At 10.15pm, everything suddenly goes black.

7

The Hills believe that at that moment they were abducted.

8

00:00:30,949 --> 00:00:38,230

Betty and Barney Hill case stirred up a whole new range of interest in alien abductions.

9

00:00:38,230 --> 00:00:41,750

I'd seen several UFOs I'd been experimented on.

10

00:00:41,750 --> 00:00:46,270

Why would a guy in a small town start talking about his abduction experience unless he really,

11

really believed it happened to him?

12

00:00:48,230 --> 00:00:51,670

People were taken aboard spacecraft by extraterrestrials.

13

The stay-in has something to do with the abduction event.

14

They were biologically related.

15

00:00:56,070 --> 00:01:01,990

And with brand new leads and physical evidence never before seen, the team examines the phenomenon

16

of alien abduction.

17

This is the key case with the best evidence in all the abduction scenarios around.

The team from UFO Magazine opens case number 61203.

Abductions.

Why is it that people think of that image whenever they hear the word alien?

You know the big eyes and the big head.

34

How do we even know what aliens really look like?

35

That was an idealization of the image that Betty and Barney Hill first talked about when

36

they drew that image after their abduction in 1961 in New Hampshire.

37

00:02:27,834 --> 00:02:32,514

And that began the whole ball of wax in the United States of America.

38

00:02:32,514 --> 00:02:38,354

When you look at the 1950s, that golden age of UFO contact, they all call themselves contactees.

39

But the Betty and Barney Hill case, contactees, become abductees.

40

00:02:45,755 --> 00:02:49,075

September 19, 1961.

41

00:02:49,075 --> 00:02:54,035

Betty and Barney Hill are returning from a vacation in Canada, driving south on Route

42

00:02:54,035 --> 00:02:57,195

3 near Franconia, Notch, New Hampshire.

43

00:02:57,195 --> 00:03:02,835

I kept driving and driving and driving.

44

00:03:02,835 --> 00:03:09,236

As they recount, around midnight an abnormally bright star catches their eye.

45

00:03:09,236 --> 00:03:16,596

The hills are puzzled at first, saw it as it swung around to the rear of my car, and

46

00:03:16,596 --> 00:03:17,596

then became terrified.

47

00:03:17,596 --> 00:03:21,916

It is there, it's right above us Betty, look.

48

00:03:21,916 --> 00:03:25,236

They realize the light in the sky seems to be following them.

49

00:03:25,236 --> 00:03:27,956

I was hurrying to get away.

50

00:03:27,956 --> 00:03:32,717

But they first believe to be nothing more than a bright star, becomes to Barney's eyes

51

00:03:32,717 --> 00:03:37,277

a hovering craft 80 feet wide with a double row of windows.

52

00:03:37,277 --> 00:03:39,437

And I made a turn.

53

00:03:39,437 --> 00:03:44,197

The disc reportedly follows them, flying directly over the car.

54

And I don't know why I had to make that turn, and I was lost.

55

And suddenly, all the hills remember next is continuing their drive south on Route 3.

56

To their astonishment, they've somehow lost hours of time.

57

Even though they consciously remembered aspects of the entire incident, they didn't remember

58

what happened in the missing time they experienced between the time they saw the spaceship and

59

the time they were in their car driving back to their house.

60

As will later be recounted in the bestselling book, *Interrupted Journey*, which introduced

61

the hills case to the world.

62

00:04:29,639 --> 00:04:35,959

Under hypnosis, they both reportedly remembered struggling against small figures or humanoids.

63

00:04:35,959 --> 00:04:41,599

They assert that the aliens appeared to regard the hills as laboratory specimens.

64

00:04:41,599 --> 00:04:46,280

One of the most important aspects of the hills case is their claim that their abduction left

65

behind physical evidence.

66

00:04:48,280 --> 00:04:51,400

Guys, if you can get up to New Hampshire, we could reopen this case.

67

And if you can get any evidence out of it, I know just the laboratory is to analyze it.

68

All you do your respective jobs, let's pack our bags and get off to New Hampshire.

The team is in northern New Hampshire to trace the route the hills took that night.

70

You can't study UFOs without seriously pondering the possibility that they will interact with

71

us and therefore can't expunge the abduction phenomenon.

72

We're going to meet Kathy Martin, who is Betty's niece, who was alive at the time of

73

the abduction and she was actually a witness to what happened to Betty and Barney Hill

that night.

Kathy Martin was 13 when she first became aware of the Hills Abduction story.

Following Barney's death on February 25, 1969, Betty grew closer to Kathy and confided

77

private details about her ordeal.

78

00:05:58,602 --> 00:06:04,083

Betty's death in 2004 left Kathy the greatest authority on the subject.

79

00:06:04,083 --> 00:06:07,963

Her book provides new insight into the case.

80

We are heading toward the first encounter, correct?

81

00:06:11,763 --> 00:06:12,763

That's correct.

82

00:06:12,763 --> 00:06:17,083

This is the first location where Betty and Barney actually stopped the car and got out

83

00:06:17,083 --> 00:06:20,483

with the binoculars to take a look at this craft.

84

00:06:20,483 --> 00:06:24,643

According to Kathy, there were three different locations where the hills spotted the alleged

85

00:06:24,643 --> 00:06:27,644

craft as they traveled down Route 3.

