It reminds me of the 1992 alleged crash over South Haven Park, where supposedly Brookhaven National Laboratories was involved.

The 1992 crash of a UFO in a wooded area on Long Island occurred just five miles south of Brookhaven National Laboratories.

That's significant because high-tech energy facilities have long been suspected of attracting alien interest.

Well, Brookhaven National Lab, I mean, that's a state-of-the-art scientific research facility.

And they created the first peacetime nuclear reactor.

Six Nobel Prizes have come from work at Brookhaven.

One of the world's largest particle accelerators was built there.

The work being done here is far ahead of what most understand about science.

So if extraterrestrial civilizations were interested in how we would challenge or threaten distant galaxies,

they would hypothetically want to set up surveillance over Brookhaven.

Mark has made a dedicated practice of videotaping them regularly.

recording compass headings,

and taking notes so that he can figure out what these lights are.

Originally they were appearing in the Smithtown Bay Area,

The lights that Mark is describing match up with the craft in the surveillance operation.

Like Mark, I want to discover what these lights are.

They might not flash or strobe like a traditional airplane,

Teres Massan is a video analyst who's an expert finding the truth about what's on tape.

85

Most UFO footage that he analyzes is brief, but it's not a big deal.

And it's rushed, but Mark's video is different.

87

There are hours of footage, and it's meticulously supported with data.

He's been very diligent about recording his shooting location,

and he keeps very good notes.

I would call him a very reliable witness.

You actually pick up a very large number of these lights.

What's consistent through all of the footage is that their motion is almost stationary.

What was a little freaky was when you speed these things up at many multiple times playback speed,

The first thing that I always do when I look at this footage is try to establish sight lines.

I actually have a map here I can show that plots this out.

You can see up here on the Southern Connecticut shore,

six different locations that I was able to isolate and then correspond his shooting directions.

Basically bullseye are Republic JFK and LaGuardia airports.

You can see the pattern actually corresponds to figure eight kind of corkscrew,

very consistent with lineup coming into an airport.

Now is every video taken line of sight to airport just like this?

So this is the remaining footage.

So we're watching it same camera settings, same effects, blown out lights,

Mark's video shows us this.

A craft that could appear to be about 25 miles from Brookhaven National Laboratory,

Given Brookhaven's long history as a leader in breakthrough energy research,

131

There were some gentlemen standing out front, and they seemed to be pointing in the direction of South Haven Park.

How long did the sky stay light?

141

It was 10 seconds, maybe.

A flash. Enough for you to go, what's going on?

I actually said to my husband, they just bombed New York.

Ever since that evening, we've heard a lot of stories about what might have happened in South Haven Park,

145

and the fact that it happened around that area.

We're meeting with Denise Gazowski, an eyewitness who saw a tremendous flash across the sky on November 24th, 1992.

147

It was the same night that a UFO reportedly crashed in South Haven County Park,

148

00:12:00,698 --> 00:12:03,698

just five miles from Brookhaven National Laboratories.

149

I know we lost our lights, and I know the next few blocks over lost our lights.

150

00:12:09,697 --> 00:12:16,696

But when they contact the utility company, there's no record of any problems with the electric that night in this area.

151

But you personally experienced the power outage.

152

00:12:19,696 --> 00:12:22,695

So the utility, as far as you were concerned, is not telling the truth.

153

Exactly. Through the whole thing, it was that there was something that was being kept from the public.

154

Talking to Denise was great because she really cemented it all together for me.

155

Something strange did happen in the park. Huge lights in the sky. The power went off in the neighborhood.

156

It's on the same night that this crash was reported.

157

00:12:42,693 --> 00:12:48,692

So finally we have some real information that we can use that something very strange did happen that night, and there was an incident in the park.

158

Whoever wants to give you an explanation can give you ten different explanations, but you can't explain that light.

159

00:12:54,691 --> 00:12:58,691

According to Denise and other witnesses, something emitted a huge flash in the sky in 1992.

160

Some think that it might have been a UFO, possibly doing surveillance on Brookhaven National Laboratory.

161

00:13:04,690 --> 00:13:06,690

That was shot down and rained debris over Southhaven County Park.

162

00:13:07,689 --> 00:13:12,689

Although the park was reportedly locked down afterward, there still may be some trace evidence that remains.

163

So this is where it happened?

164

00:13:15,688 --> 00:13:16,688

This is where it happened.

165

This is where it happened.

166

00:13:18,688 --> 00:13:20,688

This is more of a debris field rather than a crash.

167

Steve Iovaroni and Tony West are veteran UFO investigators on Long Island.

