The mutual UFO network, or MUFON, watches the skies, investigating sightings, soon after

they occur.

Their investigators use the tools of science, psychology, and law enforcement to get as

14

close to the truth as the truth will allow.

15

Unidentified flying objects definitely exist.

16

Only their identity remains a mystery.

17

The mystery of UFOs over Earth.

18

I'm excited.

19

00:01:34,440 --> 00:01:38,400

I'm excited that they're coming, excited they're at my back door.

20

I am waiting to see what the culmination of all this is.

21

To me is something that is at the forefront of a breakthrough.

22

When they're talking about a flap, essentially what you have is the occurrence of a number

of sightings in a fairly short period of time in a given geographic location.

Most UFO sightings occur with an individual.

They happen, then they're gone.

Once in a while you get a mass sighting.

In 1997 we had the lights over Phoenix.

28

We're seen by 10,000 people.

29

It was seen by the governor of Arizona.

30

00:02:19,680 --> 00:02:24,120

The flaps are rare because they can last for days and sometimes months.

31

And then one day just as quick as it starts it stops again and nobody knows why.

32

So you want to take advantage of it.

33

You want to look into it as quickly as possible.

34

This is the largest UFO wave we've had in Pennsylvania in 35 years.

We normally get 8 to 10 sightings a month.

36

We get 63 reports in July.

37

There were 25 more in August, 32 more in September.

Why all of a sudden is Pennsylvania seeing all of this?

39

Something is going on.

40

00:03:01,360 --> 00:03:04,960

Even though there are different days and different times, we've seen a description of some very

41

common objects.

42

00:03:05,960 --> 00:03:18,520

The activity that we're looking at right now is about seven times more than the usual.

43

We put together all our information so that we have a map of all the sightings.

A lot of people have reported different objects and it's interesting to note that these objects

45

vary from a cylinder shaped object to a boomerang to a sphere.

What was was a white ball of light.

47

00:03:38,720 --> 00:03:42,880

So I ran inside and I grabbed my mistrong of binoculars and I honed right in when that

48

son of a gun and there was no structural features at all.

49

00:03:47,280 --> 00:03:50,680

It was just a white, pure ball of light.

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00:03:50,680 --> 00:03:54,400

I've only been investigating for MOFON four months now.

51

00:03:54,400 --> 00:03:59,680

I'm out here to figure out what the hell is going on out there.

52

00:03:59,680 --> 00:04:02,000

It was ball shaped kind of.

53

00:04:02,000 --> 00:04:04,080

Just like multi-colored.

54

00:04:04,080 --> 00:04:05,080

Yeah.

55

00:04:05,080 --> 00:04:07,880

It was bright as like dominant colors were blue and orange.

56

00:04:07,880 --> 00:04:13,560

I was sitting out on my porch and I just happened to look over and there came a beautiful blue

57

sphere.

58

00:04:14,560 --> 00:04:17,080

It was a beautiful blue that I'll never forget the color.

59

Like a blue basketball that made me light inside of it to show the blue.

You know what I'm saying?

61

Take a boomerang and put a football in the middle and they had red lights in the front.

When you look at these objects that are being reported, they are giving different descriptions

63

to it.

64

00:04:33,160 --> 00:04:36,560

But you've got this large group of people that tell a very compelling story and they're

65

very believable.

66

00:04:37,560 --> 00:04:41,920

What would you say if I told you that four other people that night had a sighting that

67

00:04:41,920 --> 00:04:42,920

they reported?

68

00:04:42,920 --> 00:04:45,920

I'm not crazy.

69

00:04:45,920 --> 00:04:52,120

80% maybe 90% of these sightings are actually IFOs.

70

00:04:52,120 --> 00:04:57,840

But there's always that unexpected 10 to 5% that remain unexplained and that's what I'm

71

00:04:57,840 --> 00:04:59,440

after.

72

00:04:59,440 --> 00:05:02,840

The first thing I do is to ask what would be the motive?

73

00:05:02,840 --> 00:05:09,760

What would be their reason for coming forward and actually seeing I'm seeing these things?

74

I realized it was a solid object.

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00:05:12,240 --> 00:05:13,560

It wasn't shaped like a plane.

76

00:05:13,560 --> 00:05:16,560

I've never seen anything like a plane that looked like that.

77

00:05:16,560 --> 00:05:17,560

It didn't make any noise.

78

00:05:17,560 --> 00:05:19,560

It moved very slow.

79

00:05:19,560 --> 00:05:22,440

If that was a plane, it would have fell right out of the sky.

As Cliff is telling his story, I'm thinking here's an average person, a retired person

81

who wakes up in the middle of the night and sees something he doesn't understand.

82

00:05:38,360 --> 00:05:42,840

I think the fact that we have over 50 witnesses, they don't know each other.

83

00:05:42,840 --> 00:05:44,080

They don't know of each other.

84

00:05:44,080 --> 00:05:46,600

I think that says something about this investigation.

85

00:05:46,600 --> 00:05:51,640

That something real happened, that these people saw something that they can't explain that

86

00:05:51,640 --> 00:05:53,800

looked unnatural to them.

87

00:05:53,800 --> 00:06:00,200

I happen to see four objects coming round, lit balls.

88

00:06:00,200 --> 00:06:05,640

We're looking up and they're out there and two of them are stationary.

89

00:06:05,640 --> 00:06:07,280

Now that they make that type of a sound?

90

00:06:07,280 --> 00:06:11,720

That's the usual A-10 warthog flying by.

91

00:06:11,720 --> 00:06:15,320

They usually don't fly over a house like that.

92

00:06:15,320 --> 00:06:18,680

But the sound from the UFOs, they sound like those?

