and a long history of strange encounters.

My name is Daniel Gibson. I'm a retired Air Force major.

47

Major Gibson, thank you very much for taking your time to come and speak with us here today.

48

I'd like to start by asking you, what inspired you to come here today and why now?

49

In the fall of 1995, I was stationed at Malmstrom Air Force Base in Montana, right outside of Great Falls.

50

Malmstrom is primarily a ICBM missile base.

51

Since the 1960s, Malmstrom Air Force Base has housed hundreds of intercontinental ballistic missiles

52

with nuclear warheads capable of destroying entire cities.

53

During the Cold War, the base was part of the so-called Northern Tier Defense System,

54

a string of seven nuclear bases that provided a protective arc for the US and its allies.

55

Launch trajectories from the Soviet Union come over the poles across Alaska and Canada.

56

A ring of bases were established across the northern United States

57

00:04:00,000 --> 00:04:04,000

to house both ICBMs and strategic bombers.

58

00:04:04,000 --> 00:04:10,000

And they were the bedrock of our strategic deterrence and our security and safety.

Main thing alert, under War Plan Bravo.

In the fall of 1995, Gibson was on board a KC-135 as it conducted mid-air refueling

61

for a fleet of B-1B strategic heavy bombers which can carry nuclear payloads anywhere in the world.

Once the refueling was done, we started our trip back to Malmstrom.

63

I moved forward to the flight deck to enjoy the Aurora Borealis above us.

64

Flight paths for these refueling missions often included views of the Aurora Borealis, or Northern Lights.

65

All of a sudden, there was just this very bright light.

The aircraft commander and the copilot, they saw it first, time kind of froze for us,

67

This light, we watched it all the way down into the Aurora where it stopped.

And you could actually see the Aurora flowing around it, just as if you would see a bow-wave going around the front of a boat.

The longer the object stayed in the Aurora, the brighter the object got.

And then it just shot straight up and was gone.

So some people would say, you're obviously confused, you saw a planet or a star.

It was in the Aurora Borealis itself and then it shot straight back up.

I've seen the International Space Station, it moves at a very fast clip.

We all had the same reaction, it was almost a stunned silence.

None of us had seen anything like that before.

Some folks will say, well, you know, it could be a Russian first stage booster rock coming in on re-entry.

Well, initially we thought it was a shooting star, but then we saw the speed at which it was descending and then it stopped.

According to Gibson's account, the object possessed three of the five observables.

82

Instantaneous acceleration, the ability to accelerate instantly from a standstill.

83

Hypersonic velocity, speeds of 3700 miles per hour or more.

84

And trans-medium travel, the ability to move through air, water and the vacuum of space.

85

You're going from an atmospheric environment to potentially a vacuum environment.

86

I don't know of any object in our inventory that has the capability to stop mid-re-entry, stay in position,

87

and then once it's done, accelerate back out of the atmosphere.

The G-forces would kill a human being.

89

To Elizondo, Major Gibson's sighting is part of a pattern.

90

While working with ATIP, the Pentagon's Advanced Aerospace Threat Identification Program,

91

Elizondo says investigators researched multiple UFO sightings around Northern Tier nuclear bases during the Cold War.

92

These sightings were part of the G-forces' research.

93

These sightings were part of a recently leaked 500-page government-funded report

94

detailing dozens of alleged Cold War UFO encounters.

Investigative journalist Tim McMillan has studied the report.

There's a chart that showed the number of UFO sightings within proximity to different nuclear facilities that house weapons systems.

There's a distinct correlation that these objects appear to be encroaching upon airspace of the Northern Tier.

Both the UFOs had this incredible ability to take off and basically go from a very low velocity,

And there is one more detail that concerns Elizondo and his team.

If these were Russian aircraft, if these were someone else's aircraft,

He's meeting with an eyewitness from a second military base near a so-called Northern Tier Defense Site.

How you doing?

But I'd like to do, David, I want to hear this story from front to back.

It was my first annual training.

August 1st, 1992, I was deployed to a Canadian Army base called Gagetown in the province of New Brunswick.

CFB Gagetown is a large Canadian Army base just north of the US border, used by both countries as a training hub.

It was all Army. I don't know how many units were there, but people from all over the Northeast US and Eastern Canada all met up there to play these war games.

Marceau and another guardsman, he refers to as Mike because he doesn't want his real name revealed, are assigned night watch at a remote ammunition storage bunker known as a pad.

Mike was at pad one, I was at pad three.

154

00:13:35,000 --> 00:13:37,000

And what's in between each pad?

155

Thick forest.

156

It was a very bright night.