168

Along with other members of LUFON, they investigated the crash in 1992.

169

00:13:31,686 --> 00:13:33,686

If anyone can shed light on this case, it's Steve and Tony.

170

Have low witnesses say something that was falling out of the sky, they said it had a cylinder.

171

00:13:39,685 --> 00:13:42,685

It was rotating and turning from blue to white to green.

172

00:13:43,685 --> 00:13:48,684

As it came over the park, it made a right angle turn and it just fell apart all over this place.

173

00:13:51,684 --> 00:13:57,683

So here's what we've got so far. Mark's footage of a craft possibly doing surveillance and coming in from the southeast.

174

In that same area, the park is located in the south of the park.

175

00:14:01,682 --> 00:14:07,682

So here's what we've got so far. Mark's footage of a craft possibly doing surveillance and coming in from the southeast.

176

And in that same direction, we have witness Denise Kazowski, describing a bright sustained flash in the sky in November 1992.

177

And now we have additional witness reports from that night about a craft that spun out of control before exploding and raining debris all over the park.

178

Could this UFO be the same type of craft that Mark caught on tape?

179

Who would normally respond to some kind of accident or crash out here?

180

00:14:37,678 --> 00:14:41,677

The Hagamah Fire Department did respond. They were the first people on the scene to put out the fire.

181

00:14:42,677 --> 00:14:45,677

Suffolk County Police came on and started closing the park down.

182

00:14:46,677 --> 00:14:53,676

They let Brookhaven National Lab inside the park. The only ones allowed inside the park and all the other fire departments were outside the perimeter of the park.

183

00:14:54,675 --> 00:14:56,675

Why couldn't they get in? Suffolk County Police turned them away.

184

00:14:56,675 --> 00:15:04,674

40 minutes approximately after that, these guys in black jumpsuits came over to the Suffolk County Police told them to leave the area and they left immediately.

185

00:15:05,674 --> 00:15:10,673

This is a huge twist in the story of what happened at South Haven Park that night.

186

00:15:11,673 --> 00:15:18,672

There's no reason a fire crew from Brookhaven National Laboratories should have had special access to the crash that night.

187

00:15:19,672 --> 00:15:20,672

But witnesses said they did.

188

00:15:21,672 --> 00:15:29,671

The witnesses described this debris was carried out on a flatbed. Trucks look like military trucks with a military kind of canvas wrapped around it.

189

00:15:30,671 --> 00:15:34,670

So with such a large debris field, how long would you estimate it would take to clean up the wreckage?

190

00:15:35,670 --> 00:15:42,669

Well, they did it in two days. Towards the end of the second day, they had to actually widen the roads to get the flatbeds in and to get the flatbeds out.

191

00:15:43,669 --> 00:15:45,669

So you mean they had construction crews actually widening the roads?

192

00:15:46,669 --> 00:15:49,668

We only know that from when we came back and we found that the roads were widening.

193

00:15:51,668 --> 00:15:57,667

This case is over 16 years old and it would be nice to have more first-hand witness accounts.

194

00:15:58,667 --> 00:16:06,666

What we have is a lot of reports about road closures, strange behavior of authorities in charge, and a utility company's denial of a power outage.

195

I mean, is this a well-executed conspiracy or just a non-event? I think we have to keep digging.

196

There was a fireman who actually was videotaping all of this activity. About a week and a half later, it was anonymous so we left in our mailbox.

197

He doesn't want us to know who he is, but he feels that we should know about this.

198

00:16:26,663 --> 00:16:28,663

Okay, Steve, show us the video. Follow me.

199

00:16:34,662 --> 00:16:35,662

Who's got the DVD? Steve?

200

00:16:36,662 --> 00:16:37,662

It's right here.

201

00:16:38,662 --> 00:16:39,662

Walk us through it, Steve. Okay, here we go.

202

You see the big chunk of debris? Yeah. Right over there on fire? Mm-hmm.

203

00:16:50,660 --> 00:16:52,660

And you see how the cameraman is zooming in on it?

204

00:16:56,660 --> 00:17:00,659

In about a second, you're going to see these two guys, one's pulling out a body bag.

205

00:17:02,659 --> 00:17:04,659

And they're stacking something up against the tray.

206

00:17:04,659 --> 00:17:11,658

It's very intriguing. There are men doing some kind of activity involving mylar blankets, which would be used to cover bodies.

207

If this was a crash, you know, hypothetically, this is what these men could be covering up.

208

00:17:18,657 --> 00:17:23,656

If this tape is real, we will have the first live recorded evidence of a UFO crash in American history.

