indicate that he actually broke the code.

417

Why he did not return the files to the gentleman who brought the subject to his attention is not known.

As a result, both Todd and Jenkins died in obscurity, like their once famous Mars message.

In Friedman's archives, purged by the National Security Agency of much of its important correspondence, we did find one revealing letter.

The author reports that his men had recorded the same radio signals on that same day in 1924.

They consisted in part of dashes of six seconds duration separated by intervals of seven seconds.

These dashes continued for several minutes, were followed by a voice pronouncing words.

They were isolated words from one to four syllables.

The author of this amazing letter to Friedman was a captain in the U.S. Signal Corps.

Could this be Todd and Jenkins' ultimate vindication, a clue hidden by Friedman, until he was no longer here to keep the secret?

To decode a message from another planet that may or may not indicate extraterrestrial life, I believe William Friedman would have seen that as the ultimate code.

427
