Well, the year was 2000.

We were on Liberty that night.

121

When I was coming back from Liberty, I had wanted to get back to the ship because it

So I'm about 30 paces ahead of everyone.

Where was it?

It was about 100 yards from the pier.

As it got brighter and brighter, I stopped and I looked at it.

So there was no time for that.

And besides, I'm not a drinker anyway.

So you weren't out, no beers at dinner.

I don't drink at all.

Clear head, completely clear head.

155

And you weren't alone.

There were other people with you.

Well, I had duty the next day.

So I wanted to get back before everybody else.

And I was way ahead of everybody.

But if your friends were 30 paces behind you, don't you think they would have a clear

eye line to it?

Again, they was only there for maybe 15 seconds or so.

I was actually telling them to hurry up to get to see it, so to make sure I wasn't crazy.

He believes that the sightings at Guantanamo Bay and Gulf Breeze are actually part of a

much bigger picture.

The whole U.S.O., the chassis of the machine is in apparatus.

182

And there is a kind of shield around the U.S.O. that never touched the water.

You put your hand in a glass.

184

00:10:13,738 --> 00:10:14,738

You put it out.

185

00:10:14,738 --> 00:10:15,738

It's going to drip.

186

00:10:15,738 --> 00:10:19,859

U.S.Os don't drip because they don't touch the water.

187

00:10:19,859 --> 00:10:22,580

First, they don't splash.

188

00:10:22,580 --> 00:10:23,580

Why?

189

00:10:23,580 --> 00:10:29,382

Because in front of the machine, they open vacuum, vacuum space.

190

00:10:29,382 --> 00:10:31,703

This is why they need this tunnel.

191

00:10:31,703 --> 00:10:34,743

This is why they are never wet.

192

00:10:34,743 --> 00:10:39,184

According to Maximilian, U.S.Os are entering the water without creating a splash.

193

00:10:39,184 --> 00:10:43,666

And this is accomplished by some kind of a force field or vacuum surrounding the craft,

194

00:10:43,666 --> 00:10:48,747

which allows it to push the water aside without actually touching it.

195

00:10:48,747 --> 00:10:52,548

Why in the Caribbean, why in the Gulf?

196

00:10:52,548 --> 00:10:54,468

Base upon report.

197

00:10:54,468 --> 00:10:58,670

There are 12 bases for the U.S.O.

198

00:10:58,670 --> 00:11:00,070

Underwater, there are tunnels.

199

00:11:00,070 --> 00:11:05,591

There are corridors that connect one base to another base.

200

00:11:05,591 --> 00:11:08,392

You mean under the ocean floor, there are tunnels.

201

00:11:08,392 --> 00:11:09,392

Yes.

202

00:11:09,392 --> 00:11:14,434

Maximilian gets his information about these underwater bases from unidentified military

203

00:11:14,434 --> 00:11:15,994

and NASA sources.

204

00:11:15,994 --> 00:11:20,715

Unfortunately there's just no way to confirm the validity of this information.

205

So it's not like these U.F.O.

206

00:11:21,876 --> 00:11:27,077

bases are any kind of construction, any kind of cities or a little bubble under the water.

207

They're actually living in the hollows of the earth.

208

00:11:29,678 --> 00:11:30,678

Correct.

209

00:11:30,678 --> 00:11:38,960

They are interconnected from Alaska to Japan to Finland to England.

Is it Caribbean?

211

If this network of tunnels leads to a U.S.O.

212

base off the coast of Cuba, this could explain the multiple sightings taking place around

213

Gulf Breeze.

214

Very sophisticated channels.

215

And don't think when you say corridor, they were built from solid structure, such as cement

or metal.

No.

They can move it.

They denied our application flat.

258

They said, quote, no, we want no part of that, which astounds me, because the hard part is

259

usually getting permission from the United States.

260

00:14:36,446 --> 00:14:43,328

It was the Cubans learning we were investigating UFO activity and U.S.O. activity in Cuban

261

00:14:43,328 --> 00:14:44,328

waters.

262

00:14:44,328 --> 00:14:48,769

That's what shut us down.

263

00:14:48,769 --> 00:14:52,810

So although we can't get into Cuba to talk to eyewitnesses there, we have three eyewitnesses

264

00:14:52,810 --> 00:14:55,011

who were residents of Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

265

00:14:55,451 --> 00:14:58,492

We've got an amazing UFO story to tell us.

266

00:14:58,492 --> 00:15:00,092

My name is Nick Baggett.

267

00:15:00,092 --> 00:15:01,692

My name is John Brummit.

268

00:15:01,692 --> 00:15:06,294

My name is Eric Kendall, and I've seen two unexplainable objects over the skies of Guantanamo

269

00:15:06,294 --> 00:15:07,294

Bay Cubans.

270

00:15:10,295 --> 00:15:15,136

It was 2000 and it was about about 9.30 a night, probably pretty late.

271

00:15:15,136 --> 00:15:18,377

And as we were walking down the street to our friend's house, one of my friends observed

272

in the sky two very bright lights.