93

00:06:18,680 --> 00:06:20,920

There was no sound whatsoever from these sites.

94

00:06:20,920 --> 00:06:21,920

That's unusual.

95

00:06:21,920 --> 00:06:23,800

How did you feel at that point?

96

00:06:23,800 --> 00:06:24,800

Were you afraid?

97

00:06:24,800 --> 00:06:30,400

I was a little bit uneasy because they were absolutely silent.

98

00:06:30,400 --> 00:06:34,520

That was what struck me was there was no sound, whatever.

99

00:06:34,520 --> 00:06:38,480

When she gives her description of those four objects just like her husband, I mean it was

100

00:06:38,480 --> 00:06:41,520

a very believable, compelling description.

101

00:06:41,520 --> 00:06:46,520

To speak to them, you're convinced that these people saw what they saw.

102

00:06:46,520 --> 00:06:49,600

We live within five minutes of the air base.

103

00:06:49,600 --> 00:06:56,800

So I've come to be able to identify all kinds of military aircraft at 14s, at 18s, A-10

104

00:06:56,800 --> 00:06:59,000

warthogs, you know, the whole bit.

105

00:06:59,000 --> 00:07:05,240

And I immediately knew this was nothing that I could identify as either a commercial aircraft

106

00:07:05,240 --> 00:07:06,680

or a military aircraft.

107

00:07:06,680 --> 00:07:09,480

It was something, you know, totally different.

108

00:07:09,480 --> 00:07:11,200

Could this be ours?

109

00:07:11,200 --> 00:07:13,520

Not unless we have some kind of blue ball ships.

110

00:07:13,520 --> 00:07:16,120

You know, I'm seeing a bigger story here.

111

00:07:16,120 --> 00:07:21,040

Plus there's people, people with good backgrounds, they're all coming forward.

112

00:07:21,040 --> 00:07:23,040

But people don't have evidence.

113

00:07:23,040 --> 00:07:29,560

Did you at any point want to take your eyes away and go get a camera?

114

00:07:29,560 --> 00:07:34,280

I never, you know, the thought never occurred to me because I was fixated.

115

00:07:34,280 --> 00:07:42,160

I was just mesmerized, fixated, and I just couldn't take my eyes away.

116

00:07:42,160 --> 00:07:46,000

You know, one of the things that I wish would happen is that someone else would see it and

117

00:07:46,000 --> 00:07:49,880

maybe get it on film.

118

00:07:49,880 --> 00:08:00,400

I thought it was a helicopter, but it wasn't making any noise and it didn't have like one

119

00:08:00,400 --> 00:08:01,400

light.

120

00:08:01,400 --> 00:08:04,800

It had three lights and they were on the surface of the object.

121

00:08:04,800 --> 00:08:08,120

It was kind of freaky, kind of like a boomerang.

122

00:08:08,120 --> 00:08:09,120

Okay.

123

00:08:09,120 --> 00:08:11,040

Now, that was in April.

124

00:08:11,040 --> 00:08:13,800

I'm currently working on 60 cases right now.

125

00:08:14,400 --> 00:08:19,120

Part of what makes Denise's sighting the most special out of them all is that she's

126

00:08:19,120 --> 00:08:24,960

had multiple sightings and a written report with the specific dates in the time frame.

127

00:08:24,960 --> 00:08:27,120

And May, same thing.

128

00:08:27,120 --> 00:08:28,800

The dog woke me up and we came out.

129

00:08:28,800 --> 00:08:33,520

And as soon as I came out the back door, it was above this tree right here directly.

130

00:08:33,520 --> 00:08:39,080

Then the next time, I guess it was in June and it was the same exact spot again.

131

00:08:39,080 --> 00:08:42,000

It seems like it's in these two spots every time I come out.

132

00:08:42,000 --> 00:08:46,000

Now I did see on your report, you said there was a cone of light that came from it.

133

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:47,000

Yes, yes.

134

00:08:47,000 --> 00:08:53,200

I saw this glitter coming down from the object into this tree and also this tree.

135

00:08:53,200 --> 00:08:54,200

It was like glitter.

136

00:08:54,200 --> 00:08:55,840

I thought, oh, this is really weird.

137

00:08:55,840 --> 00:08:58,480

I'm not telling anybody about this, you know.

138

00:08:58,480 --> 00:09:03,160

And next thing I know, I saw the glitter leave both trees and go up to the crayon.

139

00:09:03,160 --> 00:09:08,320

She's telling us this situation of these metallic sprinkles that came down and landed in her

140

00:09:08,320 --> 00:09:09,320

backyard.

141

00:09:09,320 --> 00:09:12,120

I found it a little hard to believe.

142

00:09:12,120 --> 00:09:15,680

Then as we researched and got into it a little bit more, we find out that there was a case,

143

00:09:15,680 --> 00:09:19,120

I believe, in 1999 in Mexico, same exact thing.

144

00:09:19,120 --> 00:09:20,120

It was just silver.

145

00:09:20,120 --> 00:09:22,120

It was sparkly and this tree was full.

146

00:09:22,120 --> 00:09:25,120

Silver looked like Christmas light.

147

00:09:25,120 --> 00:09:31,160

A little bit here on the outer leaves.

148

00:09:31,160 --> 00:09:35,160

I have a Porta Poguiga counter.

149

00:09:35,160 --> 00:09:39,760

So I said, let me see if we get any trace elements off of this.

150

00:09:39,760 --> 00:09:44,760

As I put it on the branches in towards the center of the tree, you didn't get any readings.

