Mr. Slides in the sky, they were like stars.

It just like was sliding through the sky and it tilted like it was looking down at us.

It was a bright light that dimmed down to a white speck and went back to a red light, down to a white speck and then just disappeared.

Last year there were almost 4,000 reported UFO sightings in the United States,

2,000 in South America, more than 1,000 in Asia, and over 3,000 in the Soviet Union.

The worldwide total was over 10,000.

UFO investigators wonder why those numbers have increased dramatically in the past 45 years.

The modern age of UFOs began in 1947.

Although there are no photographs, Arnold had a drawing made of what he saw.

Meanwhile, sightings by credible witnesses continued.

Military pilots saw things.

Local sheriffs in Dexter, Michigan saw things.

While there was somewhat of an oval shape, looked like a toy top.

Sightings of unexplained phenomena weren't limited to just the United States.

47

Marina Popovich, a Soviet pilot with over 100 airspeed and endurance records to her credit,

had her first UFO encounter in the mountains of southern Russia.

My first contact with the UFO was a rather special experience.

50

It was in the mountains and I saw a sharp ray coming out of a huge sparkling ball.

Even some of the men in the world who have been in space have reported seeing things they can't explain.

Gemini and Apollo astronaut James McDivitt had his own encounter in June of 1966,

while in orbit above the Earth, an unidentified object outside the window caught his attention.

I happened to glance out one time and there against the black sky was a white object.

55

Geometry of it was sort of like a beer can or a coke can with a pencil sticking out,

one of the round edges at about a 45-degree angle.

57

What was it? McDivitt was able to snap a few pictures,

58

00:05:21,520 --> 00:05:25,520

but after turning the film over to NASA, the photographs disappeared.

He suggests it's conceivable that other civilizations could have the technological know-how to make space travel possible.

And he's not alone in his belief.

A 1990 Gallup poll showed that nearly 50% of Americans believe in the existence of UFOs.

The images are scratched out of focus, but the camera is just too far away to see things clearly.

But with the advent of the home video camera, more and more people have captured unexplained phenomena on tape.

This home video was shot over Las Vegas in early 1991.

It shows three objects floating and diving in front of the mountains.

67

This is spectacular maneuver. As you see, it goes in front of the mountains.

It has the mountain as a backdrop, which gives you a fairly good idea of its distance.

69

In Galt Breeze, Florida, something that looks like a spacecraft was caught floating just above the tree line.

70

Videos like this have convinced quite a few Galt Breeze residents that UFOs are real.

71

A small town located just across the bridge from Pensacola.

72

It's been one of the busiest places in the United States for UFO sightings since 1987.

73

We have over 500 witnesses and we have about 262 recorded sightings.

And we've investigated almost 200 of those.

The investigations have been conducted by a small group of Galt Breeze residents.

Most are members of MUFON, the Mutual UFO Network, a grassroots national organization of private

citizens

who've taken it upon themselves to try to get to the bottom of the UFO mystery.

One possible explanation has surfaced.

79

Galt Breeze is virtually surrounded by three major militants, all with extensive air traffic.

80

We call the military. We're told, no, we did not have anything in the area at the time that you had your sighting.

81

Of course, there would be those that say, well, that's the typical military response,

82

even if there was something going on, they would deny it.

83

The wave of sightings in Galt Breeze started with this man, Ed Walters.

84

00:07:28,520 --> 00:07:34,520

In November of 1987, Ed and his wife, Francis, took some amazing photographs of a flying saucer.

85

Fearing ridicule, Ed first kept the pictures to himself, but then he sent them to the Galt Breeze Sentinel, the local newspaper.

86

Publisher Duane Cook knew his reputation would be on the line if he decided to print the pictures.

87

00:07:47,520 --> 00:07:54,520

I was nervous, naturally, and my folks came in Wednesday afternoon while we were putting the paper together.

88

And I said, you're not going to believe what we're getting ready to run in this week's paper.

89

00:07:59,520 --> 00:08:04,520

I showed them the pictures and they looked at them and said, that's what we saw.

90

So at that point, I more or less lost my fear of going with it because, you know, if your own folks see it, if you can't trust them, who can you trust?

91

As it turns out, at least a dozen other people saw the same thing that night, including Art Hufford and several other people who then became members of MUFON.

92

I never felt more alone than I felt that day, November 11, 1987, seeing this thing and then later, nobody's saying very much,

93

and then, of course, several weeks later, you know, people were coming forward and fortunately, you came forward a month later and said, hey, I saw that same thing.

