You know, when they talk about Galileo, he'd have his telescope,

I know what I saw. There's no skeptic in the world.

They can say what they want, set them out of death, but they won't hear.

When I interviewed Chris, he described lights in the sky at three different locations.

As you get into the UFO investigations, you'll find people always are describing things they can't find words for.

So I'm working more like a police sketch artist.

We want to make this look as close to the actual event.

This is the location along the Cape Fear River where five guys got together one night to do a little evening fishing.

We were all fishing right in this very spot.

Chris leaves his friends. He walks up to this spot on the road, and this is where he has his first encounter.

Looking this way, you see the trees in front. See where it drops off, that little hut down there?

Yeah. That's where I was standing.

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00:02:53,000 --> 00:03:00,000

And there's these two orange balls, huge, and they were motionless, sitting side by side.

Okay, so this is about the size that would have been over that tree right there.

But what alerted me, a third one came in the blink of an eye.

Chris appears to be a pretty respected member of the community. He's a commercial pilot. He was a very successful builder.

He had a good business. He's got a great family, raised four children, and for all intents and purposes seems to be a pretty stand-up guy.

What do you think the attitude was when they came down? You said when they came down and then slowed down.

I'd say five, six hundred feet when they slowed down, but they were coming down at a speed unbelievable.

It looked like a star from a million miles away, and then it just boom, didn't stop, but it looked

like a cushion of something called it.

And then they come down about this speed, just gently.

I have to say that Chris Sr. just came across so well in his demeanor and his body language and just his very simple talk.

And I just got the sense that there was an element of truth here.

And was that the end of it?

It was the end until I got home. And then it started again at the house.

That's when my dogs went nuts, and I ran out to see what was bothering them.

My chest peak runs right to about right here and stops.

And her hair is standing up from the back of her head to her rear end.

I look back this way and right there. It was just standing there.

Right on that little rise, but if I reached my hand out and leaned over, I could touch it.

And it would have been about, yes sir, right there.

No more than three or four feet away.

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00:07:11,000 --> 00:07:17,000

That's the max. And he was no higher than, say, this high up on your arm.

It didn't move. It didn't blink. It had red eyes, but it was glowing.

I mean, look at the chill bumps. See that? You can't fake that, guys.

As far as looking at it, it was just stoic. It was glowing, but there was no nose twitching, no muscle movement.

Just like a statue would be looking at.

For a second I was frightened and I stood here and I said, okay, I'm a big guy.

If you want me, you got me. You got me cornered. I have nowhere to go.

This was an important part of this investigation for us because I think most people are going to look at what his reaction was

I want to move in a bed.

I was frozen and I was looking at it and it was looking at me and I was thinking real fast.

And, you know, I felt at peace at that moment.

Where's the dog at at this point?

It was coming straight to it. It came right through here.

When it got to right in there, the whole thing disappeared.

Chris, thank you.

Thank you.

You mind if we just take a minute to discuss and evaluate?

What do you think, man?

I don't know.

Unscribable.

Incredible.

We get a lot of stories. We get a lot of cases that involve entities, humanoids.

But I've never seen a case before where the entity was just four feet away from you.

That's, to me, that's pretty amazing.

I didn't notice any arm movement. I mean, it's basically this deal, looking right at him.

We bought a creature standing there that just vanished and then one second was there, the next second was gone.

As far as his description, it's staying consistent with his original submission that he made to move on.

I'm still processing. I don't know what to think right now.

If he was hoaxing this, if he was trying to scam it, why wouldn't he just use the description everybody else uses?

This is a very interesting case, but at the same time it's a very tough one because there's no physical evidence

and we have to rely on strictly witness testimony.

So far, we've only been able to interview Chris, but there were four other people involved

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00:09:58,000 --> 00:10:01,000

and I'd really like to see what they have to say about this.

As far as I know, we're getting invaded by UFOs.

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00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:10,000

I remember being one on the right, one in the middle, and one toward the left.

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00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:13,000

I'm thinking, boy, this is really sizing up to be a whopper.

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00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:17,000

Like an invasion, you know what I'm saying? That's what we were thinking in our mind.

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00:10:40,000 --> 00:10:56,000

Chris Bledsoe alleged that he had three separate UFO sightings and also had an alien encounter, but

he was not the only witness that night.

