Chairman Schiff Applauds Passage of 2022 Intelligence Authorization Act

Washington DC, September 30, 2021

Today, the House Intelligence Committee approved the Fiscal Year 2022 Intelligence Authorization Act through a bipartisan voice vote, authorizing funding for comprehensive congressional oversight of the Intelligence Community. The measure ensures the protection of civil liberties, provides for our personnel, and authorizes the resources intelligence professionals need to safeguard national security.

"One of our committee's principal responsibilities is crafting an Intelligence Authorization Act that keeps our country secure while ensuring the Congress' ability to conduct vigorous oversight of the Intelligence Community. The measure ensures the protection of civil liberties, provides for our personnel, and provides for the resources intelligence professionals need to safeguard national security," said Schiff. "The bill passed out of the committee today with the support of all of our Members and staff on both sides of the aisle."