Dr. Bruce McAvie, an expert photo analyst employed by the Navy with over 20 years' experience, spent several months studying the Walters' pictures.

95

McAvie also had Walters use a stereo Polaroid camera the next time he saw something.

96

00:08:55,520 --> 00:09:06,520

Some of his early photos contemplated the possibility that they were hoaxed by a double exposure method, but there is a question of whether or not anybody knows how to photo, how to fake stereo pictures and do it well.

97

I concluded that doing the photography, if it was a hoax, combined with all the other sightings, the testimony of Ed and his family, the intensive investigation all ruled out the possibility that this was a hoax.

And so I concluded in late May of 1988 that it was real.

Since 1987, South Shoreline Park has become a magnet for sky watching.

100

The sky watchers have been able to videotape several unidentified objects.

Most of them look like nothing more than small points of light in the sky, but close examination has revealed that the lights are doing something that science says is impossible.

They move at odd angles, change size, travel at unheard of speeds, all while never making a sound.

One of the more recent videos shows a light that was red and all of a sudden it turns white and starts flashing.

It's an extremely brilliant pulses of light.

105

It appears as if the actual size of the image, which would be related to the size of the light source itself, changed in like 1 30th of a second or so from one TV frame to the next.

We don't have anything that could do that so far as I know.

While the encounters continue in Florida, the most recent UFO observations have occurred thousands of miles away in Belgium.

An amateur photographer videotaped this triangular shaped object in early 1991.

Last year there were 500 sightings in all of Europe.

So far this year reports in Belgium alone have totaled over 3500.

From prehistoric cave art to medieval frescoes to videotapes in Florida and Belgium, people have been recording strange things they've seen in the skies.

What are they? Perhaps the answer lies out beyond the stars, at this point just out of our reach.

First, the bodies of cattle, horses and occasionally wild animals, mutilated by some sort of high-tech equipment.

144

Second are crop circles, enormous elaborate designs that appear overnight stamped into the fields, as if by some heavenly artist.

145

To my amazement, there was a huge circle in an all-seed rape field up there.

146

I nearly crashed the car because I was so excited.

147

00:13:54,520 --> 00:13:58,520

The crop circle phenomenon began in the mid-1970s.

148

00:13:58,520 --> 00:14:06,520

English farmers started finding giant circles in their fields, pressed into their crops with the precision of a cookie cutter.

149

00:14:06,520 --> 00:14:11,520

Many thought it must all be some kind of hoax or perhaps funny weather.

150

00:14:11,520 --> 00:14:18,520

It was strange though, there were never any unusual tracks leading out to the circles and no

reports of odd weather.

151

00:14:18,520 --> 00:14:24,520

Bappled scientists flocked to circle locations hoping to find a reasonable explanation for the phenomenon.

152

00:14:24,520 --> 00:14:31,520

But one by one, theories blaming disease, helicopters, tornadoes and hoax artists were shot down.

153

I've come across many hoaxes and you can tell them within two minutes because the normal circles, the corners,

154

are simply gently moved down and the stalks are not broken.

155

Anybody that tries to reproduce a hoax circle by chain, trampling, any way you may think will damage the structure of the crop involved.

156

What does it all mean? Well, this is one case where your guess is probably as good as any.

157

There are as yet no prevailing theories on how the circles are being formed.

158

Remember we are stepping into the unknown.

159

Banded together into an organization for scientific examination of the circles, British researchers are baffled with the fact

160

that bent over crops keep growing and show no signs of any physical contact.

161

They say their evidence does indicate the circles are formed in about 5 to 10 seconds and are caused by some tugging force,

162

though the roots are not pulled from the soil.

163

And the circles aren't confined only to Britain.

164

This is the first time we've seen such a situation.

165

Japan is one of the many places crop circles have shown up in the last few years, along with Canada and here in the United States.

166

Throughout the Midwest, in towns like Mylan, Illinois.

167

I thought, how could anything do that without it didn't come out of the sky and come down here.

168

They almost come down and do this because there's no way it could get in here.

169

00:15:52,520 --> 00:15:54,520

No alien droppings whatsoever.

170

00:15:54,520 --> 00:16:01,520

It might be a tornado or some kind of a wind, but why would it be exactly 46 and a half, no matter how you measure it, it's 46 and a half.

171

During the last few years, while the rest of the world got used to the appearance of crop circles, British farmers found their encounters changing.

172

Now they weren't just circles anymore.