86

00:06:27,644 --> 00:06:33,324

First, at the Mount Cleveland picnic area, 17 miles south of Lancaster.

87

00:06:33,324 --> 00:06:35,724

Second, near Cannon Mountain.

88

00:06:35,724 --> 00:06:41,004

And finally, at a lake one mile south of Indian Head, where they stopped the car and were reportedly

89

00:06:41,004 --> 00:06:44,164

abducted.

90

00:06:44,164 --> 00:06:48,844

This is the spot, the Mount Cleveland picnic area.

91

00:06:48,844 --> 00:06:53,485

This was the first stop that Betty and Barney made.

92

00:06:53,485 --> 00:06:57,845

Betty's eyes were drawn to a new light in the sky.

93

00:06:57,845 --> 00:07:00,205

Betty took the binoculars first.

94

00:07:00,205 --> 00:07:02,565

Betty looked at the moon.

95

00:07:02,565 --> 00:07:06,565

And as she was looking, she saw an odd-shaped craft.

96

00:07:06,565 --> 00:07:14,205

It was flashing multicolored points of light as it traveled across the face of the moon.

97

00:07:14,205 --> 00:07:18,366

It just immediately swooped down and no sound.

98

00:07:18,366 --> 00:07:21,686

That was the perplexing thing.

99

00:07:21,686 --> 00:07:24,926

She at that point saw the object shaped.

100

It appeared to be rotating, flashing, blue-white light.

But the craft continued to track the car.

The craft shifted ahead, stopped and descended to within about a hundred feet of their vehicle,

107

causing Barney to stop the car in the middle of the highway.

108

00:08:09,448 --> 00:08:15,528

He looked up at the craft and there were approximately eight to eleven figures in the

109

00:08:15,528 --> 00:08:19,288

window looking down at Barney.

110

00:08:19,288 --> 00:08:21,928

Barney wanted to get away from there in fast.

111

00:08:21,928 --> 00:08:33,689

I was hurrying to get away and I kept driving and driving and driving and I made a turn.

112

00:08:33,689 --> 00:08:38,969

Barney made a left-hand turn onto a dirt road.

113

00:08:38,969 --> 00:08:45,689

But there were about six to eight men in the road and they were confused.

114

00:08:45,689 --> 00:08:48,369

What are these men doing in the road?

115

00:08:48,369 --> 00:08:55,650

I really had no idea until the men divided into two groups and started to approach the

116

car that they weren't human.

117

It is here that things took a violent turn.

118

The men opened the door and took her out.

119

They dragged Barney through the woods to where this craft was waiting.

120

The Hill's alleged abduction site was nothing but open countryside and forest in 1961.

121

00:09:19,530 --> 00:09:26,131

This was the key moment in which they seemed to have crossed from frightened travelers

122

00:09:26,131 --> 00:09:33,531

along a dark road at night to actual abductees and subjects of creatures from another planet.

123

00:09:33,531 --> 00:09:36,091

They were brought here from the road.

124

00:09:36,091 --> 00:09:37,091

That's correct.

125

00:09:37,091 --> 00:09:40,171

And then taken aboard the ship here.

126

00:09:40,171 --> 00:09:44,771

After hypnosis they both revealed that they were taken up a ramp.

127

00:09:44,771 --> 00:09:50,732

Betty engaged in a struggle with these men and this is where her dress was torn.

128

00:09:50,732 --> 00:09:52,532

Betty was taken on board the craft.

129

00:09:52,532 --> 00:09:55,892

Barney was taken to a room ahead of her.

130

00:09:55,892 --> 00:09:59,292

At which point they were subjected to various sets of medical experiments.

131

00:09:59,292 --> 00:10:03,372

Medical experiments and specimens were taken from their bodies.

132

00:10:03,372 --> 00:10:08,532

According to her account, Betty asked the alien entity where it came from and was shown

133

00:10:08,532 --> 00:10:13,413

a three-dimensional map of stars connected by a variety of lines.

134

00:10:13,413 --> 00:10:19,573

Incredibly, during a hypnosis session over six months later, Betty was able to accurately

135

recreate this star map.

After the experiments were complete, the Hills alleged they were led back to the car.

137

00:10:30,293 --> 00:10:32,893

Barney was taken down a path to the vehicle.

138

00:10:32,893 --> 00:10:39,734

Betty was escorted by the leader down to the vehicle and watched the craft leave.

139

00:10:39,734 --> 00:10:46,334

I was unaware myself of how much they remembered without any kind of aid by a psychiatrist,

140

00:10:46,334 --> 00:10:48,974

regression or hypnosis.

141

00:10:48,974 --> 00:10:56,294

In the early morning hours after the incident, September 20th, 1961, the Hills returned home.

142

00:10:56,294 --> 00:11:01,375

They knew something had happened, but they could not account for the two missing hours.

143

00:11:01,375 --> 00:11:06,935

After that day, Betty noticed something unusual on the dress she wore the previous night.

144

00:11:06,935 --> 00:11:13,095

An unknown pink powder coated the dress, even though she had no memory yet of being abducted

145

00:11:13,095 --> 00:11:17,255

and no recollection of coming in contact with a pink powder.

146

00:11:17,255 --> 00:11:23,495

Something compelled her to hang the dress in the closet without having it cleaned.

147

00:11:23,495 --> 00:11:32,256

No one bothered to even do any testing in 1961 on any of the evidence.