273

00:15:22,698 --> 00:15:24,898

They actually started rotating around each other.

274

They did that for how long you think?

275

Just a few rotations around each other, and then one shot off really fast, you know, faster

276

than I've seen any airplane or helicopter go.

277

And then the other one just appeared like it was getting closer to us.

Hedero has investigated hundreds of UFO and USO cases in Cuba over the past 15 years.

This map that he drew is a result of interviewing more than 200 people about UFO sightings.

321

In 1995, there was a huge wave of sightings near South of Havana.

322

And we're talking about lots of different kinds of people, saw the same objects in the

323

00:18:13,382 --> 00:18:14,382

sky.

00:18:14,382 --> 00:18:16,943

And where is the Isle of Youth on this map?

325

It's a little south.

326

00:18:18,943 --> 00:18:24,465

Apparently, what we're talking about is that the Isle of Youth is off the map down here.

327

This would coincide with what Diaz told us regarding the structures under the water.

We've had a major breakthrough in talking to Cuban ufologists.

This is a drawing that was made by a Cuban doctor east of Havana.

It was an object that came out of the water.

And when it came out of the water, there was a light, almost like a flame going down the

00:19:19,279 --> 00:19:20,779

middle.

339

This reminds me just like the craft that Ed Wolters photographed in Gulf Breeze.

340

It's got rings around it.

341

00:19:30,922 --> 00:19:32,602

It's got a string of lights.

342

00:19:32,602 --> 00:19:38,644

And there's even something on top that was in the Wolters photograph.

343

It's one of the most amazing stories in ufology.

344

00:19:41,565 --> 00:19:48,527

In 1987, Ed Wolters snaps a few Polaroid pictures of a flying saucer.

345

00:19:48,527 --> 00:19:54,168

He takes it to the local Gulf Breeze paper and they publish a story about it.

346

00:19:54,168 --> 00:19:56,329

Hundreds of witnesses come forward.

347

00:19:56,329 --> 00:19:59,129

Some claim they saw the same craft.

348

00:19:59,129 --> 00:20:01,890

Some say they saw a different craft.

349

00:20:01,890 --> 00:20:06,171

Some come right out and say Ed Wolters is a hoaxer.

350

00:20:06,171 --> 00:20:14,573

Regardless, Gulf Breeze Florida becomes the UFO and USO capital of the world.

351

00:20:14,573 --> 00:20:23,616

21 years ago, late 87 through 1988, Gulf Breeze was sort of like the center of the UFO universe.

352

00:20:23,616 --> 00:20:27,177

And this house featured very prominently in that center.

353

00:20:27,897 --> 00:20:33,898

Dr. Bruce McAbee is a retired naval optical physicist who studied and investigated UFO

354

00:20:33,898 --> 00:20:36,499

cases since the 1960s.

355

00:20:36,499 --> 00:20:41,820

He's extensively analyzed the Ed Wolters case.

356

00:20:41,820 --> 00:20:43,781

Ed was sitting in his office which was over there.

357

00:20:43,781 --> 00:20:48,542

He happened to notice out in the sky in this direction.

358

00:20:48,542 --> 00:20:51,263

Glowing object coming along.

359

00:20:51,263 --> 00:20:55,064

He took his first picture and the object had not quite cleared the tree.

360

00:20:55,064 --> 00:20:59,545

The left hand side of the object was blocked by some of the branches of the tree.

361

00:20:59,545 --> 00:21:04,226

And then he took four more pictures that was in the clear.

362

00:21:04,226 --> 00:21:08,547

And this telephone transformer, this power transformer, and lights there, that all shows

363

00:21:08,547 --> 00:21:10,468

up in the picture that he took.

364

I have to admit that the craft in Ed Wolters' photos and the craft that was hand drawn by

365

one of the witnesses in Cuba, they look a lot alike.

Both have a basic acorn shape, lights surrounding them, and both have a light that appears to

367

be coming from the bottom of the craft.

This acorn shape is very similar to what was seen in Kecksburg, Pennsylvania in 1965.

369

As time went on over the next few weeks, he had sightings which he didn't tell anybody

370

about.

But other people had sightings as well and they did publicize in the newspaper.

And over the years, he was called all sorts of bad names, shall we say, by the debunkers

Questions will be asked and the answers will one day be discovered.

Who are they and what do they want?

384

On what basis did people claim that Ed Wolters' story might be a hoax?

385

You have to understand that virtually any photo could be faked.

For the Model 600 Polaroid camera, you press the button and a film comes shooting right

387

out, right?

Well, we found out that it is possible to double expose that, but we had to call up the Polaroid

389

00:22:56,615 --> 00:22:58,416

people to find out how to do it.

390

And the guy said, you have to stop the motor.

391

Now, Ed took his first picture with that, his first UFO picture with that camera the

392

day after he bought it.

Are we supposed to assume that Ed knew more about it than the Polaroid guy did?

394

A double exposure involves taking a frame of film and exposing it not only to the original

image but also to a second image.

The outcome is the images in the picture appear as if they're together in the photo, when

in reality they were captured at two separate times but on the same piece of film.

