On February 8, 1969, a blue-white fireball streaked across the sky and landed near the

the state of Campeche.

Although the objects were invisible to the air crew, they were picked up on the plane's

radar.

The objects surrounded the plane briefly before vanishing at high speed.

This sighting was verified and released to the media by Sidená.

On the morning of the 20th, I received a report that came from the city of Jalitla.

A ball of fire fell.

129

00:08:58,401 --> 00:09:06,202

A ball of fire fell and exploded into the treetops.

Witness reported it to the authorities and when they got there, they just found ashes.

So they found ashes instead of metal fragments.

132

One of the investigators took some of the ashes.

You could tell us where this person can be found.

Well let's try and find him and let's try and see the ashes.

According to Martinez, the object threw off long, ribbon-like coils of ash as it passed

Pat, that's your job.

Ronnie, the reporter said there was actual debris that came from the object's impact.

On August 20, 2007, a red-orange fireball reportedly performing impossible maneuvers

161

The team has traveled to this small mountain town to visit the crash site.

163

This case is really amazing.

We have a fireball crashing.

165

Ronnie's going to take a look at the actual crash site while I go interview the witnesses.

166

Hey, Ruben, these people live right across the street.

I want to find out if they saw anything.

Absolutely.

Unfortunately, I speak about two words of Spanish.

From approximately 4.30 to 4.50 a.m., 30 minutes after the crash, the entire area was under

Even the battery-powered police radios were reportedly unable to receive or transmit a

200

signal.

What happens is that...

What did it sound like?

The small ship, maybe it was a UFO.

There's any residue from this object.

I'm going to check that there is no abundance of radioactivity.

It's normal science.

Normal science.

Ronnie's Geiger counter shows that the site isn't radioactive, eliminating the possibility

226

that the fireball was powered by some sort of nuclear fuel.

227

I'm going to take soil samples, bark, fruit that's here.

228

So take advantage of everything.

Ronnie collects samples from the site.

230

While Bill and Pat hunt down the most important piece of confirmed evidence, the ashes that

Sennesis.

Sennesis.

She actually saw and handled the ribbon-like ashes, which did not disintegrate when touched.

Can you describe the ashes to me?

248

It's about two centimeters wide, a black and gray matter.

He's a police officer, right?

He's a police officer.

We are one single phone call away from getting actual debris, ashes that might have fallen

258

The team heads to Ventura, California to Capco Analysis Systems with the ash sample from

We brought here the ash sample and we've asked the scientists here at Capco if they can analyze

268

00:16:01,564 --> 00:16:07,084

these and just give us a quantitative summary of what the composition is of all of these

269

samples.

The scientists at Capco are testing the ash sample using gas chromatography and mass spectroscopy.

The detection limit is 10,000 and the amount of sulfur we find there is 90,000.

We're going to find the debris in Coyame and we'll find the link between Jalitla and Mexico's

337

UFO expert Ruben Uriarte gives the team the hottest lead ever in this case.

339

The two sites we'll be going out to visit, one of them is an actual airplane debris field

from a small airplane that crashed in the desert near here.

Ruben Uriarte found the location of the downed plane in the Coyame Desert.

Coyame sits in the Chihuahuan Desert, the same desert that surrounds Roswell, New Mexico.

At 10 p.m. August 25, 1974, strategic defense installations across Texas are allegedly

What is particularly alarming was the reported speed at which the object is traveling.

352

A typical commercial jet travels between 500 and 600 miles per hour.

354

The top speed of an F-15 fighter, one of the fastest jets in the sky, is Mach 2.5 or approximately

Well, we've discovered wreckage of a plane that's strewn about out here in the desert.

According to Low-Cards Exchange Principle, whenever two objects come into contact, a

And another part of this mystery is that the villagers told us that the military specifically

It looks like a 55 gallon drum or something.

I'm noticing other bits and pieces of metal like this.

If the military had an expedition out here, they would have definitely brought their own fuel with them

539

because there's no gas station near here.

We found chain drives for maybe a drilling mechanism.

We found welded parts.

542

The other thing we found are oil drums.

543

So somebody transported oil, petroleum or some explosive material to this site.

Could it be that like the 2007 crash in Halidla, the Mexican military was immediately called in to

collect, gather and destroy any and all evidence of this incident?

Pulling up some circular metal objects here.

Look at this. They're all like trunk covers.

You notice? Look at this.

There's something right over there.

I don't know what that is. I didn't want to touch it.

In other words, if you have the bulb assembly.

So this is a site where some kind of burial or explosive operation,

some kind of incendiary operation took place to get rid of evidence and bury evidence.

It looks kind of like a bomb crater or one of these nuclear explosion sites

560

where it explodes and the ground collapses and there's a kind of a crater.

561

That's what it looks like to me just walking up to it.