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00:10:57,000 --> 00:11:01,000

Okay, just try to remember back and tell me about what happened that night.

It was really dark out and I happened to be looking down that way and I saw these two orbs, you know, about this big, about waist high off the ground, just floating.

So all I could see was these two bright red orbs side by side.

Where were they when you first saw them?

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00:11:19,000 --> 00:11:21,000

Down the path there, coming down the road.

And so they were coming down that road and coming this way or what?

Yeah, really slowly.

So you saw the orbs go into that area?

Going to the woods on the left side in front of the near the river.

And then next thing you know, I didn't see any more orbs.

I just saw these little creatures come walking out the woods.

We interviewed Chris Jr. to see if he could corroborate any of his father's story.

But it turns out he wasn't at the riverbank.

He was actually at the riverbank having his own encounter.

You don't have to go all the way in there, but just kind of indicate where you were back here.

Try to describe him a little bit.

It was really dark.

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00:11:57,000 --> 00:12:00,000

Just like little creatures, little skin.

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00:12:00,000 --> 00:12:08,000

I could see that, you know, they're, I guess they're body, but not like what they were wearing.

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00:12:09,000 --> 00:12:11,000

Junior was a little bit different.

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00:12:11,000 --> 00:12:14,000

There could be one word I could use to describe Chris Jr.

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00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:18,000

That would be this overwhelming sense of angst.

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00:12:18,000 --> 00:12:24,000

He seemed to be having some troubles, a lot of internal battles.

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00:12:25,000 --> 00:12:26,000

Was the moon up?

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00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:27,000

Was there?

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00:12:27,000 --> 00:12:29,000

Yeah, there was a moon, plenty of stars.

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00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:35,000

We weren't sure whether this really happened to him or he was making some of this up to try to corroborate his dad's story.

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00:12:36,000 --> 00:12:42,000

So we think it's really important for us to bring in these other three witnesses who were there and find out what they saw.

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00:12:43,000 --> 00:12:44,000

Well then Chris comes up.

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00:12:44,000 --> 00:12:50,000

It was a bit of a challenge, but we were able to track down the other three men and videotape what they had to say about the event.

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00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:57,000

You could see what looked like bright stars, you know, that was scattered one, you know, across the tree line.

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00:12:57,000 --> 00:13:01,000

And I could just, you could just see him descend slowly.

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00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:04,000

And it just like, dropping.

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00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:08,000

Like I said, you know, it looked like a piece of hot steel or something, you know.

They were oranges, and then you could see separate other colors.

It was orange and maybe yellow.

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00:13:16,000 --> 00:13:20,000

I remember being one on the left, right, one in the middle and one toward the left.

From that tree to this tree, they were right there. You could see them just perfect right there.

I saw, I saw, we spent every five or ten minutes looking at them.

Right.

And the flare goes straight up there, right, right.

Right.

As I'm hearing these guys tell me their story, although there's some minor discrepancies here,

basically everybody's pretty much telling us the same thing.

And they're pretty much corroborating each other's stories.

They want no sound. I mean, it was dead, dead steel that night.

No sound whatsoever.

Did you hear any other noise, normal noises, birds, animals?

It was quiet. It was quiet.

It was just, you could have heard a rat piss on a piece of cotton.

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00:14:21,000 --> 00:14:23,000

That's how quiet it was.

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00:14:23,000 --> 00:14:29,000

One of the big discrepancies was the description of the large light that they saw at the top of the hill.

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00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:32,000

Three of them saw this big ball of light.

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00:14:32,000 --> 00:14:40,000

When we come out of here before we left, there was a light right on, there was a big light right there in that field there.

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00:14:40,000 --> 00:14:44,000

But Chris Senior had this very vivid description of what the craft looked like.

And so we're not sure what to make of that.

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00:14:46,000 --> 00:14:52,000

Somewhere between there and the highway was the spike object that I described.

It was just another big low-end light.

It was like a...

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00:14:56,000 --> 00:14:59,000

But then, you know, like I said, it just kind of just...

Hold your hand up like that. Kind of try to remember it.

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00:15:01,000 --> 00:15:06,000

Well, from a distance, I can put my hand around it like that, maybe.

