What it was or where it came from is still unexplained, but not for lack of trying.

Two investigative units combed this area.

And NYCAP sent one of our investigation teams to the scene.

There was one in Western New York State and they were there within one day of the sighting.

At the time, Richard Hall was assistant director of the National Investigations Committee on

NYCAP's distinguished membership included scientists, philosophers, retired military

personnel, people interested in solving the UFO mystery.

NYCAP came into existence because the Air Force was being very secretive about UFOs and it

49

was felt that a high level civilian group could maybe pry loose some information.

We were basically adversarial.

The Air Force, we felt, was hiding information and we were trying to get information out.

When Project Blue Book went into the field, NYCAP was right on their heels, doggedly gathering

information and eyewitnesses that the Air Force had overlooked.

Project Blue Book was the Air Force office that investigated UFO sightings for the United

55

The Air Force system in Blue Book was to label reports in one of three ways.

Either it was explained, in which case they would say what they thought it was, an aircraft

or a balloon or whatever, or it was unexplained, unknown, they used to say, and the third was

insufficient data.

The incident at Cherry Creek was labeled as a true unknown.

It was a very interesting case and it went on with multiple evidence including the electromagnetic

effects, the physical traces, the illumination, everything.

It was a classic mainline UFO sighting.

Well, it looked like an airplane.

It was that big.

And when it sat in the field, it had three legs on it.

Bob Galgansky has carefully researched the incident at Cherry Creek and has spent many

hours trying to track down additional eyewitnesses like the two state troopers who filed an official

police report then just seemed to disappear off the face of the earth.

They were risking their reputation and for them to come out and actually state that they

Dick Nelson still lives next to the butcher farm and remembers talking to the troopers

Well after the policemen saw it they had a whole different attitude towards it.

They couldn't believe what they saw.

Then the big guns descended, the Air Force arrived to investigate and on their heels

was nightcap.

Next thing I know here come this guy from the Air Force.

They had a truckload of guys that taped off the whole area out there and put a guard on

That's when Butcher says he was threatened by the Air Force officer in charge for taking

And I pondered the question, how does the moon get into the flames?

And the only way that that is possible is when there is a lunar eclipse, the moon turns an orange-brown as the earth's shadow falls on the moon.

The accuracy of his predictions has created a tidal wave of email for Damien Memorial High School.

Lee was just coming up for air when sightings revisited the school.

After the last segment of sightings, we were just overwhelmed with about 17,000 hits on our website page.

So Mike Lee is now modifying astronomy software so he can teach his prediction method to the public.

The goal is to inform and reassure us, and perhaps to save millions of lives.

The email that I've been getting with people who are interested in the 1997 predictions have been telling me,

So they're not panicking out, they're taking it very rationally and heads up.