151

00:09:44,760 --> 00:09:50,120

But then as you got outside to the perimeter of it on the top of the leaves, it was clicking,

152

00:09:50,120 --> 00:09:51,120

it was going off.

153

00:09:51,120 --> 00:09:55,720

I'm like, wow, this is something solid that we can work with.

154

00:09:55,720 --> 00:09:57,880

Each case, you take through a process.

155

00:09:57,880 --> 00:09:59,840

You go through the whole investigative process.

156

00:09:59,840 --> 00:10:01,640

You gather up soil samples.

157

00:10:01,640 --> 00:10:04,400

You gather up vegetation samples.

158

00:10:04,400 --> 00:10:08,120

And then put all the pieces of the puzzle together to see what happened.

159

00:10:08,120 --> 00:10:11,320

Log the case number and the date of location.

160

00:10:11,320 --> 00:10:14,000

And we'll send it off to be analyzed.

161

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:23,320

And we'll see anything that's out of this world.

162

00:10:23,320 --> 00:10:24,600

That brought it to a different level.

163

00:10:24,600 --> 00:10:27,600

That brought it to a different level of expertise.

164

00:10:27,600 --> 00:10:30,360

Then we find out that Denise has photos.

165

00:10:30,360 --> 00:10:31,360

She's got pictures.

166

00:10:31,360 --> 00:10:41,760

Denise's case became very important to us.

167

00:10:41,760 --> 00:10:44,520

It was beautiful looking.

168

00:10:44,520 --> 00:10:46,280

This thing had no lights.

169

00:10:46,280 --> 00:10:51,640

Seemed like it wanted to be unseen.

170

00:10:51,640 --> 00:10:56,600

An estimated 10,000 UFO sightings are reported each year.

171

00:10:56,600 --> 00:11:03,360

MUFON, the Mutual UFO Network, chronicles these sightings, but only investigates those

172

00:11:03,360 --> 00:11:05,680

they consider credible.

173

00:11:05,680 --> 00:11:08,880

The following is an account of one such investigation.

174

00:11:08,880 --> 00:11:18,960

Just happened to look over and there came a beautiful blue sphere.

175

00:11:18,960 --> 00:11:24,680

We were about like right here and it was flying that way.

176

00:11:24,680 --> 00:11:26,400

We didn't have like one light.

177

00:11:26,400 --> 00:11:32,320

It had three lights and they were on the surface.

178

00:11:32,320 --> 00:11:36,400

Denise's investigation is really what you hope for because there's a lot of evidence

179

00:11:36,400 --> 00:11:38,960

coming together here that says something really happened here.

180

00:11:38,960 --> 00:11:39,960

Hi Denise.

181

00:11:39,960 --> 00:11:40,960

Hi how are you?

182

00:11:40,960 --> 00:11:41,960

Good.

183

00:11:41,960 --> 00:11:42,960

This is Tim.

184

00:11:42,960 --> 00:11:43,960

Hi nice to meet you.

185

00:11:43,960 --> 00:11:44,960

Hi Denise.

186

00:11:44,960 --> 00:11:45,960

Nice to meet you.

187

00:11:45,960 --> 00:11:46,960

Nice to meet you.

188

00:11:46,960 --> 00:11:47,960

Nice to meet you.

189

00:11:47,960 --> 00:11:48,960

Nice to meet you.

190

00:11:48,960 --> 00:11:49,960

I'm going to work on creating some artwork.

191

00:11:49,960 --> 00:11:54,560

We'll work together and I'll make it look as accurate as we can to what it is that we've

192

00:11:54,560 --> 00:11:55,560

seen.

193

00:11:55,560 --> 00:12:00,280

It was just something like you weren't sure what it was but it was beautiful looking.

194

00:12:00,280 --> 00:12:03,280

Like triangular or boomerang shape.

195

00:12:03,280 --> 00:12:05,280

Yeah kind of like a boomerang shape.

196

00:12:05,280 --> 00:12:09,960

Take a boomerang and put a football in the middle and it had red lights in the front.

197

00:12:09,960 --> 00:12:13,440

Goldy red lights that were kind of pulsating.

198

00:12:13,440 --> 00:12:16,480

You mentioned this before a pinkish light.

199

00:12:16,480 --> 00:12:17,480

Right.

200

00:12:17,480 --> 00:12:23,320

Say like if I see this in the sky, there'd be a pink light flickering.

201

00:12:23,320 --> 00:12:27,840

This time I saw it above this house over here at the rooftop.

202

00:12:27,840 --> 00:12:31,240

On one of the evenings I think you said that it dropped some kind of substance that came

203

00:12:31,240 --> 00:12:32,240

down or.

204

00:12:32,240 --> 00:12:38,640

It was all glitter and then it went into this tree.

205

00:12:38,640 --> 00:12:44,320

So now the goal is to be able to build a craft, put it where she saw it and recreate her

206

00:12:44,320 --> 00:12:52,160

sighting in the actual spot where it took place.

207

00:12:52,160 --> 00:12:55,840

When it comes to photographs, they want to find that wow image, the one that's going

208

00:12:55,840 --> 00:12:59,400

to really say look we've got them, they're here.

209

00:12:59,400 --> 00:13:00,900

So this was in May.

210

00:13:00,900 --> 00:13:02,920

What did you see with your eye?

211

00:13:02,920 --> 00:13:07,200

It looked like three giant headlights of a car.

212

00:13:07,200 --> 00:13:08,200

Three headlights.

213

00:13:08,200 --> 00:13:11,200

It's giant three headlights, that's what I usually see first.

214

00:13:11,200 --> 00:13:13,720

In any kind of pattern configuration of any kind?