209

The videotape of the supposed UFO crash response was anonymously dropped in the mailbox belonging to UFO investigators.

210

00:17:43,653 --> 00:17:46,653

And we don't know how many generations removed from the original it is.

211

00:17:47,653 --> 00:17:50,653

And without more information, we just can't tell if this is a hoax or not.

212

00:17:51,652 --> 00:17:56,652

So to find the truth, we need to meet with the first responders in the area to find out their take about what happened.

213

00:17:57,652 --> 00:18:05,651

November 1992, members of the department did respond to what was a report of smoke in the area, a potential fire.

214

00:18:06,650 --> 00:18:13,650

So now Chief of South Country Ambulance Company Greg Maglino Jr. was on duty that night, November 24, 1992.

215

00:18:14,649 --> 00:18:18,649

If there were an accident or a crash in South Haven County Park, his ambulance would have rolled on it.

216

00:18:19,649 --> 00:18:22,648

So I was in one of my marked vehicles, so I started heading that way.

217

00:18:22,648 --> 00:18:27,648

It was determined by either the Park Police or the Suffolk County Police Department, we have jurisdiction over there,

218

00:18:28,648 --> 00:18:31,647

that it was just simply some campers that were there later in the year.

219

00:18:32,647 --> 00:18:35,647

So someone announced over the radio that there was no need for any other units to show up.

220

00:18:36,647 --> 00:18:41,646

We weren't specifically told to go away. Once we heard that it was the campgrounds, we released ourselves.

221

00:18:43,646 --> 00:18:45,645

I mean, this is not a scenic national park or anything.

222

00:18:45,645 --> 00:18:53,644

It's a county park in the suburbs of Long Island on a weeknight in November, with nighttime temperatures in the 30s.

223

00:18:54,644 --> 00:18:57,644

Not exactly the time or place to attract a lot of campers.

224

00:18:59,644 --> 00:19:06,643

Now, if there had been some kind of hazmat incident or an incident involving nuclear materials, who would roll on that?

225

00:19:07,642 --> 00:19:12,642

In 1992, that would either be the Suffolk County Emergency Services Unit back then, Brookhaven National Lab.

226

00:19:12,642 --> 00:19:18,641

Why would Brookhaven be a facility that would respond to any kind of nuclear accident and be in charge of the decontamination?

227

00:19:19,641 --> 00:19:31,639

Brookhaven National Lab has a small reactor that they've used for many years for testing, and their firefighters and fire department are explicitly trained in responding to radiological emergencies.

228

00:19:35,639 --> 00:19:40,638

We need to go to Ground Zero in this case, and that's Brookhaven National Laboratories itself.

229

00:19:40,638 --> 00:19:46,637

We've gained special access to the laboratory grounds to meet with one of Brookhaven's leading scientists.

Brookhaven is a national laboratory run by the U.S. Department of Energy for peacetime research and scientific research.

Todd Sadagata is an accelerator physicist and the leader of the Physics Accelerator Operations Analyst Group at the Collider Accelerator Department in Brookhaven.

232

00:20:04,635 --> 00:20:10,634

We are investigating a lot of UFO activity that took place right here on the edge of Long Island.

233

00:20:12,634 --> 00:20:24,632

Our hypothesis that somehow UFOs are kind of drawn to our use of nuclear power to kind of keep an eye on us and wondering what your take might be on that.

234

00:20:25,632 --> 00:20:34,631

I've worked at Brookhaven for a long time and I have never seen anything like that, but then again I'm a scientist and what I value is data.

235

00:20:37,631 --> 00:20:46,630

We have several particle accelerators here on site. The newest is the relativistic heavy ion collider. You're actually in our control room right now.

236

00:20:47,629 --> 00:20:57,628

What we're doing in this collider is studying particles that make up atomic nuclei and the forces between them to understand the underlying matter.

237

00:20:59,628 --> 00:21:04,627

Particle colliders work by accelerating atoms to near the speed of light and then smashing them together.

238

00:21:05,627 --> 00:21:13,626

These collisions release billions of subatomic particles that scientists can study and in doing so can unlock some of the mysteries of the universe.

239

Well, there's the energy that's released in the collider.

240

00:21:18,625 --> 00:21:23,625

Might some aspect of that energy be detected from Earth orbit?

241

00:21:23,625 --> 00:21:32,624

Particles that come out of there, most of those particles decay away very rapidly, but there are particles that are produced that then travel off long distances.

242

Our particle colliders might look a little brighter than the rest of the planet.

243

So your experiments here are actually giving off some kind of a signature?

