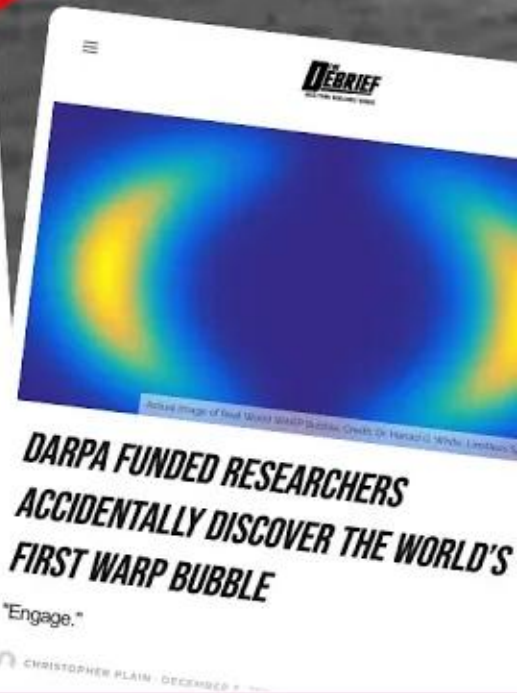

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2 This Act may be cited as the "National Defense Au-
3 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2022".
4 SEC. 2. ORGANIZATION OF ACT INTO DIVISIONS; TABLE OF

(a) DIVISIONS.—This Act is organized into six divi-