148

00:11:32,256 --> 00:11:39,296

Nobody took a look at Betty's dress in 1961, that dress that was torn at the zipper.

149

00:11:39,296 --> 00:11:45,136

Now this case, as opposed to almost all other abduction cases, actually has some physical

150

00:11:45,136 --> 00:11:49,657

evidence that we can look at.

151

00:11:49,657 --> 00:11:56,337

The Hills Abduction entered popular culture first through the 1966 book Interrupted Journey.

152

00:11:56,337 --> 00:12:01,857

The book became a best seller when Look Magazine serialized the story in its October 4th and

153

00:12:01,857 --> 00:12:05,137

18th issues that same year.

154

00:12:05,137 --> 00:12:10,217

As he stared downward, he seemed very impersonal and I suddenly felt like a tiny bug waiting

155

00:12:10,217 --> 00:12:15,858

to be snatched, like I was some sort of specimen and it was the eeriest feeling.

156

00:12:15,858 --> 00:12:22,138

In 1975, the book was made into the UFO incident, a television movie starring James Earl Jones.

157

00:12:22,138 --> 00:12:23,138

It's coming closer.

158

00:12:23,138 --> 00:12:24,138

It is not.

159

00:12:24,138 --> 00:12:25,138

It is not coming closer.

160

00:12:25,138 --> 00:12:26,138

It's just way out there.

161

00:12:26,138 --> 00:12:27,138

Ready?

162

00:12:27,138 --> 00:12:32,618

We're just going to make me believe.

163

00:12:32,618 --> 00:12:35,378

What are our criteria for alien abduction?

164

00:12:35,378 --> 00:12:41,419

According to the people who study this, the abducting has to be taken against his or her

165

00:12:41,419 --> 00:12:43,539

will.

166

00:12:44,539 --> 00:12:52,139

Two, the aliens have to transport the abductee somewhere usually to a quote unquote mothership.

167

Finally, the person is returned to wherever the person has experienced some missing time,

168

00:12:59,939 --> 00:13:01,299

like Betty and Bonnie Hill.

169

00:13:01,299 --> 00:13:05,660

To me the problem is you get various people making these claims that they've been abducted

170

00:13:05,660 --> 00:13:10,860

and the media tends to pick up on these things and then it publishes this which sort of propagates

171

00:13:10,860 --> 00:13:15,100

the myth of what the little green men should look like and what the saucers should look

172

00:13:15,100 --> 00:13:16,100

like.

173

00:13:16,100 --> 00:13:19,020

People read that and people have their own experiences and they tend to fit it to that

174

00:13:19,020 --> 00:13:23,100

and it seems to be kind of a vicious cycle that propagates the myth.

175

00:13:23,100 --> 00:13:27,780

Although thousands of UFO abductions have been reported, the vast majority of cases

176

00:13:27,780 --> 00:13:29,821

have been dismissed as bogus.

177

00:13:29,821 --> 00:13:35,621

But the Betty and Bonnie Hill case has to this day remained an open mystery.

178

00:13:35,621 --> 00:13:40,421

According to the team, there is something quite different about this case.

179

00:13:40,981 --> 00:13:43,421

The real physical evidence was left behind.

180

00:13:43,421 --> 00:13:48,141

There were highly polished spots on the trunk of the vehicle.

181

00:13:48,141 --> 00:13:52,141

There were large, shiny spots on the trunk of the car.

182

00:13:52,141 --> 00:13:54,582

About the size of \$12.

183

00:13:54,582 --> 00:13:59,342

Fortunately we also had a neighbor who was a physicist and he recommended that Betty

184

00:13:59,342 --> 00:14:04,702

take a compass out around the car to see how the needle of the compass would react.

185

00:14:04,702 --> 00:14:08,382

Just got the compass anywhere near them.

186

00:14:08,382 --> 00:14:13,382

The compass kept spinning around and around and around.

187

00:14:13,382 --> 00:14:17,582

You would place the compass anywhere other than on the spot.

188

00:14:17,582 --> 00:14:20,103

It would just flop down.

189

00:14:20,103 --> 00:14:24,303

Betty Hill story is that there was some sort of physical scuffle during the course of the

190

00:14:24,303 --> 00:14:25,743

episode.

191

00:14:25,743 --> 00:14:28,903

So then you ask the question, well, what does the dress look like?

192

00:14:28,903 --> 00:14:31,503

The dress is physically damaged.

193

00:14:31,503 --> 00:14:33,183

The zipper is torn off.

194

00:14:33,183 --> 00:14:35,423

The fabric is actually dislocated.

195

00:14:35,423 --> 00:14:38,983

There are contaminants on the fabric, stains all over.

196

00:14:38,983 --> 00:14:46,744

If extraterrestrials left something on her fabric, would that still show up?

197

00:14:46,744 --> 00:14:53,064

It's been 40 years, so there will be a certain amount of deterioration or decay of any samples

198

00:14:53,064 --> 00:14:54,264

that are on there.

199

00:14:54,264 --> 00:14:59,184

Substance involved is a powdery pink substance on Betty's dress.

200

00:14:59,184 --> 00:15:00,184

What could it be?

201

00:15:00,184 --> 00:15:02,184

It's an actual substance excreted by an alien.

202

00:15:02,184 --> 00:15:05,624

Was it something that was on the ship that she rubbed against?