244

If you can detect those sorts of things, it very well could be.

245

00:21:48,621 --> 00:22:03,620

Brookhaven's particle accelerator produces so much energy and perhaps could release so many particles that the operation could be detected from outer space by anyone with especially sensitive detection equipment.

246

So perhaps the operation could be a signal to ETs to come for a closer look.

247

00:22:09,619 --> 00:22:17,618

Did you hear anything about an incident that occurred five miles from here in 1992, maybe a big fire or something like that?

248

00:22:17,618 --> 00:22:27,616

What you can do is you can talk to our fire captain. He was part of the response crew then. He was actually on site at the time and he has much more experience about it.

249

Witnesses reported that Brookhaven National Laboratory was the only fire department allowed access to the park.

250

00:22:37,615 --> 00:22:43,614

We've got to talk to this fire crew to confirm or deny the accuracy of this report.

251

There was nothing that happened. To be totally honest, the 24th, I do have the logbook here. There was nothing unusual, no unusual calls, and the laboratory equipment as far as Brookhaven National Laboratory never left site that night for any reason.

252

Chuck LaSalle is the current chief of the Brookhaven National Laboratory firefighting team. He's been there for 33 years, so he'll know what happened back in November 1992.

Now, there's no mention in the logbook about a crash or even just a fire in general. Does that mean there wasn't a fire in South Haven Park that night? Would it be in the logbook?

254

I don't know that there was a fire in South Haven Park. I again can tell you, we did not participate or mutual aid in any shape, way or form to South Haven Park that night.

255

If you were involved in some sort of operation that dealt with national security, would that be something that might be expunged from your logs or something that you would not be able to speak about?

256

I would have to say yes, but I wouldn't lie to you and say, well, this couldn't be kept a secret except 17 years in a firehouse. If you know anything about a firehouse, we like to brag.

257

And for this never to be released in 17 years, what a great secret.

258

So if there were a fire in South Haven Park 16 years ago and we were to go in a scene, what would you recommend that we look for?

259

16 years, 17 years is going to cover a lot and you still could have the fact that there were other brush fires there over that period.

260

00:24:14,602 --> 00:24:25,601

So charred areas might not give away the fact that there was a crash there as such, maybe the tops of trees, but as I said, 16, 17 years is a long time.

261

Chief Lissala said the lab's firefighting crew never responded to a crash at South Haven County Park, so we have to go back to the scene to look for crash evidence ourselves.

262

00:24:36,600 --> 00:24:43,599

To do all this, we need a forensic archaeologist, so we're bringing in an expert, Garth Baldwin.

263

00:24:47,598 --> 00:24:57,597

Well, we've been brought in today to take a look around at the landform, the vegetation, any environmental indicators that might lead us to a conclusion about the story that was told out here.

264

00:24:57,597 --> 00:25:05,596

There's supposed to be a road of some kind and things like that, so what we want to look for are unnatural modifications to the landform and the vegetation.

265

00:25:07,596 --> 00:25:10,595

So what do you think of this place?

266

00:25:10,595 --> 00:25:20,594

Well, coming in, all the vegetation along this roughly 25 feet strip is less than 17 years old. The trees are only maybe 5 to 10.

267

00:25:20,594 --> 00:25:26,593

And that's a funny sort of crushed broken limb up there. See how it's crushed and it's splintered?

268

00:25:26,593 --> 00:25:28,593

There's a lot of broken stuff out here.

269

00:25:29,593 --> 00:25:36,592

If Garth is right then there should still be signs of the fallen debris that would have collided with the tops of these oak trees.

270

00:25:36,592 --> 00:25:42,591

So we're looking for oak trees that might have fracturing in the branch structure even after all this time.

271

00:25:42,591 --> 00:25:50,590

As for the road, Tony and Steve told us that the UFO debris removal crew had to fortify the dirt road for all the flatbed trucks moving in and out of the park.

272

00:25:50,590 --> 00:25:59,589

We're looking for signs of that road and it's interesting that on either side of this strip of the forest there are stands of oak trees that are from 18 to 40 feet tall.

273

00:25:59,589 --> 00:26:06,588

But in the middle of the strip there are younger, smaller trees only 6 feet tall. This bears a closer look.

274

00:26:08,588 --> 00:26:12,587

What would explain a clearing like this amidst the denseness of places like that?

275

Well, something definitely cleared out everything through here and not a fire.

276

00:26:16,587 --> 00:26:21,586

I mean that wouldn't explain it because there would be stumps. There's nothing in here. It could be a road.

