Hammy, terrific of course that you've been over here in the UK this summer attending our Millennium UFO Roadshow.

What did you make of all the various venues and the people that you've met here in England?

It's been an extraordinary experience.

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00:03:29,620 --> 00:03:40,820

It's been a very special time for me because I have received a good welcome, a lot of attention,

kindness from you, your family and everybody who is around this phenomenon.

I am really happy, excited to be here, especially because I think England is just starting to see Scotland,

what we have been seeing in Mexico since the eclipse.

And it's very coincidental that you are going to have an eclipse in the August 11th of 1999.

And I think the evidence shows that you are going under the same path that we observe in Mexico, especially in Mexico City.

Now for the benefit of those people who are new to this subject, and there's a lot of young people out there

who are just beginning to learn what a fascinating topic it is that we deal with,

the eclipse of course that sprang Mexico to prominence occurred in July of 1991.

And we have some videotape of course from that period.

What was so special about that eclipse and what was so special about the videotapes that followed?

I didn't know anything about the eclipse.

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00:04:53,300 --> 00:05:02,660

I just experienced, I went to an island, I saw the eclipse was beautiful, the second longest in the century.

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00:05:02,660 --> 00:05:10,420

And then we had these videos with the UFOs, not just in Mexico City, but also in Puebla and in Tula,

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00:05:10,420 --> 00:05:16,500

in three different cities, three different states, it seems, three different UFOs.

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00:05:16,500 --> 00:05:23,860

Then I started to investigate and I found that there were special prophecies made

more than a thousand years before this eclipse.

And they were telling us, especially the Mayan prophecy that you can find at the Dresda Codex,

that this eclipse could bring the end of the big lords and they would have to go and leave

room for the new lords.

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00:05:42,340 --> 00:05:46,740

It could be the end of the Jaguar Knights, probably the war in the world,

and it could be the time of the meeting with the Masters of the Stars.

And that was amazing to me because it was a message.

And if you observe the evidences and you see three different UFOs in three different cities at the same time,

with an incredible eclipse, you have to understand that something very special happened in Mexico that day.

And the most important thing is that the Mexican people became aware of this phenomenon.

For that reason, these eclipse became so important for Mexico.

We didn't know how important until we received the evidences.

We knew how important it was after the eclipse.

Okay, so I suppose for many, many people, the sight of several objects in the sky at any given time is considered to be amazing.

But here we are in Mexico, and once again, we have these extraordinary images of not several UFOs,

but numbers from...

I mean, it is absolutely...

Tell me, we have this very, very rare image of several UFOs.

It's a still photograph taken near the volcano.

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00:07:25,540 --> 00:07:27,380

Was this the first occasion where more than...

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00:07:27,380 --> 00:07:28,500

No, no, no.

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00:07:28,500 --> 00:07:32,420

This picture you are seeing close to the volcano is from 1996.

The first occasion was on the 27th of September 1992.

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00:07:39,780 --> 00:07:43,300

This man, who listens to Hino, was recording a long object,

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00:07:43,540 --> 00:07:50,020

looked like a worm or a cigar shape object standing over Mexico City.

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00:07:50,020 --> 00:07:56,580

Then he realized that over his head, horizontally, horizontally, we're flying at least 18 different objects.

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00:07:56,580 --> 00:08:04,260

And what you can observe in these videos is that they are moving along the way, and they don't never lose the formation.

They never lose the figure, the shape of the figure.

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00:08:07,780 --> 00:08:10,820

Even though they move, they keep that.

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00:08:10,820 --> 00:08:12,180

That was the first time.

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00:08:12,740 --> 00:08:19,300

On the 24th of October 1994, we have the second video from Mr. Tomás Islas,

and now you can see probably around 30 objects or so, and they are standing still.

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00:08:24,900 --> 00:08:28,260

They don't move, and this is two o'clock in the afternoon.

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00:08:28,980 --> 00:08:30,260

Then six weeks later...

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00:08:30,260 --> 00:08:34,500

Because some people have suggested that these are constellations.

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00:08:34,500 --> 00:08:35,540

In the Twilight Zone.

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00:08:37,460 --> 00:08:39,460

Yes, yes, that's what they say.

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00:08:39,460 --> 00:08:41,060

What can they say, you know?

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00:08:41,860 --> 00:08:45,140

This is two o'clock, all of these videos.

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00:08:45,140 --> 00:08:48,500

If we record these videos at night, they could be stars.

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00:08:48,500 --> 00:08:49,780

No question about it.