215

00:13:13,720 --> 00:13:15,220

No, not really.

216

00:13:15,220 --> 00:13:19,440

It was just the round object, the round part of it.

217

00:13:19,440 --> 00:13:24,280

It's like three giant headlights, just looks like a flat surface of an object with the

218

00:13:24,280 --> 00:13:28,800

lights.

219

00:13:28,800 --> 00:13:33,320

As I'm looking at her pictures, the part I didn't understand was how you could look

220

00:13:33,320 --> 00:13:38,560

at a triangle that's got three different colored lights on it and you show me a picture of

221

00:13:38,560 --> 00:13:43,480

something that looks like a golf ball.

222

00:13:43,480 --> 00:13:47,160

So in this first one, this was 420 2008.

223

00:13:47,160 --> 00:13:48,160

Where did you take that picture?

224

00:13:48,200 --> 00:13:51,720

If you could just take your camera off right over there and go check it out.

225

00:13:51,720 --> 00:13:55,400

I asked Denise to recreate the manner in which she took the pictures.

226

00:13:55,400 --> 00:13:57,800

I wanted her to use the same camera.

227

00:13:57,800 --> 00:14:03,840

I were taught this tree, so I just aimed it at it.

228

00:14:03,840 --> 00:14:07,080

Mark said she held the camera at arm's length.

229

00:14:07,080 --> 00:14:12,120

I think what she was doing was pointing it in the direction of what she saw snapping,

230

00:14:12,120 --> 00:14:15,480

almost like if you're at an event and you're snapping over the crowd, you think you're

231

00:14:15,480 --> 00:14:18,520

getting what's going on, but you don't really know.

232

00:14:18,520 --> 00:14:22,880

And I think that she may have thought she photo what she was looking at and was off

233

00:14:22,880 --> 00:14:25,480

and it might not even be in the frame.

234

00:14:25,480 --> 00:14:29,640

I spent a good deal of time last night going over all the images.

235

00:14:29,640 --> 00:14:34,760

In this image that was submitted, I noticed this clearly over here there's this bright

236

00:14:34,760 --> 00:14:37,320

blue ball.

237

00:14:37,320 --> 00:14:39,680

And that's interesting looking in and of itself.

238

00:14:39,680 --> 00:14:43,800

So to look more closely at that, I zoomed way in, brightened the image and I looked

239

00:14:43,800 --> 00:14:45,400

at that object.

240

00:14:45,400 --> 00:14:49,440

What I saw inside the object were arcs.

241

00:14:49,440 --> 00:14:54,200

So one thing you can notice is if you complete these arcs, there's a bright object just off

242

00:14:54,200 --> 00:14:56,600

frame right about here.

243

00:14:56,600 --> 00:14:57,920

Maybe that's what she meant.

244

00:14:57,920 --> 00:14:59,920

Maybe that's our object.

245

00:14:59,920 --> 00:15:02,920

Maybe that's the coolest thing in the world, but it's here.

246

00:15:02,920 --> 00:15:03,920

It's not there.

247

00:15:03,920 --> 00:15:07,360

That could be the object that she meant for us to see and it might have been a very interesting

248

00:15:07,360 --> 00:15:10,480

object, but she didn't catch it.

249

00:15:10,480 --> 00:15:17,840

I believe that this person took something that was genuinely intriguing and interesting,

250

00:15:17,840 --> 00:15:22,680

but so far, and I have more analysis to do, there's quite a few pictures.

251

00:15:22,680 --> 00:15:36,920

So far I don't see anything that's not explainable so far.

252

00:15:36,920 --> 00:15:40,200

Can you show us where your second siding took place?

253

00:15:40,200 --> 00:15:43,800

Yeah, it was outside if you want to go out there.

254

00:15:43,800 --> 00:15:51,440

It was right between those two pine trees and then I realized it was a solid object.

255

00:15:51,440 --> 00:15:56,120

I think one of the most compelling witnesses so far has been Cliff.

256

00:15:56,120 --> 00:16:00,760

I mean, there is no reason for a retiree who's had a good life and a good business to come

257

00:16:00,760 --> 00:16:01,760

up with this story.

258

00:16:01,760 --> 00:16:03,760

This is about where it happened.

259

00:16:03,760 --> 00:16:07,640

We came out here, of course, it was dark, it was like four o'clock or so and it was

260

00:16:07,640 --> 00:16:08,640

still very dark.

261

00:16:08,640 --> 00:16:09,640

Okay.

262

00:16:09,640 --> 00:16:13,480

And about the time we got back out here, it was probably right around there and there

263

00:16:13,480 --> 00:16:15,160

was a lightning flash.

264

00:16:15,160 --> 00:16:20,920

And when that flashed, I saw the whole object and it wasn't what I expected because when

265

00:16:20,920 --> 00:16:26,280

I saw it before, it looked like it, just a hexagon, dark solid object, I guess you'd

266

00:16:26,280 --> 00:16:27,280

call it.

267

00:16:27,280 --> 00:16:32,880

This time the lightning shown through cracks in the object and it kind of divided it up

268

00:16:32,880 --> 00:16:37,240

into almost six equal triangular shaped things.

269

00:16:37,240 --> 00:16:41,640

He saw the craft and he saw the light coming through the seams so he knew there were six

270

00:16:41,640 --> 00:16:44,600

different objects connected.

271

00:16:44,600 --> 00:16:47,120

His description was as good as it gets.

272

00:16:47,120 --> 00:16:49,480

How big would you say it was?

273

00:16:49,480 --> 00:16:56,000

It was at least from where we are to the tree line width wise and probably maybe even longer

274

00:16:56,000 --> 00:16:59,360

than that because it seems to be elongated.