203

00:15:05,624 --> 00:15:08,024

Could be proteins or enzymes.

204

00:15:08,024 --> 00:15:11,345

And how would you know if something is extraterrestrial?

205

00:15:11,345 --> 00:15:14,345

We're just looking for anomalies.

206

00:15:14,345 --> 00:15:19,185

Betty Hill's niece has agreed to turn over two samples of the dress to the team for testing,

207

00:15:19,185 --> 00:15:22,745

a control sample, and a contaminated sample.

208

00:15:22,745 --> 00:15:28,065

Dr. Ted Acworth brings the samples to Phyllis Budinger, a highly respected chemical analyst

209

00:15:28,065 --> 00:15:31,585

with decades of experience with British petroleum.

210

00:15:31,585 --> 00:15:36,746

She analyzes the dress, looking for any trace of the mysterious pink powder and any other

211

00:15:36,746 --> 00:15:38,386

anomalies in the fabric.

212

00:15:38,386 --> 00:15:40,746

What do we have here?

213

00:15:40,746 --> 00:15:44,706

Clipping from the left sleeve of Betty's dress.

214

00:15:44,706 --> 00:15:45,706

This is the control.

215

00:15:45,706 --> 00:15:47,906

It retains the original color of the dress.

216

00:15:47,906 --> 00:15:51,706

The hypothesis is that the stain is something to do with the abduction event.

217

00:15:51,706 --> 00:15:55,066

Yes, the dress material was stained.

218

00:15:55,066 --> 00:15:58,707

There's very, very little of this material on the control sample.

219

00:15:58,707 --> 00:16:03,667

So this tells me that whatever was on there came from an external source that absolutely

220

00:16:03,667 --> 00:16:05,387

did not come from Betty.

221

00:16:05,387 --> 00:16:08,227

Potentially having some sort of residual material or...

222

00:16:08,227 --> 00:16:09,227

It might be.

223

00:16:09,227 --> 00:16:14,747

First, she looked it under a microscope to get a high magnification view of it.

224

00:16:14,747 --> 00:16:21,307

You're going to see that compared to the control, the stain swap has a less ordered weave and

225

00:16:21,307 --> 00:16:23,948

there's more spaces between the knit rows.

226

00:16:23,948 --> 00:16:27,948

Yeah, I see the greater spacing between the knit rows.

227

00:16:27,948 --> 00:16:32,428

Yeah, and if you look closely, it's been disturbed.

228

00:16:32,428 --> 00:16:37,868

Through microscopic analysis, Phyllis has detected areas of unusual strain and distress

229

00:16:37,868 --> 00:16:39,908

in the fabric of Betty's dress.

230

00:16:39,908 --> 00:16:45,068

The fabric clearly is mechanically dislocated compared to the control sample.

231

00:16:45,068 --> 00:16:49,829

Everything that I see is consistent with an explanation of there being a physical struggle

232

00:16:49,829 --> 00:16:53,749

between the wearer of the dress and someone else.

233

00:16:53,749 --> 00:16:58,789

This be evidence of Betty Hill's claim that she struggled against the alleged abductors

234

00:16:58,789 --> 00:17:00,749

in her attempt to escape.

235

00:17:00,749 --> 00:17:03,669

Why don't we move on to the spectroscopic analysis?

236

00:17:03,669 --> 00:17:07,629

That sounded pretty interesting too.

237

00:17:07,629 --> 00:17:09,829

Infrared is a very, very powerful technique.

238

00:17:09,829 --> 00:17:12,589

It's used for molecular structure identification.

239

00:17:12,589 --> 00:17:16,470

Each infrared spectrum of a molecule is unique.

240

00:17:16,470 --> 00:17:22,350

In spectrum analysis, a beam of infrared light goes through each molecule and produces

241

00:17:22,350 --> 00:17:26,590

a unique wavelength that acts like a chemical fingerprint.

242

00:17:26,590 --> 00:17:31,790

To get an accurate identification of the dress's contaminants, Phyllis extracts some of the

243

00:17:31,790 --> 00:17:37,430

unknown residue from the sample.

244

00:17:37,430 --> 00:17:41,191

And these are the results and what it does is enhances the bands.

245

00:17:41,191 --> 00:17:46,631

It looks like there are at least two kinds of contaminants on the fabric.

246

00:17:46,631 --> 00:17:48,991

One is a protein-based material.

247

00:17:48,991 --> 00:17:51,471

The other is a fat material.

248

00:17:51,471 --> 00:17:52,471

Both are common.

249

00:17:52,471 --> 00:17:53,751

You find them everywhere.

250

00:17:53,751 --> 00:17:58,831

So we found that the dress is contaminated and those contaminants are common.

251

00:17:58,831 --> 00:18:03,712

We got a better sense of exactly what the contaminant was on the fabric.

252

00:18:03,712 --> 00:18:11,352

I can't tell whether they were human or not, but they were biologically probably related.

253

00:18:11,352 --> 00:18:17,392

The physical evidence is consistent with the story, but it does not say that something

254

00:18:17,392 --> 00:18:20,992

or someone else was an alien or a human or anything else.

255

00:18:20,992 --> 00:18:23,792

So it's inconclusive.

256

00:18:23,792 --> 00:18:29,313

reticuli system, that twin star system that Betty said existed.

264

Zeta reticuli is a star system centered around two main stars approximately 39 light-years

265

away from Earth.