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00:15:06,000 --> 00:15:12,000

If you look at the tree in the pole, it would have been the nose up, it would have been at the pole,

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00:15:12,000 --> 00:15:15,000

and the rear end of it would have been past the tree.

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00:15:15,000 --> 00:15:17,000

See the horse stand in there?

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00:15:17,000 --> 00:15:21,000

That would have been about the back of it, or a little further behind him.

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00:15:21,000 --> 00:15:24,000

And the front of it would have been along this pole over here.

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00:15:24,000 --> 00:15:26,000

It was good 40 feet.

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00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:35,000

The other major discrepancy we saw in the stories was this whole issue of missing time where Chris Senior thought he was gone for a maximum of 23 minutes from the river bank.

But his companions said he had been gone for hours, and in fact, they went to go look for him.

Okay, Chris, now you said it took you 20 minutes to get up here and back down again.

Okay, now why did the other guys think it took longer than that?

I had it been gone a long time.

I remember that night that somebody had been looking for him in the truck, the truck was parked right there.

When it got dark, you know, we kind of started wondering where Chris and God took him.

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00:16:04,000 --> 00:16:06,000

It was just me and Gene down there.

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00:16:06,000 --> 00:16:10,000

Donnie went up the hill to get Chris, so he didn't have to walk back or whatever, went around there.

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00:16:10,000 --> 00:16:12,000

Hey, hey, where you at?

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00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:17,000

All of them said they drove up to the road at the end and drove back.

And I know they left because they said they did and the truck was moved.

At some point, those guys said that they came up the road and went up there, turned around, and went back.

You're standing here the whole time.

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00:16:31,000 --> 00:16:34,000

How could they get past you without you seeing them and them not seeing you?

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00:16:34,000 --> 00:16:35,000

There's no way.

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00:16:35,000 --> 00:16:38,000

Did anybody tell you how much time had passed?

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00:16:38,000 --> 00:16:40,000

Three or four hours.

They thought you were gone for three or four hours?

220

00:16:42,000 --> 00:16:43,000

Yes, sir.

In a case like this where there's time missing, he tells me he can't remember.

He tries to remember, he thinks about it, he gets these severe smashing headaches, and he can't remember what happened up there.

So at the time, you didn't think it was strange that when you got here, it was just getting dark, and when you got back, it was very dark.

That didn't strike you as strange or odd?

225

I have a missing spot in my brain, and I've told Richard this time and again.

226

I have a wall.

I want to know what happened there.

228

00:17:15,000 --> 00:17:17,000

I'm lost for time at that point.

229

00:17:17,000 --> 00:17:18,000

I feel for him.

230

00:17:18,000 --> 00:17:22,000

I feel sorry for him because I can see that he's really struggling with something.

231

00:17:22,000 --> 00:17:27,000

But I know that's something that we probably could explore with some psychological help.

232

Now that we've finished interviewing the other witnesses, and we've pretty much gone as far as we can with them, we want to go back and focus on Chris Bledsoe, because that's where we think we're going to find our answers.

In cases like this where there's potential for having close encounters, what we've found is that use of regression hypnosis can sometimes help us to uncover missing memories.

Chris Sr. just seems to be really well known within that community.

He's a prominent businessman.

241

Makes him a credible witness.

242

00:18:28,000 --> 00:18:37,000

We're not sure if what happened to Chris Bledsoe is real or fantasy, but we're hoping that regression hypnosis will provide that answer.

243

You do the regression hypnosis.

244

00:18:39,000 --> 00:18:42,000

You basically put the client in a state of unconsciousness.

245

Sometimes that referred to it is put it in a trance.

And the psychologist can basically talk to the individual and take the information off their subconscious mind.

You're in control here.

All I'll be doing is just helping you to get focused.

Dr. Michael Connell is a Harvard train psychologist.

250

He's got 15 years experience and he's probably done a regression hypnosis on somewhere around 250 individuals and we are very lucky to have him.

Yes.

252

00:19:16,000 --> 00:19:18,000

You're okay.

00:19:18,000 --> 00:19:21,000

You're okay.

The regression hypnosis took place on July 14, 2008 and we videotaped it.

The MMPI basically said that he is vulnerable and being vulnerable he could have a certain level of psychotic or disturbed thinking.