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00:08:49,780 --> 00:08:53,060

I mean, at least you see 20 stars moving at the same time.

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00:08:53,060 --> 00:08:57,060

But let's say they are still, you can see them.

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00:08:57,060 --> 00:09:01,220

No, the incredible thing with all these videos that we are watching now,

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00:09:01,220 --> 00:09:04,420

is that they were recorded at daylight.

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00:09:05,060 --> 00:09:06,100

And that's very important.

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00:09:06,100 --> 00:09:10,740

Now these are incredible, and you've mentioned this thing that looks almost snake-like,

organic.

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00:09:11,460 --> 00:09:15,460

Now we also have a curious piece of footage taken from the space shuttle.

And here we can see this thing in outer space.

We're looking down on Earth, and it seems to be...

Like a worm.

83

Like a worm.

Yeah, it moves like a worm.

85

00:09:26,340 --> 00:09:28,900

This was recorded on September 1991.

86

00:09:29,460 --> 00:09:31,860

I think it was STS-48.

87

00:09:31,860 --> 00:09:34,580

It was from the Discovery Shuttle.

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00:09:35,620 --> 00:09:40,180

It was releasing a satellite to measure the depletion of the zone layer.

89

00:09:41,460 --> 00:09:47,380

For some reason, we recorded this object that I believe was coming out from North America.

90

00:09:47,380 --> 00:09:52,820

You see the clouds under it, and you can see how this object is ascending,

91

00:09:52,820 --> 00:09:57,380

is rising from the Earth, and is going into the stratosphere.

92

00:09:57,380 --> 00:09:59,380

Has there been any explanation of you asking for it?

93

00:09:59,380 --> 00:10:00,260

No, not at all.

94

00:10:00,260 --> 00:10:02,740

No, yes, I have asked, but you know that.

95

00:10:03,300 --> 00:10:06,580

When they don't have an explanation, they just keep silent, you know?

96

00:10:07,620 --> 00:10:08,580

What do you make of this?

97

00:10:09,540 --> 00:10:12,260

These are two videos that were released in 1997.

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00:10:12,260 --> 00:10:15,940

The first video is from 1984.

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00:10:16,820 --> 00:10:20,340

This, I believe, was the Discovery Shuttle again,

100

00:10:20,340 --> 00:10:26,580

and they were making some reparations fixing the satellite Palapa-22.

101

And at that moment, you can see a sphere that is coming from inside the space,

102

00:10:33,060 --> 00:10:36,340

you know, makes some intelligent movement and goes away.

103

00:10:36,340 --> 00:10:37,620

It's just for a few seconds.

104

But if you see this closely, it's very clear that it's an sphere.

105

And again, in 1991, from the Atlantis, I don't have the number of that mission,

but I know what's from the Atlantis.

You can see this sphere again making some intelligent movements in front of the shuttle,

and then going away.

But what about it looks like a fleet of spheres here?

In this next sequence, viewed from the space shuttle,

has there been any explanation, official or otherwise, been put forward for this?

You know, we see these spheres darting about the sky,

and then here we are now in the top left-hand corner of the screen,

and there are dozens of them.

NASA, NASA.

116

00:11:24,820 --> 00:11:28,180

Yeah, this is this video from the Mir laboratory.

117

Again, again, the Discovery Shuttle was going close to it.

118

00:11:34,740 --> 00:11:40,500

We can see in the left-right corner, in the left-upper corner of the screen,

119

00:11:41,300 --> 00:11:46,260

some like 20 things, spheres passing by.

120

00:11:46,980 --> 00:11:51,300

No, there has not been given any explanation around this.

121

00:11:51,300 --> 00:11:59,940

Probably you could have some because as long as I have asked, they just smile and turn around.

122

00:11:59,940 --> 00:12:03,060

You know, it's the easiest way to not to say.

123

00:12:03,140 --> 00:12:05,780

Not to say anything when you don't have an answer.

124

00:12:05,780 --> 00:12:08,420

These are videos that don't have easy answers.

125

00:12:11,620 --> 00:12:17,060

The name James Bond Johnson was unfamiliar to most UFO enthusiasts until only recently.

126

00:12:17,780 --> 00:12:22,660

But the photographs which Bond Johnson took in the offices of General Roger Ramey at Fort Worth,

127

00:12:22,660 --> 00:12:26,500

Texas back in July 1947 are legendary.

128

00:12:27,620 --> 00:12:30,900

During a brief visit to England in 1999,

129

00:12:30,900 --> 00:12:33,460

we caught up with Bond Johnson at his London hotel.