277

And then it's dark underneath there. Got that gray sand. That's definitely a traveled surface.

278

00:26:36,584 --> 00:26:41,583

On top of these hills or something there might be a more natural surface.

279

00:26:46,583 --> 00:26:51,582

No, it's a lot softer. A lot softer. So there's your differential compaction right there.

280

00:26:54,582 --> 00:27:03,580

Garth has shown that the soil in the supposed location of the fortified dirt road is more compact and shows more signs of travel from soil samples taken nearby.

281

00:27:06,580 --> 00:27:13,579

There's some scarring at the top of that tree. So that tree was alive when it was broken off, it was sheared off and it's growing back.

282

00:27:13,579 --> 00:27:22,578

Garth is telling me two things that are really interesting. One, he's looking at the tops of these trees and saying that the way some of these trees have been lopped off, topped off,

283

00:27:22,578 --> 00:27:26,577

is consistent with an object coming down in a debris field.

284

00:27:26,577 --> 00:27:30,577

So you have like shrapnel coming down. It would hit some trees, it wouldn't hit others.

285

00:27:30,577 --> 00:27:35,576

Exactly. We saw, you know, there's a couple of them that are splintered, you know, the couple of those branches that are splintered.

286

00:27:35,576 --> 00:27:38,576

That top was taken off and it's regrowing, it's scarred.

287

00:27:41,575 --> 00:27:48,575

And two, he looked at the compaction of the road up a piece and down here and said, you know what, that's not inconsistent.

288

00:27:48,575 --> 00:27:57,573

With an army flatbed falling a piece of debris out, getting it back up this road in two days, there's no inconsistency there. It could have happened.

289

00:28:01,573 --> 00:28:08,572

What did you think of what we found on Long Island?

290

00:28:08,572 --> 00:28:14,571

I have to say I was really impressed with Mark's footage. I mean, there's no way to really easily explain what he caught on video.

291

00:28:14,571 --> 00:28:20,570

That was some very strange footage, but does it tie into the crash and the sightings at South Haven?

292

00:28:20,570 --> 00:28:24,570

Unfortunately, I don't think we can make a definitive connection to a UFO crash.

293

00:28:24,570 --> 00:28:28,569

What did you guys think of Brookhaven?

294

00:28:28,569 --> 00:28:34,569

I looked at the log myself and it looks legit and if they're going to cover it up, they did a hell of a good job.

295

00:28:34,569 --> 00:28:40,568

You have to factor in all the eyewitnesses that actually saw Brookhaven National Lab vehicles going to the crash site.

296

00:28:40,568 --> 00:28:41,568

That's right.

297

00:28:41,568 --> 00:28:43,567

So, I mean, I don't know how you explain that.

298

00:28:44,567 --> 00:28:47,567

Look, guys, we're freezing out here.

299

00:28:47,567 --> 00:28:57,566

On the west coast, it's warmer where there's another video of UFOs of the Lawrence Livermore, a

laboratory like BNL does energy research.

300

00:28:57,566 --> 00:28:59,565

Unlike BNL, weapons research.

301

00:28:59,565 --> 00:29:00,565

Lasers.

302

00:29:00,565 --> 00:29:02,565

Lasers, high energy lasers.

303

00:29:02,565 --> 00:29:06,564

So, let's see what UFO activities over Lawrence Livermore.

304

00:29:06,564 --> 00:29:07,564

I look forward to.

305

00:29:07,564 --> 00:29:08,564

Let's go.

306

00:29:08,564 --> 00:29:28,562

After examining footage, witness reports and trace evidence of UFO activity over Brookhaven National Laboratory on Long Island,

307

00:29:28,562 --> 00:29:37,560

we're heading into Altamon Hills to search for alien surveillance in the skies over the premier weapons research lab in North America,

308

00:29:37,560 --> 00:29:40,560

the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory.

309

00:29:43,560 --> 00:29:45,559

Here's where I worked for 17 summers.

310

00:29:45,559 --> 00:29:48,559

I taught physics during the year at Nebraska-Omohan, came out here.

311

00:29:48,559 --> 00:29:50,559

I worked in D-Division.

312

00:29:50,559 --> 00:29:53,558

I studied the physics of the effects of nuclear weapons.

313

00:29:54,558 --> 00:29:58,558

Not only was Jack Hasher a professor of physics at the University of Nebraska at Omaha,

314

00:29:58,558 --> 00:30:05,557

he spent 18 years working on powerful microwave lasers as a researcher at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory.

315

00:30:05,557 --> 00:30:09,556

Was the work that you were working on at the time, was that classified information?

