It is the medium that you as a phantom, as an apparition, view your target.

How do they teach you to get to that place, to be able to go into the ether?

167

Initially, you go through a long extended period of lecture.

168

Where you're taught, everything that there is to know,

169

theory-wise, about remote viewing.

170

The normal human being would scratch their heads and go,

171

well, wait a minute, that doesn't make sense.

172

How does that work?

173

And I ask that question often until my trainer would turn to me and say,

you know, we don't know how this works, really.

Project Sunstrike monitored the officers as they entered the deep sea of the area.

Project Sunstrike monitored the officers as they entered the deep state of relaxation,

178

the ether, necessary to begin a remote viewing.

179

The men were then given a set of coded coordinates and asked to go there,

180

00:15:59,000 --> 00:16:05,000

psychically, to see with the mind's eye what was happening at that location.

In the years that you worked with this agency,

182

you were sent to many, many different operational targets, including Desert Storm.

What did you see there?

I think the probably one that sticks most in my mind that was most concerning to me

185

was the plume of smoke created by the oil fire.

What I saw in this smoke plume was, and I know that others saw it as well,

187

a biological agent that had been released into this cloud.

Some remote viewers have speculated that this biological agent may be responsible

189

00:16:43,000 --> 00:16:48,000

for the as-yet undiagnosed illnesses suffered by Desert Storm veterans.

190

Flight 803 over Lockerbie, Scotland. You were sent there after it came there.

191

00:16:53,000 --> 00:17:01,000

A few hours after that aircraft exploded, we were asked to begin work on that particular project.

192

Several of the remote viewers drew in their sketches, saw this radio device,

193

00:17:07,000 --> 00:17:10,000

and saw an explosive in the radio device.

194

00:17:10,000 --> 00:17:15,000

A very good friend of mine, Mel Riley, who is certainly one of the best remote viewers that there ever was.

195

00:17:15,000 --> 00:17:24,000

I can remember him standing in the fuselage and finding himself turning to these souls

196

00:17:24,000 --> 00:17:28,000

that now their physical bodies are obviously plummeting towards Earth.

197

00:17:28,000 --> 00:17:35,000

And I remember Mel trying to tell people that they had died.

198

00:17:35,000 --> 00:17:39,000

They were all gone now. That this is what had happened.

199

00:17:39,000 --> 00:17:48,000

That is a tremendous amount of emotional and spiritual pain that you are asked to grasp, to embrace.

200

But it takes a tremendous toll on you as a human being to have to experience that.

201

And the toll it took on David Morehouse and his family was irreparable.

202

Unable to talk about the horrifying visions with anyone, David withdrew

203

00:18:02,000 --> 00:18:09,000

through increasingly anxious and like a lot of other remote viewers, David felt he was losing his mind.

204

The people who were put in this program and put in the position of remote viewing, I think they were totally unprepared, psychological.

205

Dave Morehouse, who had a very conventional, traditional, up-raising schooling,

206

00:18:24,000 --> 00:18:30,000

and suddenly he's into this program of just mind-boggling dimensions.

207

One of the worst things that happens to remote viewers is they develop a messiah complex.

208

You think you're God?

209

00:18:38,000 --> 00:18:43,000

Yeah, you think you're God. You can go forward and backwards in time.

210

00:18:43,000 --> 00:18:53,000

You can experience any event and manifest the physiological aspects of that event, remote in time and space.

211

00:18:53,000 --> 00:19:01,000

When you go back and see the ground zero at Hiroshima or crawl amongst the bones and ashes in the ovens of Dachau as a remote viewer,

212

00:19:01,000 --> 00:19:08,000

and you go home that night, what do you say to your wife? What does she say to you? How was your day at the office, honey?

213

00:19:08,000 --> 00:19:13,000

You start to lose the ability to communicate to the rest of humanity.

214

But David's emotional connection to his remote viewing targets was not the reason he dropped out of the project.

215

That decision came, he says, after he realized that remote viewing was being tested not only as an intelligence tool,

216

but also as a weapon of psychological destruction.

217

They knew that it could go far beyond where it was today. They wanted to be able to kill with it.

218

00:19:40,000 --> 00:19:48,000

I always believed that this gift, as we referred to it, was something that could benefit all of humankind.

219

And it goes back to my vision after being shot in the head that seek a road to peace.

220

Seek a road to peace. Stop being what you are, what you are is wrong.

221

So I felt that I had a moral and an ethical responsibility to bring that information forward to humankind.

222

After he dropped out, David was discharged less than honorably.

223

His family and friends received anonymous threats.

224

00:20:19,000 --> 00:20:26,000

But the scariest thing for me was the night that they tried to kill my wife and my children.

225

00:20:26,000 --> 00:20:44,000

And that was really tough for me to accept after I had given so much as an officer to the Army.

226

00:20:44,000 --> 00:20:52,000

Now I don't think that Army guys did this and I don't think that some general officer setting in the Pentagon ordered a hit on my wife and family.

227

But do I think that the Central Intelligence Agency did it? Yeah.

228