173

The most amazing thing was that in 1990, in May, we started getting these pictograms, which are these dumbbell or barbell shaped formations with various features coming out of them.

Features like hands and claws, semi-circles on the end, all of these things.

175

We've never seen anything like that before.

176

00:16:33,520 --> 00:16:44,520

The British hoaxsters who recently claimed credit for the crop circles could demonstrate only the crudest designs, and the quality and quality of their handiwork left most experts unconvinced.

177

When you go into the extra pieces that were there, the claw features, key pattern, that sort of thing, we found they were still as precise, and the claw patterns were very, very precise.

178

00:16:57,520 --> 00:17:06,520

It is impossible to reproduce an entire structure like that, which is nearly 300 feet in length, without creating an immense amount of damage in its construction.

179

00:17:06,520 --> 00:17:12,520

Despite attempts by a wide range of experts, no one has been able to photograph a circle being made.

180

00:17:12,520 --> 00:17:22,520

But strange sounds have often been recorded lingering within the circle area, sounds that can best be described as a trilling noise.

181

And researchers do get plenty of reports of strange sightings.

182

00:17:27,520 --> 00:17:44,520

Oh, at least 20 or more cases of circles which have formed following UFO activity, or following globes of light which have descended into the field, or lights which have shone beams down into the field.

183

00:17:44,520 --> 00:17:49,520

Clearly they seem to be related to electromagnetism, there's overwhelming evidence of that.

184

00:17:49,520 --> 00:17:54,520

But how electromagnetic forces can produce this effect, we don't know.

185

What I think is becoming very clear now is that we are forced to conclude that because these patterns are very symmetrical and very beautiful, that they are designs.

186

They are designs, and therefore there's a designer, and therefore there's an intelligence of some sort behind the design.

187

00:18:12,520 --> 00:18:23,520

This is the fifth cattle steer that's been mutilated since mid-spring of this year.

188

00:18:23,520 --> 00:18:31,520

North American livestock farmers are also dealing with a strange phenomenon that's been classified as a close encounter of the second kind.

189

00:18:31,520 --> 00:18:35,520

Although this one is as repulsive as the crop circles are beautiful.

190

00:18:35,520 --> 00:18:41,520

Since the mid-60s, some ranchers in the American and Canadian West have been finding dead animals in their fields.

191

00:18:41,520 --> 00:18:50,520

Investigators have dismissed predators as a probable cause because there are rarely any tracks around the body, not even the tracks of the animal itself.

192

00:18:50,520 --> 00:19:02,520

The carcasses are usually neatly cut open, organs removed with surgical precision, and as Joel Bradshaw discovered on his ranch in Arkansas, the aftermath is an oddly bloodless scene.

193

00:19:02,520 --> 00:19:12,520

The blood had been taken away. There was no blood, no word. You could take a piece of white piece of cloth and lay it in it, and you didn't get no blood or nothing.

194

00:19:12,520 --> 00:19:17,520

Some have said cult followers are to blame, but medical evidence makes that unlikely.

195

00:19:17,520 --> 00:19:28,520

Tissue samples sent to Oregon State University for testing showed that high heat had been used to make the strange, rippled incisions, heat like that of a medical laser.

196

00:19:28,520 --> 00:19:40,520

So maybe it's the work of high-tech cultists. Well, medical lasers didn't even exist when this phenomenon began, and even today's so-called portable lasers require a generator the size of a large freezer.

197

Many farmers say they don't need medical evidence. They know their fields very well, and animals and humans would leave evidence behind.

198

00:19:48,520 --> 00:19:59,520

Human beings will always make mistakes along that line. They'll forget something or drop something, or put there's no sign, you can go off 50 yards around, it's never fine any.

199

00:19:59,520 --> 00:20:05,520

As with crop circles, UFO sightings often seem to precede the mutilations.

200

00:20:05,520 --> 00:20:20,520

There have been possibly 15,000 of these cases in the United States and Canada since the 60s, and you look at the records, you look at if there's anybody been prosecuted, has anybody been arrested, and you don't find that.

201

You don't find any prosecutions, you don't find any arrests.

202

00:20:24,520 --> 00:20:38,520

In a forensic sense, you use all the information, you look at all of it, and when you get all of that information and you run it through a sieve, you come out that there is some other non-human entity doing this.

203

The Chief Intelligence Officer at the base, Major Jesse Marcell Sr., was sent out to the ranch to collect the crash debris and transport it to the Army Air Force headquarters for examination.
