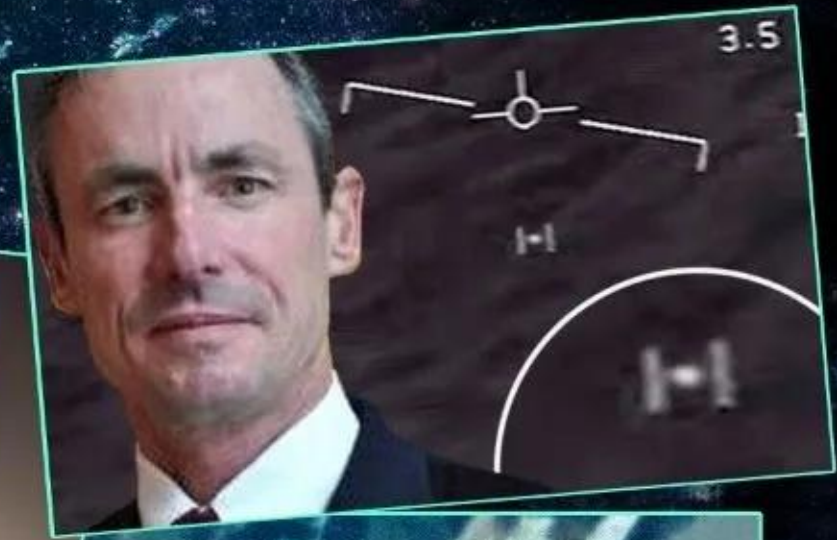

method we have full control over our instruments we calibrate them so everything will be open

180

um the government is not an open organization it's not a scientific organization they are

181

focused primarily on National Security matters and it makes sense for them to hide data because

182

of the sensors being used to adversaries so

183

for national security purposes obviously we
want to know if there are any spy balloons

184

it's right behind it is actually 4.2 miles
away and this is our first indication that

here but if you can get the bearing and range