130

00:12:34,180 --> 00:12:38,500

In this exclusive interview, we learned not only about the man and his role as the

131

photographer who snapped pieces of an alleged UFO that crashed at Rosswell, New Mexico,

132

00:12:43,940 --> 00:12:48,660

but how a chance meeting with a senior retired United States Air Force military figure many

133

00:12:48,660 --> 00:12:55,460

years later led to a claim that more than one UFO had been retrieved and stored at Wright-Patterson

134

00:12:55,460 --> 00:12:56,340

Air Force Base.

135

00:12:57,540 --> 00:12:58,580

Just a reporter.

136

00:12:58,580 --> 00:12:59,380

Just a reporter.

137

00:12:59,380 --> 00:12:59,860

Right.

138

00:13:00,500 --> 00:13:04,500

I didn't, I was not officially a photographer.

139

00:13:05,620 --> 00:13:12,100

I had purchased my own speed graphic and because I worked out hours as a police

140

00:13:12,100 --> 00:13:16,980

reporter working nights, late evening and so forth, I bought my own camera.

141

00:13:16,980 --> 00:13:24,980

I had been an amateur photographer since I was a kid and so I spent some of my war bonds and bought

a

142

So how old would you be then?

143

00:13:27,300 --> 00:13:28,260

I was 21.

144

00:13:28,260 --> 00:13:28,740

21?

145

00:13:28,740 --> 00:13:29,060

Yes.

146

00:13:30,180 --> 00:13:35,220

And would you say that you were an ambitious reporter?

147

00:13:35,940 --> 00:13:37,940

No, I was just working my way through college.

148

00:13:39,220 --> 00:13:40,740

For what specific aim?

149

00:13:40,740 --> 00:13:43,140

What was your sort of career ambitions at that time?

150

00:13:45,300 --> 00:13:50,500

My first degree was in journalism and I was after I was working there, I was planning to follow that up.

151

00:13:51,460 --> 00:13:59,140

And I graduated from, I see I started to college in the fall of 1942, right after

152

00:14:00,100 --> 00:14:04,420

I was a senior in high school when Pearl Harbor happened in December of 1941.

153

00:14:05,060 --> 00:14:10,420

And then I finished the next summer and started into college in September.

154

00:14:11,300 --> 00:14:18,180

And I was a year ahead of my colleagues and I would have probably stayed over and

155

00:14:18,180 --> 00:14:22,580

gone another year to high school except when the war started then there was the urgency

156

00:14:22,580 --> 00:14:25,780

to for everyone to get as much education as possible.

157

00:14:26,260 --> 00:14:28,820

What were the thought worths to our telegram?

158

00:14:29,540 --> 00:14:32,820

What kind of circulation would that have had in those days?

159

00:14:32,820 --> 00:14:37,220

It was the largest newspaper in the south.

160

00:14:37,220 --> 00:14:39,220

That was it in the south of Texas.

161

00:14:39,220 --> 00:14:40,820

No, the south of the United States.

162

00:14:41,460 --> 00:14:41,940

Really?

163

00:14:41,940 --> 00:14:42,180

Yes.

164

00:14:42,820 --> 00:14:48,260

It was a morning evening and Sunday and the combined circulation was the largest in the south.

165

00:14:48,980 --> 00:14:51,700

Now I don't know how it compares today.

166

00:14:51,940 --> 00:14:56,340

Probably the Dallas Morning News is larger now.

167

00:14:56,340 --> 00:14:57,860

But it was just a morning paper.

168

00:14:57,860 --> 00:14:59,700

The Dallas News was a morning paper.

169

00:14:59,700 --> 00:15:01,620

We had a morning afternoon and Sunday.

170

00:15:01,620 --> 00:15:03,860

The morning evening and Sunday they called it.

171

00:15:03,860 --> 00:15:06,740

So the combined circulation made it the largest.

172

00:15:06,740 --> 00:15:14,500

So you were in the offices where you were told to get over to the base?

173

00:15:14,500 --> 00:15:18,900

And what triggered that was this flash message that came from the Associated Press saying they

174

00:15:18,900 --> 00:15:22,580

were flying this flying saucer from Roswell to Fort Worth.

175

00:15:22,580 --> 00:15:28,980

Had you prior to that, had you any indication whatsoever that anything untoward had occurred

176

00:15:28,980 --> 00:15:29,540

at Rossville?

177

00:15:29,540 --> 00:15:34,980

Had there been any rumors on the media grapevine?

178

00:15:34,980 --> 00:15:35,380

No.