157

The moon was full.

158

I could see the whole big pile of ammunition in front of me.

I had a weapon, had no ammunition.

160

I was a sitting duck there.

161

About 1120, the hair in the back of my neck starts to stand up.

162

I feel like someone's watching me.

163

The tree frogs and the crickets and all the nighttime forest noises stopped.

164

And then I look up at this enormous spacecraft.

165

My first instinct is don't move.

166

I was afraid that whoever was in there was going to see me.

167

I knew as soon as I saw what I was looking at.

168

And I was scared that you're fine.

169

I don't think it was moving when I first noticed it.

170

And then I saw it move over the trees.

171

Is it's not like anything that's naturally occurring or even man-made?

172

I could hear like a static noise.

173

Like a TV that's not tuned into any channel.

174

We had field phones, always live.

175

I picked up the phone.

176

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:56,000

I said, Mike, are you there?

177

00:14:56,000 --> 00:14:59,000

I said, did you see that?

178

00:15:00,000 --> 00:15:02,000

And he said, thank God you said that.

179

00:15:02,000 --> 00:15:05,000

I thought I was going crazy.

180

00:15:05,000 --> 00:15:10,000

So if you can, David, just describe from the front to back rough dimensions.

181

Marcel later asked an illustrator he knew to create an image of the craft.

182

Oblong, rounded corners, slightly tapered towards the tail.

183

It was taller than my house.

184

00:15:23,000 --> 00:15:26,000

More than an acre long, half that width.

185

It was huge.

186

Did you notice any wings, control surfaces, navigation lights, landing gear?

187

No visible means of keeping this thing aloft and stationary.

188

There was no downwash.

189

Only recently has Marcel been able to talk openly about what he experienced.

190

I was traumatized by this, just saying, yeah, I saw an alien spaceship.

191

These were your words.

192

I knew it was an alien ship.

193

Now that's a word I typically don't use, but you did.

194

I knew what to look for, and it was neither an Allied nor Soviet block aircraft.

It was not a commercial aircraft.

196

It was that.

It's pretty clear to me that they were there scoping out our capabilities.

And here's these huge caches of ammunition.

199

Hey, let's go check this out.

Really, really appreciate it.

Elizondo wants to know more about Marcel's fellow witness.

202

Until now, Mike has stayed silent, but he agrees to speak to Elizondo by phone.

203

Hello.

204

00:16:36,000 --> 00:16:44,000

It was fairly routine shift, and I spotted a very bright yellow orange light across the road.

205

It was about 30 feet above the tree tops.

206

It was there for at least a half hour or more.

207

00:16:50,000 --> 00:16:54,000

All of a sudden, without any warning, it just took off.

208

It was like a streak of light.

209

It went so fast that if I closed my eyes for a second, I would have missed it.

210

Did it shoot over the horizon?

Where did it go? Did it go up?

212

All I saw was a streak of light.

213

It was completely silent.

I was talking to Dave.

215

I don't know if he asked me or if I asked him, but I remember, did you see that?

Elizondo recognizes three of the five observables, instantaneous acceleration, hypersonic velocity, and anti-gravity,

217

the ability to move without conventional propulsion or heat signature.

218

These vehicles don't seem to have any obvious signs of propulsion.

219

No wings or control surfaces, and yet somehow they seem to be defying Earth's gravitational pull.

220

Both Mr. Marceau and Major Gibson described objects with this incredible ability to take off from a very low velocity,

221

almost a complete hover, to an incredible speed in the instant of time.

222

But why would a UFO show an interest in a Canadian military base?

223

Gagetown was not far from Loring Air Force Base in Maine, another of America's strategic Northern Tier nuclear bases.

224

Whatever this phenomenon is, it seems to be keenly interested in our defense capabilities.

The Canadians are very closely integrated, in defending North America.

226

So not the least bit surprising that sightings would occur on both sides of the border.

227

I found it very interesting he said they were guarding ammunition,

228

and he mentioned that there was a 50 gallon drum barrel to simulate an atomic burst.

Why would we have that?

231

It doesn't mean it's a real nuclear device, but it's to simulate that.

Is there a connection, once again, between potential nuclear technologies and UAP activity?

But another theory suggests a different kind of nuclear connection.

234

You know it's interesting, about 60 miles outside of Gagetown there is a nuclear power plant.

235

The Point La Pro nuclear power generating station is one of just four nuclear power plants in all of Canada.

236

Previously, Alizando had found a link not just with UFOs and missile bases, but also power plants.

237

You know when I was at ATIP, we were under the presumption that there was definitely a connection between UAP activity and our nuclear energy.