Astronomers did not map this system until 1972.

267

While Betty Hill's star map from the late 60s closely matched the newly mapped star

cluster, Betty's diagram showed three stars too many.

269

The map didn't even match.

And in 1972, when we have a technology to see that sector of space, what did we find

out?

The exact same three stars that Betty Hill said were there, and it became an exact

How could Betty Hill have identified the exact location of that star system and the exact

She identified it, she drew it, she diagrammed it before we even had the technology.

As Betty Hill reported being abducted and subjected to an invasive medical examination,

On August 27, 1995, 21 witnesses in 13 locations around Central Colorado reportedly see a massive

292

cigar-shaped object performing incredible maneuvers.

293

These sightings continue over the next 48 hours, making it one of the most important

294

00:21:07,559 --> 00:21:10,399

mass sightings in recent U.S. history.

One witness actually captured this object on tape.

296

Tim has had several close sightings of a UFO and subsequently discovered a strange object

297

implanted in his body.

It began in May of 1978.

299

I was driving home, coming home from Denver with my wife, and we were coming up Highway

300

59 and the UFO came down in front of us.

It was about 100 foot long, 20 foot wide, 10 foot high.

Tim spotted the object on Highway 59, 12 miles outside of Yuma.

The craft moved out here into this pasture and I think it landed approximately out here

Of those that were, all were found to be either of earthly origin or the tests were

Is there any way this could be just a biological secretion of some sort, some deposit of...

Absolutely not.

Because the metals that are in this object are not secreted by the body, they're all

321

foreign to the body.

And you would say that if an object that size entered externally, there'd be a discernible

entry wound.

There's going to be some portal of entry, and we looked at his arm and there was no

Look at the size of that pad.

There it is.

Now look how it's moving away.

See there's your proof.

Now you see that?

The object is moving on its own.

The tool is in pushing.

A 49-year-old Pennsylvania man, Jeff Harvey, contacts the team.

385

Let's get back to the office.

386

In 2001, he became seriously ill with what was diagnosed as heavy metal poisoning.

387

00:26:03,691 --> 00:26:07,411

The cause of the poisoning was never determined.

388

00:26:07,411 --> 00:26:12,851

At the same time, he discovered something strange buried in his upper thigh.

389

00:26:12,851 --> 00:26:17,091

When did you first realize you had an object or something inside you?

390

00:26:17,091 --> 00:26:20,571

What happened was I started losing a lot of weight.

391

00:26:20,571 --> 00:26:23,252

I used to weigh 220 pounds.

392

00:26:23,252 --> 00:26:26,812

I weigh 140 pounds now, so I was losing tons of weight.

393

00:26:26,812 --> 00:26:29,532

I became extremely ill.

394

00:26:29,532 --> 00:26:36,452

If this is related to that, I want it out A and B. I want this thing analyzed eight

395

00:26:36,452 --> 00:26:38,612

ways to Sunday to find out what the answer is.

396

00:26:38,612 --> 00:26:41,212

What makes you think that this is UFO related?

397

00:26:41,212 --> 00:26:45,092

It's one of the possibilities I'm researching.

398

When Jeff was eight years old in 1967, both he and his father had witnessed a UFO sighting

399

00:26:52,133 --> 00:26:56,413

while living in Honesdale, Pennsylvania, near Scranton.

400

00:26:56,413 --> 00:27:00,733

My dad and I were standing on the banks of the Lackawaxon River fishing.

401

00:27:00,733 --> 00:27:05,133

And at treetop level, it came across.

402

00:27:05,133 --> 00:27:07,653

It was smoking from the back.

403

00:27:07,653 --> 00:27:09,573

It had a circular shape.

404

00:27:09,573 --> 00:27:11,294

It had a bit of a bowl to the bottom.

405

00:27:11,294 --> 00:27:18,414

Did you have any memory at all of when you sensed that nodule in your leg being put in?

406

00:27:18,414 --> 00:27:20,214

That's the oddest part about it.

407

00:27:20,214 --> 00:27:25,094

The VA said consistent with shrapnel, never been in battle.

408

00:27:25,094 --> 00:27:28,974

So I don't have any reason why that could be there.

409

00:27:28,974 --> 00:27:32,054

But you do have experience with having a UFO sighting.

410

00:27:32,054 --> 00:27:33,774

Maybe that's the connection.

411

When the team has the alleged implants surgically removed and analyzed, to their surprise, we

actually detected radio frequency.

413

The team takes Jeff to Dr. Lear's medical examination room in Thousand Oaks, California

414

00:27:57,255 --> 00:28:02,256

for pre-surgery testing on the alleged alien implant.

415

00:28:02,256 --> 00:28:06,896

Look for some radioactivity, electromagnetic fields and things of that nature.

416

00:28:06,896 --> 00:28:09,896

So come on right on in.

417

00:28:09,896 --> 00:28:14,776

Jeff Harvey noticed a foreign magnetic object in his leg four years ago.

418

00:28:14,776 --> 00:28:18,216

When I noticed it, I thought, I'd really like to find out what the heck this is.

419

00:28:18,216 --> 00:28:20,216

So I talked to the doctors down at the VA.

420

00:28:20,216 --> 00:28:24,056

They said, oh, fatty cyst, don't worry about it, no big deal.

421

00:28:24,056 --> 00:28:28,097

And then for some reason, one day I thought, you know what, I wonder if it's metal.