275

00:16:59,360 --> 00:17:05,600

He calculated this thing to be in excess of 300 feet so this is an enormous craft.

279

and I was a little setback.

280

Do you have any concerns that this is the second time you've seen it over your property?

281

Yeah, I just want to get on with my life.

282

Yeah, I don't want to see anymore.

283

00:17:31,080 --> 00:17:34,000

He's a little afraid and I think he's a little concerned.

284

I said why does he keep coming around his neighborhood?

285

Why is he the one that's seeing it?

286

00:17:39,880 --> 00:17:44,600

Cliff and Denise, they've seen something more than once and that becomes exciting for us

287

00:17:44,600 --> 00:17:47,320

because it wasn't a one time deal.

288

Now would you take your eyes off of something like that?

289

I wasn't moving.

290

I didn't really believe the story of the metallic sprinkles coming down but that's the part

of the case that's actually come to fruition.

It got right near my house when it briefly turned red and then bang was going to vanish.

293

It was going very fast so it had like okay, it said that motion over here.

This is such a good case.

We've got so many witnesses, we've got physical evidence so I called James Cary on the International

Director to enact our STAR team just because I wanted to make sure that I covered all the

bases.

The STAR team is made up of a group of elite new fund investigators who can be deployed

00:18:44,080 --> 00:18:46,400

at a moment's notice wherever there's a major UFO event.

300

Yeah, listen that's a video that I told you about.

301

00:18:48,440 --> 00:18:50,840

This is a really incredible case.

302

00:18:50,840 --> 00:18:54,360

There's a number of sightings and any of these cases that are associated with any kind of

303

physical evidence, we're going to focus on those first.

304

We're not here to take over the investigation, we're here to help them and provide technical

305

00:19:01,160 --> 00:19:03,200

support and experience.

When you have members of the STAR team coming down, that in itself is an indication that

307

we've got something here that's a little bit more unusual than just a rash of sightings.

308

When you saw these flakes come down, did they reach a certain level and then get sucked

309

00:19:21,200 --> 00:19:24,800

back up right away or did any of them reach the ground and get sucked back up?

310

00:19:24,800 --> 00:19:26,480

No, none of them reached the ground.

311

00:19:26,480 --> 00:19:31,840

They came down simultaneously and it looked like Christmas lights.

312

00:19:31,840 --> 00:19:33,160

It looked like it was Christmas lights.

313

00:19:33,160 --> 00:19:35,120

They were all glowing.

314

00:19:35,120 --> 00:19:37,160

We already knew Denise's story.

315

She had multiple sightings of the same object.

316

00:19:39,480 --> 00:19:44,440

It's glitter coming down from the object into this tree.

317

00:19:44,440 --> 00:19:47,520

It was this tree.

318

00:19:47,520 --> 00:19:49,440

I knew that she had taken these photos.

319

00:19:49,440 --> 00:19:54,280

We had seen the photos beforehand, but we're a little at a loss to understand why is it

320

00:19:54,280 --> 00:19:57,960

that she saw this object five times but didn't have a clear photo of it.

321

Denise, you said this was a giant craft.

322

00:19:59,880 --> 00:20:03,840

If you were looking, just put your fingers up there and tell me how big the object would

323

have been on the screen there.

324

It was pretty big.

325

00:20:08,880 --> 00:20:14,320

But in your pictures, nothing that big shows up on the pictures, which is what we find

326

on.

327

Just try to understand how it is you could look through the camera and you said you could

328

00:20:19,280 --> 00:20:23,120

see the object inside of the screen as being very large, but we're not seeing it show up

329

00:20:23,120 --> 00:20:24,120

on film.

330

00:20:24,120 --> 00:20:26,840

We're not seeing it actually show up in the picture.

331

00:20:26,840 --> 00:20:28,840

Did you look at all the pictures?

332

00:20:28,840 --> 00:20:29,840

Yes.

333

00:20:29,840 --> 00:20:32,040

Did you have time to put your glasses on?

334

00:20:32,040 --> 00:20:34,560

No, I never had time to get my glasses on ever.

335

00:20:34,560 --> 00:20:35,560

So you took the picture?

336

00:20:35,560 --> 00:20:38,640

Because you never knew when it was going to go away, so I didn't want to go in the house

337

00:20:38,640 --> 00:20:42,200

and miss it or whatever, but no, I never had my glasses on.

Why do you think you haven't seen it since?

339

I really don't know why, but hopefully they're going to show themselves to somebody else.

Denise, does this look like the object you saw?

347

Yes.

348

Yes, except it goes slower when it goes in a shuffling pattern.

349

What do you mean by a shuffling pattern?

350

00:21:22,760 --> 00:21:26,760

When it's going across the sky, it kind of just shuffles along.

351

00:21:26,760 --> 00:21:30,880

So you're saying that the way we have this illustrated here, it's a pretty smooth trajectory.

352

Right.

353

00:21:31,880 --> 00:21:33,760

You're saying it's a more zigzag kind of thing?

354

00:21:33,760 --> 00:21:34,760

Yes.

355

00:21:34,760 --> 00:21:39,760

Shall we take a look at the sparkles here?

356

00:21:39,760 --> 00:21:40,760

Wow.

357

00:21:40,760 --> 00:21:45,760

Oh, that's cool.

358

00:21:45,760 --> 00:21:48,760

Looks like Christmas.

359

00:21:48,760 --> 00:21:49,760

Oh my gosh.

360

00:21:49,760 --> 00:21:51,760

Is that what it looked like?

361

00:21:51,760 --> 00:21:57,760

Yes, except it was twinkling more, but other than that, it just like it.