562

00:35:30,001 --> 00:35:33,002

According to Noe and Ruben's book, Mexico's Roswell,

563

quote, the presence of this deadly agent motivated a U.S. military task force

564

00:35:39,002 --> 00:35:44,003

to rush into Mexico and set off an incendiary device, possibly nuclear,

565

to prevent any further spread of the problem.

566

The U.S. did indeed have backpack nuclear weapons in the 1970s.

567

The W-54 suitcase nuke ranged in power from 1 to 10 kilotons.

568

This smaller explosion may have been used to eliminate a, quote,

569

lethal biological agent.

570

According to Noe and Ruben, citizens of Coyame were warned for years after the 1974 event

571

to stay away from this area due to high levels of radiation.

572

00:36:18,006 --> 00:36:20,006

What exactly happened here?

573

00:36:23,007 --> 00:36:25,007

They got a sweep slowly.

574

00:36:25,007 --> 00:36:30,007

Ronnie tests for radioactivity in the pit using a Geiger counter.

575

00:36:30,007 --> 00:36:34,008

The Geiger counter measures the number of radioactive particles being emitted

576

00:36:34,008 --> 00:36:37,008

by a sample in counts per minute, or CPM.

577

00:36:37,008 --> 00:36:40,008

Just about 15 CPMs.

578

00:36:40,008 --> 00:36:45,009

The Earth itself emits a background radiation of approximately 15 CPM.

579

00:36:46,009 --> 00:36:48,009

No sign of any radioactivity.

580

00:36:48,009 --> 00:36:52,010

Looks like... looks like we're radioactive dead.

581

00:36:52,010 --> 00:36:54,010

In other words, it's just normal.

582

Hold on a second.

583

00:36:56,010 --> 00:36:57,010

There's something.

584

00:36:57,010 --> 00:36:58,010

Hang on.

That increased rapidly.

586

Hang on.

587

00:37:01,010 --> 00:37:02,011

Wow.

588

The radiation level jumped to over 100 counts per minute,

589

00:37:06,011 --> 00:37:08,011

eight times the normal level,

590

00:37:08,011 --> 00:37:13,012

indicating radioactive material may have been in this immediate vicinity.

591

Well, I still have a lot of questions about what this hole might be,

592

but I have to admit it's unusual.

When you come upon a site that potentially contains the wreckage

of a plane that crashed with a UFO,

and yet on the site are potentially little pieces of forensic evidence

that may reveal substances other than simply what would have been on that plane.

This is a major find.

The plane debris and the radioactive samples taken from the mysterious pit

in the Chihuahuan Desert are sent to the lab to test for trace evidence of UFOs.

We do know that something happened there.

603

00:37:59,016 --> 00:38:00,016

While testing in the lab,

604

00:38:00,016 --> 00:38:04,017

finally helped solve the case of Mexico's Roswell.

605

The team has gathered samples from a reported UFO crash site near Coyame, Mexico.

606

00:38:16,018 --> 00:38:17,018

What is this?

607

00:38:17,018 --> 00:38:23,019

They are now headed back to the laboratories at Capco Analysis Systems in Ventura, California.

608

00:38:23,019 --> 00:38:27,019

So the team had collected four samples, one of which is a control sample,

609

and the other three are closer to this mysterious hole.

610

We're going to test these samples for a variety of known compounds, organic and semi-volatile.

611

The team meets Alan Repedi, an analysis technician

612

who ran a number of tests on samples gathered near the reported burial site.

When we were at Coyame out in the desert,

we took a series of samples radiating out from what we think was the sign of the explosion.

I know you ran some tests on those. What did you find out?

The organic site basically implied that analysis using gas chromatography,

617

mass spectroscopy instrument,

618

00:39:03,023 --> 00:39:11,024

the purpose being to identify all the semi-volatile compounds potentially present in those samples.

619

00:39:11,024 --> 00:39:18,024

Alan is testing four samples collected from different distances around the mysterious pit near Coyame.

620

00:39:18,024 --> 00:39:22,025

The sample areas start at the furthest distance from the center point.

621

00:39:22,025 --> 00:39:29,025

Sample A is the control, and sample D was taken from inside the hole itself.

622

00:39:29,025 --> 00:39:36,026

Alan is scanning for the presence of VOCs, Volatile Organic Compounds.

623

00:39:36,026 --> 00:39:40,026

VOCs are defined by the Environmental Protection Agency

624

00:39:40,026 --> 00:39:44,027

as chemical compounds that easily vaporize into the atmosphere.

625

00:39:44,027 --> 00:39:49,027

These include methane, formaldehyde and many common household chemicals.

626

00:39:49,027 --> 00:39:55,028

Identifying the VOCs will help to define the chemical makeup of the sample.

627

00:39:55,028 --> 00:40:01,029

In your sample, sample A and sample B are completely clean samples.

628

00:40:01,029 --> 00:40:03,029

There is really nothing in it.