422

00:28:28,097 --> 00:28:31,577

So I stuck a magnet on it and it pulled right up out of the skin and I said, all right,

423

hold on, there's no fatty cyst that's magnetic.

424

00:28:33,937 --> 00:28:36,617

Jeff, come on in.

425

00:28:36,617 --> 00:28:41,697

Only after the object has been surgically removed can the team determine scientifically

426

00:28:41,697 --> 00:28:44,097

what this object is and its origin.

427

00:28:44,097 --> 00:28:46,137

That's the main bone.

428

00:28:46,137 --> 00:28:50,058

And then here is your object.

429

00:28:50,058 --> 00:28:55,898

The unknown object feels like a small pellet, slightly bigger than a BB, buried three to

430

00:28:55,898 --> 00:28:59,938

four millimeters under the skin of Jeff's upper right thigh.

431

00:28:59,938 --> 00:29:05,938

Size-wise, this is something very similar to what we have seen before.

432

00:29:05,938 --> 00:29:10,618

Jeff says he has no idea how the object entered his leg.

433

00:29:10,618 --> 00:29:15,979

He remembers no incident that might have somehow allowed metal to become lodged in his body.

434

00:29:15,979 --> 00:29:18,979

There is no scar anywhere near the implant.

435

00:29:18,979 --> 00:29:22,659

Are the other ones you've removed as close to the skin as this one?

436

00:29:22,659 --> 00:29:25,739

No, they're usually closer to the bone.

437

00:29:25,739 --> 00:29:34,059

Initially, it could have been deep and then that come and work its way superficially.

438

00:29:34,059 --> 00:29:37,939

Before we go into surgery to remove the implant, we need to determine what this object really

439

00:29:37,939 --> 00:29:39,099

is.

440

00:29:39,099 --> 00:29:42,660

We need to do a few series of tests of magnetism and radiofrequency.

441

00:29:42,660 --> 00:29:49,620

This is a 250 pound magnet and with that we have quite a bit of magnetic force here.

442

If this object will react to a magnetic field, it should pull it closer to the skin.

443

Is this the spot here, Jeff?

444

00:30:01,580 --> 00:30:02,580

Right there.

445

00:30:02,580 --> 00:30:03,580

Right here.

446

00:30:03,580 --> 00:30:04,580

Okay.

447

00:30:04,580 --> 00:30:06,581

Yeah, it does stand out a little bit.

448

00:30:06,581 --> 00:30:08,581

See the skin?

449

00:30:08,581 --> 00:30:10,581

Yeah, I can't.

450

00:30:10,941 --> 00:30:13,181

It's pulling out just a small circular area.

451

00:30:13,181 --> 00:30:14,181

Right.

452

00:30:14,181 --> 00:30:16,101

How far out would you say that it's pulling out?

453

00:30:16,101 --> 00:30:18,501

A good eighth of an inch.

454

00:30:18,501 --> 00:30:19,501

Good eighth of an inch.

455

00:30:19,501 --> 00:30:27,141

Now we're going to be testing for radioactivity, electromagnetic fields and radiofrequency

456

00:30:27,141 --> 00:30:28,621

next.

457

00:30:28,621 --> 00:30:33,062

Before we permanently remove this implant, we need to see if there's anything detectable

458

00:30:33,062 --> 00:30:34,062

going on.

459

00:30:34,062 --> 00:30:35,742

We do know that it's magnetic.

460

00:30:35,742 --> 00:30:37,502

Maybe it's giving off a radioactivity.

461

00:30:37,502 --> 00:30:39,342

Maybe it's giving off a radio signal.

462

00:30:39,342 --> 00:30:43,662

We need to determine if it's just a piece of metal or it has some greater purpose.

463

00:30:43,662 --> 00:30:46,422

This instrument is called a gauss meter.

464

00:30:46,422 --> 00:30:49,542

That's for the detection of electromagnetic fields.

465

00:30:49,542 --> 00:30:51,542

Let's see what happens.

466

00:30:51,542 --> 00:30:57,543

That noise is a very strong electromagnetic field.

467

00:30:57,543 --> 00:31:05,103

It's going to get a reading of 10 milligauss, which is extremely strong.

468

00:31:05,103 --> 00:31:10,623

It's highly unusual for a tiny speck of metal to give off such a strong signal unless it's

469

00:31:10,623 --> 00:31:13,263

connected to a power source.

470

00:31:13,263 --> 00:31:17,983

I wasn't that curious up until just now when you got a reading on output.

471

00:31:17,983 --> 00:31:23,544

Now the next instrument we use is a radiofrequency detector.

472

00:31:23,544 --> 00:31:27,944

We have two ranges here that we can change from.

473

00:31:27,944 --> 00:31:31,624

What is the gigahertz range and the other is the megahertz range.

474

00:31:31,624 --> 00:31:36,864

Dr. Lear is sweeping a wide range of possible radio frequencies from the bottom of the

475

00:31:36,864 --> 00:31:43,264

megahertz range and continuing upward to the top of the gigahertz range.

476

00:31:43,264 --> 00:31:48,145

Megahertz is the wavelength used by television and FM radio stations.

477

00:31:48,145 --> 00:31:54,265

Gigahertz is much higher used for microwave ovens and cell phones among other applications.

478

00:31:54,265 --> 00:31:57,025

It is emitting a radiofrequency.

