It changed the way I believe about the universe and my place in it and our place in it.

In 1964, Lieutenant Robert Jacobs was stationed at Vandenberg Air Force Base, California.

He was in charge of a special photographic unit filming test flights of Atlas-F

and Minuteman missiles, both nuclear weapon delivery systems.

When you launch a piece of equipment that costs four or five million dollars

53

just for the piece of equipment and it blows up 300 yards out of the hole,

54

we want to know first of all why did it blow up.

So my job was to provide photographic documentation from 30 or 40 different camera positions for each launch.

In November of 1964, Jacobs was assigned to film a Vandenberg missile launch

57

using a brand new state-of-the-art telescope developed at Boston University.

58

It was the most powerful lens the Air Force had ever used.

59

The biggest lens we had on our M45s was 180 inches.

60

This telescope had an effective focal length of 1,200 inches, so you can see that it's enormously bigger.

61

It was so big in fact that when the missile left Vandenberg with the Boston University telescope

62

in one single frame, just the bottom three engines on an Atlas-F filled the frame.

That was from a distance of about 130 nautical miles.

In a top secret mission, the telescope was flown in from Boston aboard a Hercules aircraft.

This is actual footage shot by Jacobs' unit and only recently rediscovered in his archive.

The telescope was so large it had to be hauled to its site in an 18-wheel big rig.

Jacobs' crew assisted the telescope's inventor, Walter Manning, with the installation of the lens.

The camera was perched on a bluffing big sur, 130 miles from the launch site.

We walked out of the missile and we saw all three stages of powered flight.

After the film was developed, project director Major Florence Mansman called Jacobs into his office and Major Mansman was not alone.

They denied then that there was a tracking site at Big Sur.

They denied that there was a telescope called the BU Telescope.

Socorro, New Mexico is the site of one of the most baffling UFO encounters in US history.

Recently, two members of Mexico's Air Traffic Control Union risked their livelihoods by discussing with being their own UFO sightings, UFOs that came dangerously close to commercial aircraft.

There are reports that the air traffic controllers in Mexico City are seeing very strange things on their radar screens. Is that true?

293

We have activity almost every day. Some days, a few, some days just only one, but I work at nights and pilots keep reporting me they have lights inside, near the mountains, at the volcano areas, at the archaeological zones.

It's somewhat strange because they move so fast that the radar does not register their movement, only when they become motionless.

We don't investigate any case that is not proven by hard evidence. We are trying to be as scientific as possible. We go to the places, we look through all the night and try to find out if there is something going on there that all of us believe is really happening.

I accompanied Musson at a chapter of Los Vigilantes on a nighttime stakeout outside Mexico City. Around 9pm, Musson received a phone call from a city air traffic controller. He reported unusual activity on his radar screen.

There were three lights. I was seeing that when I had the phone. And he said that one of them, they didn't have it in the radar.

301

It wasn't registered as an airplane, so it was something else.

Exactly. They had two airplanes, but the third light was not an airplane. And he's expecting now to have a repetition of the images in the radar. And then we will know for sure that that's a UFO.

Musson confirms that this is an inbound commercial aircraft. Los Vigilantes scan the skyline, but we cannot see the UFO being picked up intermittently on airport radar.

Well, the number 13 may be scary, but to strike real terror in some people, just mention 666.

322

They call it the Devil's Highway, 200 miles of road bisecting the Navajo Nation in northern New Mexico.

This two-lane thoroughfare is the primary artery in and out of the nation's largest Native American reservation, a vital link for commercial and public transportation.

324

00:32:56,000 --> 00:33:00,000

But when the sun goes down, death comes to the Devil's Highway.

325

00:33:00,000 --> 00:33:10,000

This road has one of the highest highway fatality rates in America, and for good reason, say many travelers, because this is Highway 666.

326

00:33:10,000 --> 00:33:19,000

The number 666 in the Bible is one of the few specific references to something that is downright evil, something to be avoided.

327

00:33:19,000 --> 00:33:26,000

So it's something that people can seize on and say, okay, God said, avoid this number or any combinations thereof.

328

00:33:26,000 --> 00:33:39,000

Unsafe passing and tired drivers do account for many of the deaths on Highway 666, but many people have died along the side of the road under very mysterious circumstances, according to criminal investigator Jones Begay.

