On the UAP issue, yes. I'm liking where we're going. I think there's a lot of energy still and we just have to deal with the politics, especially in Washington and Congress right now.

Ryan Graves is a fascinating person. He's a very brave person.

He was one of the first people to speak out about his anomalous experiences and his encounters with UAP as a fighter pilot while he was still enlisted.

Ryan is the perfect person to be talking about air safety issues with regard to UAP.

I have been reaching out to pilots globally. I've spoken to pilots Central America, South America, Europe, Middle East, Eastern Asia, Australia.

and taking the bones of children to construct these things and sell them and to have them paraded around to a global audience.

No they're not.

Because I want to believe in it so bad.

479

Because it's so fun.

You know, the idea of spaceships coming here from another galaxy.

It takes away from legitimate science that's being done with regard to studying this phenomenon.

But the more we talk about this, it's important to debate these things.

People are often very reluctant to talk about their anomalous experiences.

What is it?

Be careful, be careful. What is that?

However, partially due to the work of Leslie Kane and Ralph Blumenthal with that amazing bombshell front page New York Times article back in 2017,

and then another level of people that are more willing to talk about this publicly like myself.

508

Whoa!

It's holly ass. Wow. It's got to be a drone or something.

510

That's either a drone or a UFO. You just see how it moved. That was incredible.

An experimenter is anybody that has had anomalous experiences of any and all kinds.

512

That could be UAP encounters, encounters with non-human entities,

513

and that is kind of hard for the general public to often wrap their head around.

514

The family says something crashed into their backyard, prompting them to call 911,

515

saying they saw creatures walking around.

There is a popular conception that people that have anomalous encounters are coops,

517

and that couldn't be further from the truth.

What I found is that we have people that have had high-level positions in Fortune 500 companies.

519

Doctors, lawyers, these are people that have a lot on the line in terms of their profession,

520

in terms of their families, and often they can't talk about these situations that have happened with them.

521

But the stigma comes in because people don't want to handle that this is something real that people have seen.

522

So you immediately, when you poke your head up and people say,

okay, this is what I saw, they're demoralized, almost instantaneously.

Initially, I actually wasn't scared. It was like a sense of wonder, but that feeling was only a couple seconds.

540

Very quickly, almost at once, the being off the foot of my bed started moving towards me.

541

And as it started moving towards me, the other being raised its arm that had this wand in its hand towards me.

And at that point, I was terrified. And I don't remember what happened after that.

543

Let's make no mistake here. Many, many, many people have stated that they've had such experiences.

There are people that have lost their loved ones that have gotten divorced.

There are people that have lost access to their own children and that has even more severe implications.

565

And that some of these people that lose their families or have lost their jobs because word got around, they lost their reputations.

There's a reason why we need to get past this stigma and why we need to be able to talk about these situations.

A pair of Harvard scientists say a massive fast-moving visitor to our solar system may have been a probe sent by an advanced alien civilization.

571

Oumuamu is the first observed object to come from outside of our solar system.

And get this, once it got here it behaved in ways that scientists can't quite explain.

573

My name is Avi Loeb. I'm the director of the Institute for Theory and Computation at Harvard University.

574

In 2017 there was an object detected by a telescope in Hawaii called Panstars.

575

And this object was moving too fast to be bound to the sun.

576

00:50:51,080 --> 00:50:52,080

Oumuamua, is that what I said?

577

00:50:52,080 --> 00:50:53,080

Yes, that's the right thing.

578

Oumuamua, which is an object that we detected in space that you believe could possibly have been extraterrestrial in origin, meaning from some sort of a civilization.

579

Right.

580

00:51:05,080 --> 00:51:10,080

Oumuamua was detected as a near-earth object the size of a football field.

581

00:51:10,080 --> 00:51:16,080

It became clear that it's most likely flat in its shape, very unusual for a rock.

582

Moreover, it was pushed away from the sun by some mysterious force, which is also unusual for a rock.

583

That can happen if you have a comet that sheds mass evaporates.

584

And there was no cometary tail around this object.

585

00:51:32,080 --> 00:51:37,080

First of all, this is historic, this discovery, because they've never seen something that's come from outside of our solar system.

586

It has a shape that scientists have never seen before, and at one point it sped up, and they couldn't explain why.

587

So a lot of mysteries, a lot of theories, one of them now is somebody came by to check us out.

588

The question is who manufactured Oumuamua.

589

The more data we collected about this object, the more anomalous it was.

590

It led me to suggest that maybe it's pushed by reflecting sunlight.

591

And for that it had to be very thin, like a sail.

592

00:52:05,080 --> 00:52:12,080

And nature doesn't make thin objects of that type, and so I suggested maybe it's artificial in origin.

593

Finding whether we are alone is one of the most fundamental questions.

594

Unfortunately, the situation is quite polarized right now because mobs on social media come together to just attack me personally.

595

And in a non-professional way.

596

00:52:26,080 --> 00:52:31,080

And find that disturbing because this is the way science should be done.

597

00:52:31,080 --> 00:52:35,080

Science is always about narrowing the scope of what the possible answers might be.

598

The data can provide this, and then you do successive experiments to narrow the scope until ET might be somewhere within the scope of that question.

599

Avi Lo did exactly this.

600

00:52:48,080 --> 00:52:55,080

When you rule out the impossible, whatever remains as improbable as it is, must be the truth.