316

00:30:09,556 --> 00:30:11,556

Yeah, it was very, very highly classified.

317

00:30:11,556 --> 00:30:14,556

I found as time went on, security became a lot tighter at the lab.

318

00:30:14,556 --> 00:30:19,555

What was the ratio of the pure science research to Department of Defense weapons research?

319

00:30:19,555 --> 00:30:25,554

Most of the time when I was out here, it was about 50-50, where you'd have, you know, after physics, geology and so on.

320

00:30:25,554 --> 00:30:29,554

That made up about half of it, and the rest of it was defense-oriented.

321

00:30:31,553 --> 00:30:33,553

Weapons research became a big priority.

322

00:30:33,553 --> 00:30:39,552

They did work on nuclear-powered X-ray lasers that were the foundation of the Star Wars missile defense program.

323

00:30:39,552 --> 00:30:46,551

And if Livermore concentrated that much on weapons research, it's likely that they became a target for alien surveillance.

324

00:30:49,551 --> 00:30:55,550

There's the theory that once humanity started developing nuclear energy and nuclear weapons,

325

00:30:55,550 --> 00:30:59,550

that extraterrestrials are observing facilities where this is taking place.

326

00:30:59,550 --> 00:31:00,550

They do.

327

00:31:01,549 --> 00:31:10,548

Over in Russia, for example, a 900-foot diameter saucer hovered over a Russian missile silo for four hours.

328

00:31:11,548 --> 00:31:15,548

Then you got Malmstrom, where the UFO was over the base.

329

00:31:16,547 --> 00:31:21,547

I mean, it's not really a question of, do you think they will? They have done that several times.

330

00:31:21,547 --> 00:31:26,546

Do you know of anything at Lawrence Livermore Labs that would give off some kind of signature that could be detected from space?

331

00:31:26,546 --> 00:31:32,545

They've done some fusion experiments and so on, and that might be attractive.

332

00:31:34,545 --> 00:31:38,545

Jack, I'm curious about the effectiveness of lasers as a weapon.

333

00:31:38,545 --> 00:31:46,544

It would certainly have to be powerful enough to knock a missile out, and so I don't know how well-defended a UFO would be,

334

00:31:46,544 --> 00:31:51,543

but it would be worth a shot, I guess, if we felt it was some kind of a threat to us.

335

00:31:51,543 --> 00:31:54,542

So would aliens consider lasers a threat then?

336

00:31:54,542 --> 00:31:58,542

I think that if what we're speculating about is true, certainly.

337

If Brookhaven's particle beam research were somehow involved in bringing down a UFO,

338

00:32:06,541 --> 00:32:11,540

then Lawrence Livermore Labs, which makes no secret about its mission to preserve national security,

339

00:32:11,540 --> 00:32:15,540

would be even more inclined to have the weaponry to take out a UFO.

340

00:32:15,540 --> 00:32:20,539

We're going to meet with an investigator who might have information on such a case involving Livermore.

341

00:32:22,539 --> 00:32:28,538

Some sort of a streaking object had shot across the entire sky of the Bay Area roughly.

342

00:32:28,538 --> 00:32:34,537

I mean, we had reports that it made a course correction off-coast before coming inland, before breaking apart.

343

00:32:35,537 --> 00:32:44,536

Olaf Phillips was one of the first investigators to report on the supposed UFO crash in August 1998 over Livermore, California.

344

00:32:45,536 --> 00:32:49,535

We had a source that had seen lasers actually coming out of Livermore.

345

00:32:52,535 --> 00:33:03,534

Late at night, on August 6, 1998, witnesses over the Bay Area report seeing a craft in the air making abrupt directional changes.

346

00:33:03,534 --> 00:33:06,533

That means it couldn't have been a meteorite.

347

00:33:07,533 --> 00:33:16,532

Just hours after the sighting, a very strange thing happens at a tire dump just seven miles away from Livermore's test area.

348

00:33:16,532 --> 00:33:23,531

Did anyone bother to come up here and investigate a possible crash site the next day or days after this was all reported?

349

00:33:23,531 --> 00:33:30,530

You know, everyone, including me, wanted to come out here, but unfortunately because there was a tire fire associate with the area where it had crashed.

350

00:33:31,530 --> 00:33:33,530

So the whole area was completely toxified.

351

00:33:33,530 --> 00:33:36,529

How close is this tire fire to the alleged crash site?

352

00:33:36,529 --> 00:33:38,529

I believe it was less than a quarter of a mile.

353

00:33:40,529 --> 00:33:45,528

The tire dump burns for two entire years and is not cleaned up for five years.