179

00:15:35,380 --> 00:15:38,180

This came right out of the blow.

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00:15:38,180 --> 00:15:38,500

Yes.

181

00:15:38,500 --> 00:15:44,020

They were looking for, as I said, the two weeks preceding.

182

00:15:44,100 --> 00:15:49,860

There was a front page article every day in the paper about the flying saucer incident.

183

00:15:49,860 --> 00:15:54,740

And people were looking and they were casting about and they were reporting that they had found one on the beach.

184

00:15:54,740 --> 00:16:01,220

When we talk about the flying saucer incident for the record, we're referring to the Kenneth Arnell incident.

185

00:16:01,220 --> 00:16:05,700

That would have triggered all of the media hype and the public attention.

186

00:16:05,700 --> 00:16:06,180

Yes.

187

00:16:06,180 --> 00:16:10,740

So you were familiar in some respects with what had taken place in Washington State?

188

00:16:10,740 --> 00:16:11,140

Yes.

189

00:16:11,140 --> 00:16:11,620

That was...

190

00:16:11,860 --> 00:16:15,300

You received this flash fire pressure association.

191

00:16:15,300 --> 00:16:19,380

How far would the base have been from the offices of the Fort?

192

00:16:19,380 --> 00:16:21,300

It fits within a half hour.

193

00:16:21,300 --> 00:16:21,780

A half hour.

194

00:16:21,780 --> 00:16:22,820

And did you drive out there?

195

00:16:22,820 --> 00:16:23,300

Yes.

196

00:16:24,260 --> 00:16:24,900

What was your car?

197

00:16:25,780 --> 00:16:27,380

This is for the car enthusiasts.

198

00:16:28,020 --> 00:16:28,820

Was it a vehicle?

199

00:16:28,820 --> 00:16:40,900

I had a brand new 1947 Ford Club Coupe that I paid 15.94.21 for American.

200

00:16:41,860 --> 00:16:47,060

And with including a signal seeker radio and seat covers.

201

00:16:48,660 --> 00:16:49,700

What else do you want to know?

202

00:16:54,420 --> 00:16:59,780

But I was very proud of that car and I got it through the Stark Telegram in 1947.

203

00:16:59,780 --> 00:17:00,980

I'd been on waiting list.

204

00:17:00,980 --> 00:17:03,700

See, I came home from the war at the end of 45.

205

00:17:04,660 --> 00:17:08,500

And I had sold my car when I went in service.

206

00:17:08,580 --> 00:17:10,980

And so I was riding in cabs.

207

00:17:10,980 --> 00:17:17,780

And fortunately our newspaper owner also owned the Yellow Cab Company.

208

00:17:17,780 --> 00:17:19,940

So that made it easy to get about.

209

00:17:19,940 --> 00:17:22,340

But I wanted my own car.

210

00:17:22,340 --> 00:17:23,780

And I'd been on waiting list.

211

00:17:23,780 --> 00:17:28,900

You signed up at different places and would put it on a deposit and wait for a car.

212

00:17:29,460 --> 00:17:30,740

Who was your immediate boss?

213

00:17:30,740 --> 00:17:31,940

So you supervised it?

214

00:17:31,940 --> 00:17:34,740

His name was Cullum Green, was my city editor.

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00:17:34,740 --> 00:17:36,260

And he's the one that came over and said,

216

00:17:36,340 --> 00:17:39,300

Bon, you have your camera because see, I was not normal.

217

00:17:39,300 --> 00:17:41,140

And yeah, I said it's out in the car.

218

00:17:41,140 --> 00:17:43,060

I kept it in the trunk of the car and said,

219

00:17:43,060 --> 00:17:49,220

well, go out to General Ramey's office and they're bringing in a flying saucer.

220

00:17:51,540 --> 00:17:57,860

No, because this was everybody was expecting that sooner or later somebody would come up with one.

221

00:17:57,860 --> 00:18:01,860

They're out there and now they've captured one and they're bringing it to.

222

00:18:01,860 --> 00:18:06,580

And that was a logical thing because this was eight of the headquarters of the airport.

223

00:18:06,580 --> 00:18:07,300

Here you are.

224

00:18:08,100 --> 00:18:09,860

You're in your vehicle.

225

00:18:09,860 --> 00:18:13,220

You've got a 30 minute drive or so to the base.

226

00:18:14,340 --> 00:18:15,940

You've been sent by the city editor.

227

00:18:16,500 --> 00:18:17,940

You're 22 years of age.

228

00:18:17,940 --> 00:18:18,660

21.