629

00:40:03,029 --> 00:40:15,030

However, in the other two, C and D, we found a slight trace of hydrocarbons, basically petroleum products,

630

00:40:15,030 --> 00:40:22,031

which we kind of define looking at the chromatogram as motor oil.

631

00:40:24,031 --> 00:40:31,032

Again, it's not too much, but enough to show us some positive, you know, some hits.

632

00:40:31,032 --> 00:40:38,032

Which is funny because where that sample came from, C and D, they were getting closer to the actual mine shaft,

633

00:40:38,032 --> 00:40:46,033

where as the story goes, the United States Army blew up some debris at, right around that mine shaft,

634

00:40:46,033 --> 00:40:49,033

we found a few petroleum containers there.

635

00:40:49,033 --> 00:40:57,034

The soil samples from Coyame did have some kind of semi-volatile compound in them.

636

00:40:57,034 --> 00:41:02,035

Although we can't draw specific conclusions, we do know that something happened there

637

00:41:02,035 --> 00:41:08,035

that may have involved some kind of explosion or incendiary process.

638

00:41:08,035 --> 00:41:14,036

All of this supports the possibility that there may have been some sort of military activity there

639

00:41:14,036 --> 00:41:17,036

and therefore some sort of military cover-up.

640

00:41:17,036 --> 00:41:24,037

Almost as though there was petroleum stored in there, which either reached out and went to the top

641

00:41:24,037 --> 00:41:29,037

or was actually exploded and we don't know.

642

There's a link here between the two cases, the crash at Coyame

643

00:41:33,038 --> 00:41:36,038

and what really happened in the village of Halitla.

So what are the test shells, Jeff?

645

Well, the test shows the petroleum or benzene substance was more in concentration in a specific area, which was the D sample.

646

D, the hole had the highest concentration of petroleum-based products.

647

00:41:54,040 --> 00:42:01,041

In the hole itself, which is what struck me was that the soil itself was basically dark.

648

It's almost as though something in the hole threw something dark into the soil

649

00:42:08,041 --> 00:42:11,042

and so the closer to the top, the lighter the soil became.

650

00:42:11,042 --> 00:42:14,042

It sounds like perhaps an explosion.

651

00:42:14,042 --> 00:42:16,042

What does that look like to me?

652

00:42:16,042 --> 00:42:19,042

Which may involve some volatiles or semi-volatiles.

653

00:42:19,042 --> 00:42:22,043

We've measured, we detect some very trace amounts there.

654

00:42:22,043 --> 00:42:29,043

It may have done something thermally to the soil or added some chemical composition to the soil as it threw the soil out,

655

00:42:29,043 --> 00:42:34,044

which would be consistent with the idea that what it had thrown settled on the top of the surface,

656

00:42:34,044 --> 00:42:38,044

away from the hole, but in the hole it could have been driven into the walls of the hole.

657

00:42:38,044 --> 00:42:44,045

I think we can debate Koyami at Infinitum until we get more information.

658

00:42:44,045 --> 00:42:47,045

We know there's smoke, we need to find the fire.

659

00:42:47,045 --> 00:42:53,046

Let's turn our attention to Halit Law because here's a case where we actually have a current case, right?

660

00:42:53,046 --> 00:43:04,047

It was April 2007. We were able to get a minute sample of the ash that was the residue from this fireball.

661

00:43:04,047 --> 00:43:07,047

Why couldn't we bring more sample? Why do we have just a tiny amount?

662

00:43:07,047 --> 00:43:10,048

There were large amounts of samples that the villagers themselves collected.

663

00:43:10,048 --> 00:43:16,048

The police came in and confiscated the whole mess of it except for a very small amount.

664

00:43:16,048 --> 00:43:18,048

Now that we're able to get into this country.

665

00:43:18,048 --> 00:43:23,049

The fact that the Mexican authorities confiscated all these samples, what does that mean?

666

00:43:23,049 --> 00:43:26,049

Now you're coming over to my side of the table.

667

00:43:26,049 --> 00:43:34,050

What you've got is one, why would the Mexican authorities make it such a high priority to roll in immediately,

668

00:43:34,050 --> 00:43:41,051

take the soil and go? Why were we followed by police and military as we went to the location?

669

00:43:41,051 --> 00:43:44,051

We have evidence of something.

670

00:43:47,051 --> 00:43:55,052

From collecting ash from the reported Halit La Crash of 2007 to finding a darkened earth area near Mexico's Roswell,

671

00:43:55,052 --> 00:44:02,053

the team has gained insight into one of the world's most active regions for UFO reports.

672

00:44:02,053 --> 00:44:10,054

And although the samples proved inconclusive, the number of sightings and the government's response to these events shows

673

00:44:10,054 --> 00:44:15,054

there may be more going on in Mexico than the public is allowed to know.