362

And they just pulled away and went up just like that?

363

Yes, just like that.

I just can't believe someone can capture what you're seeing, you know?

It's like if these guys were there.

And when we talked about the sighting and the glitter, she seemed much more confident.

Her answers were spontaneous, and she seemed like she was telling the truth about that.

But she's alleged that that glitter had come down in the trees and illuminated the trees,

371

00:22:21,760 --> 00:22:25,760

and she stood there for 20 minutes and watched it and never thought to get a camera.

372

Just like that?

373

00:22:26,760 --> 00:22:28,760

Yes, just like that.

374

00:22:28,760 --> 00:22:32,760

Now, would you take your eyes off of something like that?

375

00:22:32,760 --> 00:22:35,760

I wasn't moving.

376

00:22:35,760 --> 00:22:40,760

When we showed her those metallic sparkles, sprinkles coming down onto the tree, she lit up.

377

00:22:40,760 --> 00:22:45,760

That hit it right on the head, that this was exactly what she saw coming into those trees.

378

00:22:45,760 --> 00:22:48,760

So to me, that was confirmation that we got something good.

379

00:22:48,760 --> 00:22:50,760

It's always like flickering.

380

00:22:50,760 --> 00:22:52,760

It's like a little flicker.

381

00:22:58,760 --> 00:23:01,760

MUFUN is a nonprofit scientific research organization.

382

00:23:01,760 --> 00:23:07,760

We work with a wide network of experts who offer their skills and expertise to MUFUN.

383

00:23:07,760 --> 00:23:12,760

Dr. Levensgood is a retired professor who's intrigued by UFO investigations.

384

00:23:12,760 --> 00:23:18,760

He has his own lab and will look into interesting cases for UFO researchers.

385

00:23:18,760 --> 00:23:22,760

When we took these leaves and sent it to a lab for testing,

386

00:23:22,760 --> 00:23:27,760

we never thought we were going to get the type of report back that we did.

387

00:23:27,760 --> 00:23:33,760

Professor Levensgood's report said that these leaves in this tree was hit by some form of radiation.

388

00:23:34,760 --> 00:23:41,760

At first glance, this looked very suspicious because the leaves had a reddish coloration.

389

00:23:41,760 --> 00:23:45,760

That never happens in June or July, normally.

390

00:23:45,760 --> 00:23:51,760

But here, the energy level was so high that it caused the production of anthocyanin,

391

00:23:51,760 --> 00:23:56,760

a pigment in the plant that causes the reddish color in the leaves.

392

00:23:56,760 --> 00:23:59,760

Now, this was a real unusual situation.

393

00:23:59,760 --> 00:24:04,760

The energy not only produced this cream-colored region,

394

00:24:04,760 --> 00:24:14,760

but you got little bubbles from when the microwave heated the cytoplasm so fast that I'd never seen before at all.

395

00:24:14,760 --> 00:24:18,760

This whole thing took place in a matter of microseconds.

396

00:24:18,760 --> 00:24:22,760

Denise saw a very, very unusual phenomena.

397

00:24:22,760 --> 00:24:29,760

Another obvious thing that was occurring in these leaves, notice the heart shape.

398

00:24:29,760 --> 00:24:31,760

This is extremely unusual.

399

00:24:31,760 --> 00:24:34,760

This is called a somatic mutation.

400

00:24:34,760 --> 00:24:36,760

Here are the normal leaves down here.

401

00:24:36,760 --> 00:24:40,760

They come to a point, so they're quite different.

402

00:24:40,760 --> 00:24:48,760

You'll notice why, because these microwave energies came along and just hit that leaf bud's tip.

403

00:24:48,760 --> 00:24:52,760

And it didn't kill the cells, but it slowed the growth rate way down.

404

00:24:52,760 --> 00:24:57,760

I don't think we can escape the fact that some area of the sky

405

00:24:57,760 --> 00:25:02,760

had emitted an energy that caused these changes in the leaves.

406

00:25:02,760 --> 00:25:05,760

He's found stuff that he's never found before.

407

00:25:05,760 --> 00:25:08,760

The new growth is actually mutated.

408

00:25:08,760 --> 00:25:12,760

Changes that wouldn't happen unless something came in contact with microwaves.

409

00:25:12,760 --> 00:25:15,760

I don't think Denise walked out back with her microwave

410

00:25:15,760 --> 00:25:19,760

and popped the tree branch from up top into it.

411

00:25:31,760 --> 00:25:33,760

I sold the whole object.

412

00:25:33,760 --> 00:25:36,760

I wasn't quite sure whether or not I was losing it.

413

00:25:36,760 --> 00:25:40,760

The guy has really nothing at all to gain by making up a story like this.

414

00:25:42,760 --> 00:25:46,760

All Mufon investigators are volunteers.

415

00:25:46,760 --> 00:25:52,760

Their full-time occupations range from police detectives to computer graphic designers

416

00:25:52,760 --> 00:25:54,760

to aeronautical engineers.

417

00:25:54,760 --> 00:25:58,760

They bring their skills to each investigation.

418

00:26:12,760 --> 00:26:17,760

The close description of the UFO, I think, is probably one of the most detailed ones I've ever gotten.

419

00:26:17,760 --> 00:26:20,760

If they make any noise, they move very slow.

420

00:26:20,760 --> 00:26:23,760

If that was a plane, it would have fell right out of the sky.

421

00:26:23,760 --> 00:26:28,760

This thing wasn't smooth or aerodynamic in any way.

422

00:26:28,760 --> 00:26:34,760

He was very specific about the top of the craft, had windows that came along the edge.