354

00:33:46,528 --> 00:33:52,527

By that point, any possible traces of the reported UFO crash are long obliterated.

355

00:33:54,527 --> 00:33:56,527

It takes very little to burn grass.

356

00:33:56,527 --> 00:33:57,526

Right.

357

00:33:57,526 --> 00:34:04,526

However, it takes a lot to ignite as you're calling it a massive field of tires.

358

00:34:04,526 --> 00:34:07,525

That's something that has bothered me for the last ten years.

359

00:34:08,525 --> 00:34:12,525

I mean, from an investigational point of view, it's a nightmare because everything is gone.

360

00:34:12,525 --> 00:34:13,524

It was a perfect cover.

361

00:34:13,524 --> 00:34:17,524

I don't know if it was intentionally started as a cover, but it definitely served as a cover.

362

00:34:20,523 --> 00:34:26,523

At both Brookhaven and Livermore National Laboratories, we have apparent signs of UFO crashes,

363

00:34:26,523 --> 00:34:31,522

occurring in close proximity to places where high-energy research has been performed.

364

00:34:31,522 --> 00:34:36,521

This could suggest that UFOs perceive these labs as posing a threat to them,

365

00:34:36,521 --> 00:34:39,521

thus meriting surveillance operations.

366

00:34:40,521 --> 00:34:44,520

What's even more intriguing is how both crashes seem to be covered up.

367

00:34:45,520 --> 00:34:48,520

At South Hayden Park, we heard how feds had arrived at the scene

368

00:34:48,520 --> 00:34:51,519

and erased any evidence of a UFO debris field.

369

00:34:52,519 --> 00:34:59,518

Now here at Livermore, we see how a suspicious tire fire might have obliterated any evidence of a UFO crash.

370

00:35:09,517 --> 00:35:14,516

Near Long Island, Mark's UFO footage was proof of UFO surveillance near Brookhaven.

371

00:35:14,516 --> 00:35:19,516

What we need now is video evidence of surveillance near Lawrence Livermore Labs,

372

00:35:19,516 --> 00:35:21,516

and we might have it.

373

00:35:24,515 --> 00:35:25,515

Hey AI, how's it going?

374

00:35:25,515 --> 00:35:26,515

Good.

375

00:35:26,515 --> 00:35:27,515

Good.

376

00:35:27,515 --> 00:35:32,514

Al Murphy is one of the premier video analysts in all of California.

377

00:35:32,514 --> 00:35:38,513

In fact, Al worked at Lockheed Skunk Works on some classified projects,

378

00:35:38,513 --> 00:35:44,513

and he specializes in figuring out what's happening on a video, how movement can be determined.

379

00:35:45,512 --> 00:35:50,512

This video was shot by a gentleman named Pablo, who did not want to appear on camera.

380

00:35:50,512 --> 00:35:54,511

He told us he was 20 miles away from Lawrence Livermore Laboratories.

381

00:35:56,511 --> 00:36:02,510

Well the first thing I notice is that it looks like it was shot with a night vision scope.

382

00:36:05,510 --> 00:36:09,509

You can see there's an object here very high up, very far away.

383

00:36:09,509 --> 00:36:11,509

It looks like it's moving very fast.

384

00:36:11,509 --> 00:36:13,509

It's a sequence of lights.

385

00:36:14,509 --> 00:36:19,508

The geometry of the lights is different, and they kind of move with respect to each other.

386

00:36:20,508 --> 00:36:24,507

If you look closely, you can see stars behind the lights,

387

00:36:24,507 --> 00:36:29,507

so that would kind of indicate to me that it's a formation and not a single crash.

388

00:36:29,507 --> 00:36:31,506

Right, but a formation of what?

389

00:36:32,506 --> 00:36:35,506

A formation of something that we don't know what it is.

390

00:36:38,505 --> 00:36:39,505

Are helicopters an option?

391

00:36:39,505 --> 00:36:41,505

I don't think helicopters are an option.

392

00:36:43,505 --> 00:36:48,504

To be pulling maneuvers like this, flying in tight formation, again over civilian airspace,

393

00:36:48,504 --> 00:36:52,504

it just doesn't really work for me.

394

00:36:52,504 --> 00:36:57,503

After looking at this and after this discussion, would you say these lights are pretty unconventional?

395

00:36:57,503 --> 00:37:02,502

I would say it's pretty unconventional to fly in close formation at night, yes.

396

00:37:02,502 --> 00:37:08,502

We have to consider the possibility that we are looking at a UFO that is interested in what's going on over Lawrence Livermore Labs.