479

00:31:57,025 --> 00:32:05,745

It looks to be like about 59.1, 25254 gigahertz.

480

00:32:05,745 --> 00:32:14,226

This is the megahertz range now, which is a 35.893 and this is megahertz.

481

00:32:14,226 --> 00:32:17,106

The megahertz reading fell under a VHF band.

482

00:32:17,106 --> 00:32:21,866

The VHF band is used by satellite radio and terrestrial communication, which is used by

483

00:32:21,866 --> 00:32:23,866

the government as well as the consumers.

484

00:32:24,106 --> 00:32:30,306

Well, I think we've learned something today and we'll wait for tomorrow to have it in our hands.

485

00:32:34,067 --> 00:32:37,867

The evidence that we were able to test was pretty interesting actually.

486

00:32:37,867 --> 00:32:46,107

We came out with the reading of 10 milligauss and also a radiofrequency of 35 megahertz and 59 gigahertz.

487

00:32:46,107 --> 00:32:51,507

35 megahertz is VHF and that's radio, FM radio or television.

488

00:32:51,507 --> 00:32:53,947

Good chance there's a lot of background radiation around.

489

00:32:53,947 --> 00:32:55,947

You might have picked that up.

490

00:32:55,947 --> 00:33:00,828

But the other one, 59 gigahertz, that's extremely high frequency.

491

00:33:00,828 --> 00:33:08,228

Those are the radiofrequencies that radio astronomers use to detect radiofrequencies coming in from outer space.

492

00:33:08,228 --> 00:33:13,188

Why would an object under someone's skin be generating that kind of frequency?

493

00:33:13,188 --> 00:33:18,948

One is that the thing is sending a signal at a frequency that does travel pretty far.

494

00:33:18,948 --> 00:33:22,868

Two is that it's kind of also a homing beacon.

495

00:33:22,868 --> 00:33:27,069

These readings are not particularly magnitude wise, very powerful.

496

00:33:27,069 --> 00:33:33,789

So, you know, it could be just part of the ambient environment in space where you took your readings.

497

00:33:33,789 --> 00:33:39,149

You know, it's pretty, basically it's pretty inconclusive until we can get that implant out and do some further testing.

498

So here we are, Jeff at the surgical suite.

499

00:33:43,349 --> 00:33:44,389

The systems are all ready.

500

00:33:44,389 --> 00:33:46,389

The surgical suite is ready to go.

501

And I'm looking forward to seeing what we pull out.

502

Before the operation, the medical team extracts blood from Jeff.

503

00:33:53,790 --> 00:33:58,590

So the object can be stored in the same fluid it was once immersed in.

504

OK, you're all set.

All right, thank you.

506

00:34:04,670 --> 00:34:09,110

Actually, the first part, I want everyone to back up a little because I really have to find this thing.

507

Dr. John Mitriciano, a general surgeon practicing in Thousand Oaks, California, is conducting the operation.

508

There we go.

509

I'm going to use the local anesthesia.

510

00:34:21,711 --> 00:34:24,831

And this is where we're going right to the spot we marked before.

So I'll make a little nick with the skin.

So I can't feel it, so I am going to rely a little bit on the x-ray.

Make sure we're on the same spot.

I'm going to grasp this if I can.

is one of the leading independent analysis

laboratories in the country.

In order to take a scientific approach to this,

578

we have to see actually what this thing is,

579

00:37:20,038 --> 00:37:24,038

submit it for metallurgical and biological testing,

580

and see if we do have anything here.

581

The sample is pretty small.

582

It's only about 1 to 2 millimeters across.

Under the optical microscope at 40x magnification,

we got a great sense of what it looks like.

The object has two distinct areas, a light inner layer

597

and a dark outer shell.

598

I do look at the outside surface,

599

and it did appear to be blackened or charred,

600

if you want to say.

You could be looking at rust.

Yeah.

Yeah, it's true.

But a closer look reveals a third area,

And I'm very curious to know what's this made of.

So this is a scanning electron microscope.

613

Right here, we have an electron source

614

that shoots electrons down vertically at the sample.

We can scan the sample in X and Y.

616

We can get X-rated fraction, which

617

will give us the information about the elements that

There it is.

Can we get the X-ray off of this sort of fin-like material?

623

Sure.

I think we see here that it's not actually

625

a material that's protruding from within the sample.

626

It's actually something attached.

627

The spectra of that material, it's organic.

628

So for some reason here, we've got

629

a piece of the human body that's attached itself

630

to the exterior surface of the sample.

631

So this is really interesting, because the human body

632

has two kinds of reactions to a foreign object.

633

One was the more extreme case where

634

it would encapsulate it in pus and transport it out.

635

And the second one was where it would just encase it

636

and have a minor inflammatory reaction.

It seems here that some material from the human body

638

has actually attached itself to the sample, which to me

639

doesn't seem like either of those cases

640

that Dr. Laird described.

641

00:40:01,004 --> 00:40:03,285

Usually he would reject it, but in this case,

642

00:40:03,285 --> 00:40:04,365

it's actually embracing it.

643

00:40:04,365 --> 00:40:05,605

Yes, it's attached itself.

644

00:40:05,605 --> 00:40:06,245

Very interesting.

645

00:40:06,245 --> 00:40:08,285

Does it look like it's attached to the sample

646

00:40:08,285 --> 00:40:09,605

in any unusual way?