423

00:26:34,760 --> 00:26:36,760

The interesting thing about his description was there were no lights.

424

00:26:36,760 --> 00:26:39,760

So many UFO stories involved lights in the sky.

425

00:26:39,760 --> 00:26:42,760

This was a completely dark craft.

426

00:26:42,760 --> 00:26:47,760

And the only way he saw this was that the heat lightning lit up the clouds behind it.

427

00:26:47,760 --> 00:26:52,760

This is a very useful tool to me because it's one thing to hear a description of someone.

428

00:26:52,760 --> 00:26:58,760

But once you show them an animation, it's interesting how they will start to really pick out what's wrong about it

429

00:26:58,760 --> 00:27:03,760

and help us refine it and we get to a really good view into their mind as to what they saw.

430

00:27:04,760 --> 00:27:08,760

Cliff, I want to show you the animation.

431

00:27:08,760 --> 00:27:11,760

Let's go ahead and play it all the way through once.

432

00:27:11,760 --> 00:27:16,760

And then we'll play it again and you can stop it at certain points and then point out whether it's accurate or not.

433

00:27:16,760 --> 00:27:34,760

Initial impressions? Very realistic looking.

434

00:27:34,760 --> 00:27:39,760

But it's too smooth on the sides from what I could see there.

435

00:27:39,760 --> 00:27:41,760

It didn't look quite like that.

436

00:27:41,760 --> 00:27:46,760

And if you're trying to get in the perspective of how I saw it, it wasn't going this way.

437

00:27:46,760 --> 00:27:49,760

It was going kind of away from me.

438

00:27:49,760 --> 00:27:52,760

So it looked more like a pizza.

439

00:27:52,760 --> 00:27:54,760

It was cut six slices.

440

00:27:54,760 --> 00:27:56,760

It was more consistent on the bottom here.

441

00:27:56,760 --> 00:27:59,760

It was still gray, like the color of the sky.

442

00:27:59,760 --> 00:28:01,760

But here we got it black.

443

00:28:01,760 --> 00:28:03,760

But no black. You can't really see the seams.

444

00:28:03,760 --> 00:28:06,760

Was there any lighting at all of the craft itself?

445

00:28:06,760 --> 00:28:16,760

Cliff's reaction to the animation, he made elaborations on it going back to the very first description he gave me

446

00:28:16,760 --> 00:28:19,760

and the first drawings that he showed me.

447

00:28:19,760 --> 00:28:24,760

You're seeing someone who is relying on memory rather than imagination.

448

00:28:24,760 --> 00:28:31,760

After Cliff saw the animation, he opened up and started to tell us a lot more about what happened to him.

449

00:28:31,760 --> 00:28:34,760

And that's what really what we were hoping for.

450

00:28:34,760 --> 00:28:42,760

There were some things that happened during both sightings that I didn't really bring out because I, at that point, I know what I saw.

451

00:28:42,760 --> 00:28:48,760

But I wasn't quite sure whether or not I was losing it.

452

00:28:48,760 --> 00:28:54,760

What it was doing as it went along, it would kind of jump.

453

00:28:54,760 --> 00:28:59,760

And you would see it here and then you would see it here.

454

00:28:59,760 --> 00:29:02,760

It kind of goes in a shuffling pattern.

455

00:29:02,760 --> 00:29:04,760

What do you mean by a shuffling pattern?

456

00:29:04,760 --> 00:29:10,760

Like when it's going across the sky, it kind of just shuffles along.

457

So it's almost like you were filming something and that's the only object that was moving.

458

It would look like it was here and it skipped and it goes there.

459

The object skipping through the sky.

460

00:29:19,760 --> 00:29:28,760

When he got into that mode of explaining that, that's sort of what tipped me off to there might be

a little more to it than was initially realized.

461

To me, Kalypsy seemed like an extremely credible witness.

462

00:29:31,760 --> 00:29:36,760

I don't see how this guy is going to at all benefit by coming forward with a story like this.

463

00:29:36,760 --> 00:29:38,760

He has so much more to lose than he has to gain.

464

00:29:38,760 --> 00:29:47,760

In terms of his standing in the community, the way his neighbors are going to view him, the guy has really nothing at all to gain by making up a story like this.

465

00:29:47,760 --> 00:29:50,760

It's not exactly what I saw that's the best I could do for him.

466

00:29:50,760 --> 00:29:58,760

I think he's coming forward because he's seeing something that he can't explain, that he wants someone to verify it for him.

467

00:29:58,760 --> 00:30:03,760

And just like any kind of credible witness, they wonder about their own sanity.

468

00:30:03,760 --> 00:30:07,760

They wonder when no one else can validate what they've seen, whether it's something that they've made up.

469

00:30:07,760 --> 00:30:14,760

But his deep conviction tells me and his stability tells me that what he's seen must be true.

470

If you're sleeping and woke up, could you sense something?

471

00:30:17,760 --> 00:30:19,760

Now the dog, the dog woke me up.

472

00:30:23,760 --> 00:30:27,760

Very little of what he had to say makes a whole lot of sense.

473

00:30:27,760 --> 00:30:31,760

I managed to isolate some very small flakes of a white compound.

474

00:30:31,760 --> 00:30:33,760

There is something intriguing here.

475

00:30:45,760 --> 00:30:50,760

It's like the regular airplane light, but there were so many of them.

476

00:30:50,760 --> 00:30:53,760

They would start as balls of light, then morph into a crab.

477

00:31:00,760 --> 00:31:08,760

When I got Levin Good's analysis, I was intrigued by the fact that something may have chemically altered these leaves or caused mutations in the growth.