329

A lot of times we don't have a vehicle at the scene, and we usually don't have grill markings or brake markings.

330

00:33:47,000 --> 00:33:54,000

There's usually evidence left behind by a vehicle that caused the accident, but we don't find anything along the highway.

331

And strangely, the most dangerous part of Highway 666 is located here at mile marker 13.

332

I got a call about an accident with fatality that occurred about midnight, and we processed the crime scene.

333

And then six hours later, six o'clock in the morning, we had the same accident happen in the same impact area with the same scenario as the first one.

00:34:21,000 --> 00:34:32,000

And I was having a talk with the FBI agent, and he suggested, well, maybe we should get a medicine man to bless the highway, so we don't get a lot of these accident fatalities that occurred on this highway.

335

00:34:32,000 --> 00:34:47,000

The Navajo Nation does not share in the belief that the number 666 is the mark of the devil, but ancient Navajo tradition teaches that numbers do have spiritual power, and writing the number 6 can spell big trouble if it's not done correctly.

336

00:34:47,000 --> 00:34:57,000

6 is something that we should not mess around with because it would cause illness, it would cause poverty, it would cause death.

337

00:34:59,000 --> 00:35:10,000

In addition to the evil overtones of the highway's numerical designation, there is another reason why Highway 666 is the devil's highway, according to Navajo medicine man Ned Maguet.

338

00:35:10,000 --> 00:35:19,000

He believes that the highway was built on sacred land, and that the desecration of this sacred ground has offended the spirits of his ancestors.

339

00:35:19,000 --> 00:35:30,000

There's places that are real holy, and they just slaughtered up and just made a road, and some of them just messed it up, and that's why a lot of people are getting hurt on that road.

340

00:35:30,000 --> 00:35:37,000

The belief that a highway is cursed because it disturbs sacred ground is by no means unique to Highway 666.

341

00:35:37,000 --> 00:35:49,000

Sightings has reported previously on an epidemic of fatal accidents that have occurred during the construction of Hawaii's H3, a freeway that cuts through Oahu's most sacred burial sites.

342

00:35:50,000 --> 00:36:02,000

In Blyster County, New Jersey, the death toll was mounting on Highway 55 until members of the Delaware tribe blessed the area where the highway ran through ancient burial ground.

343

And according to Navajo, there is only one way to stop the carnage on Highway 666.

Personally, I think that we just have to tear the whole road out and just redo it again and have a prayer for it.

Offhand, I can't tell you where I remember where there was an alcohol involved in the accident or a fatality that occurred on this highway.

There's nothing I'd ever seen in aviation. It didn't have wings or propellers or jets. The rate of acceleration was far too rapid, absolutely no noise.

And about then, the thing just took off, just gone.

Until former MP, Bart Burns, gave his astonishing first person account to Sightings.

The eyewitness details of the Hunter encounter had not been heard for more than two decades because of a government clampdown on the press interviews that Burns and his partner freely granted in the days after the incident.

365

Although there was no reason to doubt the encounter Burns recounted in his Sightings interview, we searched for independent verification of his story.

They came running inside and Shade of Special was very, very shaken, very, it was scary.

And Bart was very concerned, shall I say.

Although Burns was still rattled, he agreed to accompany Murray back to the scene of the encounter.

After a fruitless search of the base perimeter, they returned to the dispatch desk where Murray received shocking confirmation of the episode.

I basically just called the county dispatcher and said, did anybody see anything?

And he said, boy, I'm glad somebody else, he said one of our guys called in and the poor did the same thing, saw the same thing.

Intrigued by the possibility of seeing a UFO, Murray says he persuaded Burns to go with him onto the airfield the very next night.

They pulled up a troll car to the end of a closed runway and waited for hours. Then their patience was rewarded.

I was sitting there and I saw a red light at first.

382

At first I thought it was the navigation lights, a rotating beacon from an airplane.

383

But it didn't flash at all, it was just a round red light as such.

384

And it moved in very erratic fashion, kind of quick jerks around and then disappeared down behind the trees.

385

Because at the end of the runway it was all trees and forests and stuff.

And I can remember just watching it, didn't say anything.