647

00:40:09,605 --> 00:40:10,845

To me, it doesn't.

648

00:40:10,845 --> 00:40:13,005

The team continues to analyze the object

649

00:40:13,005 --> 00:40:15,805

for other anomalies.

650

00:40:15,845 --> 00:40:18,525

We're getting a good sense here of what the elements are

651

00:40:18,525 --> 00:40:20,165

within this edge.

652

00:40:20,165 --> 00:40:23,805

I see iron, oxygen, and carbon.

653

00:40:23,805 --> 00:40:25,685

And then, sulfon.

654

00:40:25,685 --> 00:40:28,366

As you can see, the highest peak is carbon.

655

00:40:28,366 --> 00:40:32,566

The carbon and the oxygen he thought were contaminants.

656

00:40:32,566 --> 00:40:37,206

All of these would be found in body fluids, for example.

657

00:40:37,206 --> 00:40:40,726

But if we remove those, it were left with iron.

658

00:40:40,726 --> 00:40:43,366

So it looks like it's probably iron.

659

00:40:43,366 --> 00:40:46,286

So we've just panned over to a third area of the sample,

660

00:40:46,286 --> 00:40:50,566

right, where we thought it had that black coloration.

661

00:40:50,566 --> 00:40:52,207

There are our peaks.

662

00:40:52,207 --> 00:40:52,967

Wow.

663

00:40:52,967 --> 00:40:55,247

They're coming up very similar.

664

00:40:55,247 --> 00:41:00,207

The phosphorous is, there's more phosphorous in this area.

665

00:41:00,207 --> 00:41:04,727

For now, I'm really not seeing anything too unusual.

666

00:41:04,727 --> 00:41:08,327

Basically, we have a small piece, about a 1 to 2 millimeters

667

00:41:08,327 --> 00:41:10,527

in diameter, made of iron.

668

00:41:10,527 --> 00:41:13,847

In fact, it is medically possible for foreign objects

669

00:41:13,847 --> 00:41:17,168

to migrate inside the body and emerge at points

670

00:41:17,168 --> 00:41:20,728

far from where they entered, sometimes years later.

671

00:41:20,728 --> 00:41:23,448

My job as a scientist is just to look at the data

672

00:41:23,448 --> 00:41:24,888

and see if there's anything unusual.

673

00:41:24,888 --> 00:41:28,368

And in this case, there really isn't anything yet

674

00:41:28,368 --> 00:41:29,768

that has surprised us.

675

00:41:29,768 --> 00:41:31,688

My job is to rain on their parade.

676

00:41:31,688 --> 00:41:33,768

And I'm afraid I may have to do that again.

677

00:41:33,768 --> 00:41:37,048

Ted believes this implant is an iron pellet

678

00:41:37,048 --> 00:41:41,488

and that its emergence is a natural occurrence.

679

00:41:41,488 --> 00:41:43,249

We could debate this case all night long,

680

00:41:43,249 --> 00:41:44,929

and debate this case forever if you want to.

681

00:41:44,929 --> 00:41:47,809

But the fact is, there was a traumatic event in his life.

682

You took it to the lab, you ran your tests,

683

00:41:50,889 --> 00:41:54,249

and we found out that at least one test was very, very strange,

684

that there was actual human tissue,

685

protein growing from within a fracture in the object itself.

686

00:42:01,129 --> 00:42:04,009

I know it was pretty exciting to have an opportunity

687

to surgically remove what we thought

688

00:42:06,049 --> 00:42:09,890

might be some sort of foreign object or alien implant.

689

00:42:09,890 --> 00:42:13,810

As far as I can tell, after all of our scientific tests of it,

690

00:42:13,810 --> 00:42:19,330

it just looks like simply a small fragment of oxidized iron.

691

00:42:19,330 --> 00:42:22,370

What about the tissue growing out of the metal?

692

We just don't have that technology here on Earth.

693

So therefore, I say this is beyond our technology,

694

it's quite possibly alien.

695

We've taken technology and applied it to ufology.

696

How rarely is that done in this field?

697

The bunker will always say to you,

698

you haven't proven the existence of a UFO,

699

as if you've got to produce the UFO on the table for it to be true.

But on the other hand, the ufologists will say,

701

well, you haven't disproven the UFO.

Show me something that says this is anything but a UFO.

And you know what?

704

We have not found one thing to disprove

705

that there's an extraterrestrial presence

706

affecting us on planet Earth into fear with our lives,

707

00:43:04,892 --> 00:43:07,812

and traveling through our skies.

708

00:43:07,812 --> 00:43:12,692

What began on a lonely New Hampshire highway in 1961,

709

00:43:12,692 --> 00:43:16,652

a couple allegedly chased down and abducted by aliens,

710

00:43:16,652 --> 00:43:18,972

continues to this day.

711

00:43:18,972 --> 00:43:21,533

Hundreds of new stories of alien abduction

712

00:43:21,533 --> 00:43:23,533

are reported every year.

713

00:43:23,533 --> 00:43:26,773

But the full accounts of what happens during these abductions

714

may never be fully known.

715

Are we really being watched by beings not of this world?

716

Is it possible that other beings are leaving behind

717

evidence of their visits to our planet?

Or do these disturbing stories come not from the darkness of outer space,

719

but from the dark corners of our own imagination?