229

00:18:18,660 --> 00:18:20,100

21 years of age.

230

00:18:20,100 --> 00:18:26,100

And you're on the brink of potentially the most important news announcement or discovery

231

00:18:27,060 --> 00:18:28,180

on the history of the planet.

232

00:18:28,180 --> 00:18:30,820

I mean, that didn't compute.

233

00:18:30,820 --> 00:18:32,260

That was not, it was not that.

234

00:18:32,260 --> 00:18:32,820

And I've been.

235

00:18:33,700 --> 00:18:34,500

This is the thing you say.

236

00:18:34,500 --> 00:18:40,420

I mean, what was going through your mind on that journey from your newspaper desk to Fort Worth?

237

00:18:40,900 --> 00:18:41,220

I don't have.

238

00:18:41,860 --> 00:18:46,260

Did you have any kind of idea as to what you might expect?

239

00:18:46,900 --> 00:18:48,500

Were you going to be taken to a hangar?

240

00:18:48,500 --> 00:18:49,860

Were you going to meet anybody?

241

00:18:49,860 --> 00:18:51,300

Were you going to see anything?

242

00:18:51,300 --> 00:18:52,580

What was going through your mind?

243

00:18:53,220 --> 00:18:56,900

I had been involved in some airplane crashes before.

244

00:18:57,460 --> 00:19:02,340

And in every case, in the past, they had reassembled these in hangars.

245

00:19:02,340 --> 00:19:04,740

That was kind of the MO as it is today.

246

00:19:04,740 --> 00:19:12,500

That's what you, with the Pan Am crash and so forth, they always seemed to find an empty

247

00:19:12,500 --> 00:19:15,700

hangar somewhere and reconstruct it to try to find out what happened.

248

00:19:16,420 --> 00:19:19,220

That was what I would have expected.

249

00:19:19,220 --> 00:19:22,980

And I still remember, I remember only a few incidents.

250

00:19:22,980 --> 00:19:27,380

You know, our memory, I think, could be described as being in soundbites.

251

00:19:28,340 --> 00:19:32,580

That is what we just remember, little snippets of, of thing.

252

00:19:32,580 --> 00:19:36,420

And, but there are the few snippets that I have of that day.

253

00:19:36,420 --> 00:19:38,340

So you arrive at the base.

254

00:19:39,860 --> 00:19:46,420

Are you not then surprised to be taken instead of a hangar or an area where, like you say,

255

00:19:46,420 --> 00:19:50,660

you might expect to see something that has been assembled from the wreckage and the like,

256

00:19:50,660 --> 00:19:53,780

but instead to a carpeted office?

257

00:19:53,780 --> 00:19:54,580

That's correct.

258

00:19:54,580 --> 00:19:56,180

That did not make sense.

259

00:19:56,180 --> 00:19:58,660

Why would, and it doesn't to this moment.

260

00:19:59,700 --> 00:20:02,820

You've literally entered this room, you've seen the carpet.

261

00:20:03,700 --> 00:20:06,980

What was it about that room that you looked at?

262

00:20:06,980 --> 00:20:08,100

What, what happened next?

263

00:20:08,100 --> 00:20:15,700

I remember my consternation, the fact that there was this junk piled on the floor,

264

00:20:16,340 --> 00:20:19,700

not very photographic or photogenic at all.

265

00:20:20,420 --> 00:20:25,780

And now I've got to, you know, this is one of my really, I guess, first assignments.

266

00:20:25,780 --> 00:20:28,340

I had only had the camera for a month or two.

267

00:20:29,140 --> 00:20:35,460

And so this was really one of the first times that I had been assigned to do that.

268

00:20:35,460 --> 00:20:40,660

Otherwise, I had gone like covering a speaking engagement or something,

something that's not too easy to mistake as an aircraft or a helicopter or a landing light or a bird or a balloon.

And again, both route.

Brian has filmed some remarkable objects, as we saw in Hard Evidence 3.

a term that Hammy Massan's captured and clung to for describing the sightings over Mexico City.

And just to finish off, this one, well, maybe we can't call it a sphere as such,

496

but just watch this. This is stock footage of a B2,

497

And look, look what happens behind it.

We see one of these glowing particles, whether it's a sphere or not,

even though it's only a brief clip.

We have got to find out exactly where this footage was filmed

and who took it.

But watch again.

There we have B2, the America's most expensive aeroplane,

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00:37:09,460 --> 00:37:13,140

one of the most expensive flying machines ever built.

And clear as day, it's being followed by an unidentified flying object.