601

00:52:55,080 --> 00:53:01,080

They will go as far as saying it's insulting to science to actually suggest this is alien.

602

00:53:01,080 --> 00:53:04,080

As scientists, you provide a theory, you offer evidence.

603

00:53:04,080 --> 00:53:09,080

You don't say, well, you can't prove your theory, so this must be a possibility as well.

604

00:53:09,080 --> 00:53:11,080

And even they're saying it's just clickbait, so don't be fooled.

605

Just clickbait?

606

Nevertheless, you hear others claiming that it's an embarrassment to science.

607

This is unfortunate because this is the way for us to gain new knowledge.

We have to be open-minded.

We need scientists on this.

Science used to be a realm where you're exploring the unknown.

611

That was the whole point.

612

If it's unknown, let's look at it.

613

But with this topic, you see a resistance to that.

614

This is really disappointing to me that people, instead of being inspired, are trying to step on every flower that rises above the grass level.

615

Jackie Farity is an astrophysicist at the American Museum of Natural History.

616

She says, oh, Muamua did not give off any signals suggesting it was a spacecraft.

617

If you say that the top 10 lists of explanations does not include Alien Probe, what is on that list?

618

It's a comet.

619

00:54:06,080 --> 00:54:07,080

Or an asteroid.

Or an asteroid, a rock.

621

Where is alien civilization on the list of explanations?

622

I don't know.

623

Real low.

624

00:54:13,080 --> 00:54:14,080

Real low.

625

00:54:14,080 --> 00:54:20,080

Now, even scientists, other scientists in his discipline, came out and said, oh, it couldn't possibly be.

626

Or, you know, Avi's gone off the ranch.

627

00:54:23,080 --> 00:54:24,080

No, he hadn't.

628

00:54:24,080 --> 00:54:27,080

He's just said that it's within the scope of possible answers.

629

It is absolutely true to say that the scientific community has been not just skeptical of UFOs for generations, but I would say fairly hostile.

630

And an aversion.

631

And more than an aversion, a fear, a genuine deep-seated fear of being tainted by this subject.

632

When you get scientists with that level of hubris, it's really hard to backtrack from there and start considering other possibilities.

633

Now, this thing's got to be like a ship, right?

634

That looks too much like a spaceship.

So, so, the reason why it's probably not aliens is its trajectory around the sun was completely determined by gravitational forces.

636

Because we not, we calculate this.

638

Neil deGrasse Tyson needs to grow up.

639

I think Neil deGrasse Tyson is jealous.

640

You can publish that.

641

He's acting more like an astrologer than an astronomer.

642

He's acting more like a priest.

643

Look at the people who are the most against it.

644

They're actually not practicing scientists.

645

They're opinion scientists.

646

00:55:30,080 --> 00:55:36,080

When's the last time any of these people have actually been anywhere near a laboratory or near a measurement device?

647

The signal we get from it is elongated, but it's probably a rubble pile stretched into that shape.

648

Because you don't get that by nature.

649

You don't get that.

Yeah, that's why it's man-made.

651

Alien-made.

Alien-made.

You want that to be aliens.

654

That's what, that's up.

You want that to be aliens.

Of course I want that to be aliens.

657

These people should be forced to give back their PhDs.

658

If you're not going to honor your oath of how you're going to address and approach data and openness to ideas,

659

and you're going to use ridicule, you've lost.

If this were aliens in some kind of advanced ship, it would be maneuvering.

661

Any chance that's a tennis ball?

Very quickly, faster than any rocket that we can launch, that's why we couldn't really chase it when it was receding away from us.

And it came from outside the solar system.

672

So, you know, I just do one plus one equal two.

673

I say, okay, it looks very peculiar.

674

Maybe it belongs to another civilization.

675

I attended a colloquium about t'omu'a mua at Harvard University,

and I left the room after it was over with a colleague of mine that worked on space rocks for decades.

677

That colleague said, t'omu'a mua is so weird, I wish it never existed.

678

To me, that's exactly the opposite of the way a scientist should approach anomalous data.

679

It should be an exciting opportunity to learn something new.

680

00:57:35,080 --> 00:57:37,080

It should be inspiring.

681

That should be a situation that we aspire to have.

682

So, I actually see it as a blessing, you know?

683

I can't imagine why anybody would be upset that it exists.

684

Like, I wish it didn't exist. That's kind of hilarious.

Because it takes you away from your comfort zone, you know?

There are lots of people who imagine that we are unique and special.

687

Obviously, that flutters our ego.

It's really important to recognize that the Earth is not the descent of the world.

So, reality puts constraints on our imagination.

But we need to adapt to that and accept the verdict of experimental data evidence

And unfortunately, within the public, lots of people have opinions.

Here to introduce itself to all of us, interstellar asteroid, uma mua.

Oh, hi guys!

I'm uma mua mua. I'm just visiting your solar system.

696

00:58:35,080 --> 00:58:38,080

You know, I'm on traveling. I'm on holiday.

And in the scientific community, you have exactly the same situation

698

00:58:41,080 --> 00:58:46,080

where scientists prefer to argue that we are alone.

699

So that is the main damage that I see to innovation in science.

700

And of course, it suppresses our ability to gain new knowledge about our cosmic neighborhood.

701

We at NASA are acutely aware of the considerable public interest in UAP.

702

However, it's critical to understand any form of harassment towards our panelists

703