478

00:31:08,760 --> 00:31:11,760

But I knew that I had to get a second opinion.

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00:31:15,760 --> 00:31:20,760

Dr. Salisbury is a world-class plant physiologist.

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00:31:20,760 --> 00:31:28,760

We took Levin Good's report and we forwarded it on to Dr. Salisbury for him to just take a look at it and tell us whether he agreed with Levin Good's analysis or not.

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00:31:28,760 --> 00:31:32,760

Unfortunately, he starts right off jumping to conclusions.

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00:31:32,760 --> 00:31:35,760

He jumps to conclusions throughout the whole analysis.

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00:31:35,760 --> 00:31:40,760

Levin Good says that the brown spots were because of anthocyanins.

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00:31:41,760 --> 00:31:48,760

This looked very suspicious because the leaves had a reddish coloration.

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00:31:48,760 --> 00:31:52,760

That never happens in June or July, normally.

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00:31:52,760 --> 00:31:56,760

To me, that's a tremendous conclusion jump.

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00:31:56,760 --> 00:32:04,760

The only way that he really would know that the anthocyanins would be to do the proper tests, chemical tests.

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00:32:04,760 --> 00:32:07,760

No real reason to think they're anthocyanins.

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00:32:07,760 --> 00:32:10,760

Then there were mutations.

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00:32:10,760 --> 00:32:13,760

He finds some of the leaves have a heart shape.

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00:32:13,760 --> 00:32:21,760

But the idea that they were in response to a mutation is again a huge leap into the unknown.

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00:32:21,760 --> 00:32:25,760

For one thing, leaves don't particularly grow that way.

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00:32:25,760 --> 00:32:27,760

They don't grow at the tip like stems do.

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00:32:27,760 --> 00:32:31,760

They form in the bud and then the cells expand to make the leaves.

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00:32:31,760 --> 00:32:36,760

It was disappointing, but also I said to myself, isn't this typical?

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00:32:36,760 --> 00:32:43,760

I mean, no matter what you do in this field, there's always a skeptic or somebody else to come back with the opposite.

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00:32:43,760 --> 00:32:48,760

So in this case, we have one scientist on one hand that's saying, yes, we have something here.

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00:32:48,760 --> 00:32:56,760

Then we turn around and submit his report to another scientist who takes the opposing view and says he doesn't think what the first one told us was valid.

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00:33:02,760 --> 00:33:10,760

There's several photos that were interesting. Let's take a look at this one.

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00:33:10,760 --> 00:33:18,760

My understanding is that this is the image that she's told the investigators was a pretty direct representation of what she actually saw that night.

What do you think of it?

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00:33:19,760 --> 00:33:24,760

When you look at this image, you see what looks like a bright, splotchy looking image.

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00:33:24,760 --> 00:33:27,760

So now you have this and that.

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00:33:28,760 --> 00:33:36,760

So here we see the bright image. You have to identify that and also account for what this is. What's that?

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00:33:36,760 --> 00:33:41,760

I asked Denise to take me outside and show me exactly where this was.

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00:33:41,760 --> 00:33:43,760

You got the coordinates and then...

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00:33:43,760 --> 00:33:50,760

I did. I did a compass bearing of 220 degrees. I could then plug it into some of my astronomy programs that I have.

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00:33:50,760 --> 00:33:51,760

Get the celestial picture.

509

00:33:51,760 --> 00:33:54,760

Get a celestial picture for that exact time and date.

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00:33:54,760 --> 00:33:58,760

We're looking for her backyard just like it would look.

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00:33:58,760 --> 00:34:02,760

That's right. She said it was somewhere between 1 and 2 in the morning.

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00:34:02,760 --> 00:34:05,760

And I have it set for 1 in the morning right now.

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00:34:05,760 --> 00:34:13,760

If we move the time ahead a little bit, okay, now we're around 2 in the morning.

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00:34:13,760 --> 00:34:17,760

And lo and behold, here comes the moon in Jupiter.

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00:34:17,760 --> 00:34:19,760

And that would put you in line with the tree line.

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00:34:19,760 --> 00:34:21,760

Actually, it would put us right in the tree line.

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00:34:21,760 --> 00:34:28,760

And the moon was full. You can actually see leaves silhouetted against the moon in this image.

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00:34:28,760 --> 00:34:31,760

And that explains why the moon was round behind the trees.

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00:34:31,760 --> 00:34:32,760

Gotcha.

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00:34:32,760 --> 00:34:40,760

Alright. Now, when you look at the image, you see that the orientation of this moon and that Jupiter are not the same as in the photo we saw.

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00:34:40,760 --> 00:34:43,760

Yeah, but you said she had the camera turned up this way too.

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00:34:43,760 --> 00:34:46,760

She could very well have turned the camera vertical for that shot.

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00:34:46,760 --> 00:34:48,760

And that would explain exactly what we're seeing.

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00:34:48,760 --> 00:34:50,760

It's perfect. It's amazing, isn't it? It's perfect.

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00:34:50,760 --> 00:34:52,760

It's a perfect correlation.

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00:34:52,760 --> 00:34:55,760

Mark and I went through all Denise's photos and there was really nothing there.

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00:34:55,760 --> 00:35:03,760

Mark felt everything was either reflections off the lens, possible aircraft lights, and other bright lights in the sky.

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00:35:03,760 --> 00:35:07,760

There was nothing there that Mark couldn't explain. And it was really disappointing.

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00:35:11,760 --> 00:35:15,760

Denise's case is falling apart, but we don't want to give up on it.

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00:35:15,760 --> 00:35:21,760

We collected samples from the tree that the UFO was seeing hovering above and dropping down this glitter into.
