But, Fronine points out, this is unlike any propulsion system he's ever seen. Flying fast at high altitude, the UFOs leave no contrails, and none of the objects has any visible means of propulsion.

The Air Force continues to maintain that what crashed was a balloon.

But within the report, there is an important and remarkable new disclosure about what kind of balloon.

This, states the Roswell report, is debris from a top secret Air Force program to carry surveillance equipment up into the atmosphere.

My earliest recollections of life are of being on a military installation and watching a column of tanks roll by.

My first toys were army things. It's all I ever knew, and it's what I thought I was supposed to be.

He was to be one of a handful of men chosen for training as psychic spies, learning the technique called remote viewing. One of the first things David Morehouse and his colleagues in Project Sunstrike learned was how to enter an altered state of consciousness they called the ether.

It is that word that we used to describe that place between reality and some place distant in time and space. It is like the medium that you travel in. It is the medium that you as a phantom, as an apparition view your target.

Initially, you go through a long extended period of lecture where you're taught everything that there is to know theory wise about remote viewing. The normal human being would scratch their heads and go, well wait a minute, that doesn't make sense.

How does that work? And I asked that question often until my trainer would turn to me and say, you know, we don't know how this works, really. We just know that it does work.

Project Sunstrike monitored the officers as they entered the deep state of relaxation, the ether, necessary to begin a remote viewing. The men were then given a set of coded coordinates and asked to go there, psychically, to see with a mind's eye what was happening at that location.

In the years that you worked for this agency, you were sent to many, many different operational targets, including Desert Storm. What did you see there?

A few hours after that aircraft exploded, we were asked to begin work on that particular project. Several of the remote viewers drew in their sketches, saw this radio device and saw an explosive in the radio device.

A very good friend of mine, Mel Riley, who is certainly one of the best remote viewers that there ever was. I can remember him standing in the fuselage and finding himself turning to these souls that now their physical bodies obviously plummeting towards Earth.

And I remember Mel trying to tell people that they had died. They were all gone now. That this is what had happened. That is a tremendous amount of emotional and spiritual pain that you are asked to grasp, to embrace. But it takes a tremendous toll on you as a human being to have to experience that.

And the toll it took on David Morehouse and his family was irreparable. Unable to talk about the horrifying visions with anyone, David withdrew, through increasingly anxious and like a lot of other remote viewers, David felt he was losing his mind.

The people who were put in this program and put in the position of remote viewing, I think they were totally unprepared, psychologically. David Morehouse, who had a very conventional, traditional, upbringing, schooling. And suddenly he's into this program of just mind-boggling dimensions.

One of the worst things that happens to remote viewers is they develop a messiah complex.

You think you're God?

And when you go back and see the ground zero at Hiroshima or crawl amongst the bones and ashes in the ovens of Dachau as a remote viewer and you go home that night, what do you say to your wife? What does she say to you? How was your day at the office, honey?

You start to lose the ability to communicate to the rest of humanity.

265

But David's emotional connection to his remote viewing targets was not the reason he dropped out of the project. That decision came, he says, after he realized that remote viewing was being tested not only as an intelligence tool, but also as a weapon of psychological destruction.

They knew that it could go far beyond where it was today. They wanted to be able to kill with it.

So I felt that I had a moral and an ethical responsibility to bring that information forward to humankind.

After he dropped out, David was discharged less than honorably. His family and friends received anonymous threats.

But the scariest thing for me was the night that they tried to kill my wife and my children. And that was really tough for me to accept after I had given so much as an officer to the Army.

Now I don't think that Army guys did this and I don't think that some general officer setting in the Pentagon ordered a hit on my wife and family. But do I think that the Central Intelligence Agency did it? Yeah.

Mr. Morehouse, you're an Army man. Are you mad at the military, at the US government for what they've done to your son?

273

I have disgusted you with what they did for my son. He was a good officer and they mistreated him. They treated him like a criminal.

Today, David Morehouse lives in a quiet seaside home with his parents, writing a book about his experiences. He's working towards a reconciliation with his wife and children, and he continues to use his paranormal abilities for good to solve crimes, to find missing children, and in the quest for world peace.

According to Jim Mars, other remote viewers are following David's example.

Now that it's become public knowledge, now that the former head of the CIA has spoken out about it, now that General Thompson has gone on the record talking about it, the other spies, I'm sure, will begin to come forward and tell their stories.

All of the ones I spoke to indicated that they really thought that this was a technology that should be used for the betterment that mankind and not strictly for intelligence and war purposes.

Given that remote viewing has such a tremendous capacity for good and for evil, and that you now know how to do it, when you look back at your decision to become involved, do you regret the decision?

Jazz singer Vicky Umopeg has been blind since birth. Vicky's world is devoid of all shape, color, even light. She only sees the world through her sense of touch. And yet Vicky says she knows what it's like to have vision.

Following a near-fatal car crash in 1973, Vicky says she saw with her eyes for the first and only time. At her home in Seattle, she told me about her near-death experience.

I experienced a, I guess you could say a clinical death or near-death.

My first real clear recollection was finding myself up on the ceiling and looking down.

And the only thing that I saw was the doctor briefly and my body. And I was on this kind of stretcher thing.

And I thought, oh my lord, am I dead or what?

It was very disorienting and frightening to perceive things from a distance like that because I have to, I have to touch everything.

And this way I was not touching anything. I was observing things from a distance and it was quite foreign and scary and weird. It was eerie.

I started feeling peaceful and I could hear a sound like wind chimes. It was the most beautiful thing.

For years I've heard rumors that the blind can actually see during near-death experiences.

And it was attempt to see whether there was any validity to this rumors that led me to do this particular study.

Dr. Kenneth Ring is one of this country's leading NDE researchers.

After interviewing Vicky Umepeg, Dr. Ring began a formal study on near-death experience and the blind.

It's a paradox that people who have no concept or even history of vision can actually report being able to see.

307

But it's that particular paradox that we want to be able to understand.

308

And in Vicky's case, she was blind from birth. She was premature, so she's never had any vision or any concept of vision.

And yet in this experience she says and says unequivocally that she could see.

When you had your near-death experience, did you have any visual perception during it?

Sharon Cooper is the co-author of the NDE study. She believes that there's compelling evidence that NDE is more than random visions of a dying brain.

The near-death experience seems to be an authentic experience happening to millions of people.

And the common theme seems repeated regardless of the physical disability of the individual.

314

Brad Burroughs is among the congenitally blind who participated in the study.

315

Although he was born without pupils, Brad claims he had a vivid and fully visual near-death experience after a near-fatal bout of pneumonia when he was just 8 years old.

I had stopped breathing for about four minutes and I became aware that my body seemed to be in a separate place from me.

317

It was almost as if I was hovering above my body and was separated from it.

318

As I found myself entering this new plane however, I felt that this sensation, which I could only describe as seeing,

and this light, which I only knew of as light, was so natural and normal to me that I didn't even question it.