A lot of UFO hoaxers use this double exposure technique to make it seem like they've taken

399

a photograph of a genuine UFO.

400

But the first photo was the one that said, you can't just pass this off completely as

401

00:23:41,507 --> 00:23:42,507

double exposed hoax.

402

Because the first one shows the tree blocking part of this object.

403

And you can't do that in a simple double exposure.

You can do it with a so-called masked double exposure where you make a mask that blocks

So in reality, there were a whole bunch of witnesses before Ed Walters, before he even

the craft on repeated occasions.

There were a dozen other people who said they saw exactly the same thing.

And so you have to ask yourself, does it make any sense to say Ed Walters' photos were

No.

This is only the tip of the iceberg.

421

There are hundreds of UFO and USO sightings here in Gulf Breeze.

There could be something in the water, something out there in the ocean that they could be

423

attracted to.

My heart was racing.

425

00:25:12,450 --> 00:25:15,611

I didn't know if I was going to collide with the object.

426

00:25:15,611 --> 00:25:23,893

It was not anything I've saw in 30 years.

427

In November of 2007, Captain Keith Brassard is sailing a small boat from Panama City

428

00:25:29,895 --> 00:25:32,416

to Gulf Breeze, Florida.

429

00:25:32,416 --> 00:25:38,417

And suddenly a green glowing unidentified submerged object appears right under his boat.

430

00:25:38,417 --> 00:25:42,418

And what happens next terrifies him.

431

It was about 3 a.m. in the morning and I was about 100 miles south of here.

432

00:25:48,300 --> 00:25:51,901

And I was sailing all night to try to get back to Mobile Bay.

433

And what had happened was my depth sounder started triggering off.

434

And I was in about 1300 feet of water.

And my depth sounder showed 12 feet of water.

And I knew something was under the boat, but I didn't know what it was.

When I looked over the side of the boat, the water was glowing green.

I looked around the sky and there was this light behind me that looked like a star, but

it was really bright.

I took a navigation head and when I went to go look back, it swung around to the front

of the boat.

442

And when it swung around to the front of the boat, the object that was under me came out

443

00:26:27,990 --> 00:26:30,111

of the water and took off into the sky.

444

Can you describe exactly what you saw in the water?

445

Well, I thought it might have been a submarine, but you know, because it was cylindrical.

But it wasn't a submarine because there was no lights on it or anything.

And all it did was it made the water around it glow a green glow.

448

Multiple witnesses seeing USOs report a green glow underneath their boats.

But this glow could just be bioluminescence.

Bioluminescence is a chemical reaction in the water that produces light.

451

In fact, 90 percent of marine life produces bioluminescence.

452

00:27:08,360 --> 00:27:12,521

And describe for me the interaction it had with the water.

453

00:27:12,521 --> 00:27:16,002

I guess you'd say the water domed in front and then it broke out of the water.

454

00:27:19,643 --> 00:27:27,085

An object underwater larger than Captain Keith's boat exiting the water quickly should have

455

00:27:27,085 --> 00:27:33,007

generated a pressure wave of such magnitude that it could easily swamp the boat.

456

We've got to find out what made that object exit the water so smoothly that it didn't

457

00:27:42,169 --> 00:27:44,290

broach Captain Keith's sailboat.

458

00:27:44,290 --> 00:27:48,811

Captain Keith's testimony gels with Petty Officer Howard's and the testimony of a lot

459

00:27:48,811 --> 00:27:54,812

of other witnesses who say that they see craft enter and exit the water without making a splash.

460

00:27:55,613 --> 00:27:56,973

Now how is this possible?

461

00:27:59,134 --> 00:28:01,774

So what was going through your mind while this was going on?

462

00:28:01,774 --> 00:28:06,415

That was pet-fied. I didn't know what it was going to do. I was 100 miles offshore.

463

I was in a radio dead zone. There was no way I could communicate back to shore if anything was going to happen.

464

How long does this trip typically take?

465

And do you stop for sleep or do you drive right through?

Sometimes when we're out in the ocean we'll see lights in the water.

484

There'll be circles probably about 10 feet deep green colored and glowing looking.

485

We're here right on the shore of the Gulf of Mexico because some shark fishermen out here in

486

Gulf Breeze contacted us and they said they see lights in the water at night when they're out

there at night shark fishing.

All right basically what we do is we'll kayak all this bait out for shark fishing about

hotels or anything like that it's a lot quieter you can see things in the sky in the water that

you wouldn't be able to see at all here you can actually see straight down.

My name is Marcus May and I see UFOs and USOs while I'm shark fishing.

Nope it's just there and it's glowing.

Pat is able to cause the lights themselves just by violently pushing his ore through the water.

This is bioluminescence that's what he's seeing out there a chemical reaction

caused by an organism and the result of this chemical reaction is an emission of light.

528

This is a very good explanation to what all the fishermen are seeing themselves.

529

We we've dropped the bait.

530

There are uh Marcus's there are sharks uh around us at this time.

When things go in the water really fast they tend to create a little column of air behind