397

00:37:08,502 --> 00:37:13,501

I think it's really time to find out what has happened at Livermore and what's happening now.

398

00:37:22,500 --> 00:37:28,499

We are so excited about the possibility that UFOs are surveilling Lawrence Livermore Labs.

399

00:37:28,499 --> 00:37:36,498

We're going to use our Fourier truck, our very high-tech surveillance vehicle with all kinds of cameras and imaging devices

400

00:37:36,498 --> 00:37:40,497

to stay out here at night. Maybe we can discover our own UFO.

401

00:37:40,497 --> 00:37:42,497

Hi guys, come on in.

402

00:37:49,496 --> 00:37:54,496

This camera is sensitive in a much further wavelength from the visible.

403

00:37:54,496 --> 00:38:00,495

We're meeting with Roy Monberg of the Fleer Corporation, one of the pioneering inventors of thermal imaging technology.

404

00:38:00,495 --> 00:38:06,494

We're going to spend the night on a sky watch with Roy to figure out just what is flying over Livermore.

405

00:38:06,494 --> 00:38:11,493

So we're not actually seeing lights, we're not seeing tail lights and headlights there.

406

00:38:11,493 --> 00:38:12,493

That's correct.

407

00:38:15,493 --> 00:38:20,492

The human eye can register only a minor portion of light in the electromagnetic spectrum,

408

00:38:20,492 --> 00:38:23,492

approximately in the range of 400 to 700 nanometers.

409

00:38:23,492 --> 00:38:28,491

At best, night vision cameras like Pablo's double this range.

410

00:38:29,491 --> 00:38:33,490

But this Fler camera on the other hand expands this range a thousand-fold.

411

00:38:34,490 --> 00:38:42,489

If aliens and extraterrestrials are doing things outside of our visual spectrum, as some people have hypothesized,

412

00:38:42,489 --> 00:38:49,488

how effective would this be in our search for aerial vehicles over Lawrence Livermore laboratory?

413

00:38:49,488 --> 00:38:53,488

Anything that puts out a thermal signature, this camera is going to see.

414

00:38:53,488 --> 00:39:00,487

With the tool that I have here, I can spot an airplane as we're doing right here across the approach quarters 25, 30 miles away.

415

00:39:01,487 --> 00:39:07,486

If an alien craft were keeping watch over this lab and that craft generated the slightest thermal signature,

416

00:39:07,486 --> 00:39:14,485

Lawrence Livermore would have the technology to quickly detect it, and it would most likely possess just the weapon to destroy that craft.

417

00:39:15,485 --> 00:39:19,484

You're going to see scheduled airline traffic coming and going on the approach end into Oakland.

418

00:39:19,484 --> 00:39:23,484

So if we keep going this way, we should probably find the next guy that's out there.

419

00:39:24,484 --> 00:39:26,484

And there he is right there.

420

00:39:26,484 --> 00:39:32,483

That's just a blob of heat in the sky. How can you determine that that is an airplane?

421

00:39:32,483 --> 00:39:37,482

Well, if I can get at it close enough here now, and I'll zoom in a little bit.

422

00:39:38,482 --> 00:39:41,482

It looked like it could be a cylinder, possibly a flying saucer.

423

00:39:41,482 --> 00:39:46,481

It could be, but you know, because I'm staring at the approach end, I'm guessing that it's an airplane going into Oakland.

424

00:39:46,481 --> 00:39:51,480

So if we're going to differentiate between a flying saucer, an extraterrestrial craft, and an airplane,

425

00:39:51,480 --> 00:39:56,480

it's going to be based on the flight pattern of the craft, the movement.

426

00:39:56,480 --> 00:40:01,479

That would be an indicator that I would use to come to a conclusion about what I was looking at.

427

00:40:02,479 --> 00:40:10,478

So even with this advanced thermal imaging system, we can see how some conventional aircraft might be mistaken for UFOs.

428

Still, nothing we've seen here dispels our analysis that marks footage of craft near Brookhaven,

429

00:40:15,477 --> 00:40:20,477

and Pablo's footage of weird formations near Livermore are unconventional.

430

00:40:20,477 --> 00:40:24,476

The craft in those videos could definitely be doing surveillance at those labs.

431

00:40:25,476 --> 00:40:28,475

Let's see here. Why is that doing that?

432

00:40:29,475 --> 00:40:31,475

Let's get a closer look on that and see if we can zoom in.

433

00:40:35,475 --> 00:40:37,474

That one's a go fast.

434

00:40:38,474 --> 00:40:40,474