238

The question is who's doing it and why are they doing it?

239

00:19:24,000 --> 00:19:30,000

There's all sorts of reasons why an enemy would want to spy on our nuclear capabilities.

240

A potential adversary is going to want to destroy our nuclear weapons capability to survive a nuclear conflict.

They're going to want to understand any vulnerabilities that they may have.

245

Out of the tree line rises this huge UFO.

246

Louis Alizando is reviewing David Marceau's eyewitness account with former Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense Chris Mellon.

247

He remembers the entire forest being completely dead silent.

248

Everything ceased.

249

Everything ceased.

251

His chain of command ridiculed him for it.

Negative.

There should have been follow-up.

This kind of reporting should be examined in a purely objective fashion.

Some of our facilities owned by Department of Energy, DOE, may have some reporting as well that hasn't yet been brought to the light of day, so to speak.

There were so many sightings that it generated memos that got to the four star level.

Francis E. Warren Air Force Base in Wyoming is one of America's most secure nuclear strongholds.

It operates 150-minute-man-3 intercontinental ballistic missiles on constant alert.

265

Roger, point roads announced.

266

00:21:41,000 --> 00:21:42,000

Clear.

267

00:21:42,000 --> 00:21:49,000

Like Malmstrom and lowering air force bases, Warren was also part of the Northern Tiered Nuclear Defense System.

268

00:21:49,000 --> 00:21:53,000

I was a security specialist, worked out in missile fields.

269

00:21:53,000 --> 00:22:00,000

I was an Army Sponsored Team member at that point, which is two men working a 12-hour shift.

270

00:22:00,000 --> 00:22:03,000

And I usually got stuck with working nighttime.

271

00:22:03,000 --> 00:22:07,000

It was June 1988, the waning days of the Cold War.

272

00:22:07,000 --> 00:22:17,000

We had just gotten on duty, and we had the missile crew down in a capsule call up to the flight security sergeant.

273

Told him that they had several missiles go offline.

274

It's very rare for a missile field to go down.

275

00:22:26,000 --> 00:22:31,000

The whole time that I was there, it had never happened except for that one incident.

My art team leader and I, we got into the truck and we headed off just patrolling the whole area.

277

It was right around 930s at that time.

That's when the lights went out.

This light came up very quickly, stopped over us and hugged over us.

That we could see red and blue lights moving in a circular fashion.

It was a streak of light going off.

The witness and his partner returned to the launch facility.

But just months later, multiple witnesses report a similar unidentified aircraft in the skies above Warren Air Force Base and nearby Cheyenne, Wyoming.

I got spotted up here in the sky, I can't figure out where it is.

This is a picture of the unidentified flying object that hovered over Cheyenne early Wednesday morning.

According to 911 records, the officer saw a circular object floating in the sky and he said it was moving slowly across the horizon.

It was kind of long shaped and kind of oblong and it kind of curved in it.

And you can see lights in the middle going around like this, changing colors from red, blue, green and even some yellow in it.

Whatever it was, it returned last night when there were several new reports of UFO sightings over Cheyenne.

There were never any official reports about the incident at Warren Air Force Base.

But the sightings over Cheyenne serve as proof for one witness.

The concern is, is there anything we can do about it? And the answer may very well be that there's no, there's nothing we can do about it right now.

317

Three military eyewitnesses from the same era appear to back up Elizondo's belief that there's a connection between UFOs and America's strategic Northern Tier nuclear bases.

But could an alleged encounter half a world away raise the stakes even higher?

You don't necessarily want to be the guy who saw a UFO. You don't want to have that stigma.

Jeremy McGowan served in the US Air Force Security Forces.

328

I was part of a team that would get deployed all over the planet for multiple different types of exercises or operations.

329

In the mid-1990s, McGowan was deployed on a classified security mission deep in the Jordanian Desert.

330

00:27:34,000 --> 00:27:37,000

We're basically told, here's a crate.

331

00:27:37,000 --> 00:27:41,000

A very large crate that you could have driven a Volkswagen bug through.

332

00:27:41,000 --> 00:27:48,000

There was no markings, no stencils, no nomenclature, no plaques, no cordons.

333

00:27:48,000 --> 00:27:55,000

It was just a large wooden crate that had absolutely no business being in the middle of the desert.

334

We're told, don't let anybody near it. Don't get near it.

335

Any idea what might have been in that crate?

336

I was never, never officially briefed as to what the contents of the crate was.

We were told that this crate was a top priority for security.

McGowan wonders why a crate in this remote desert needs such intense security.

339

On the base, we had Naval Special Warfare, 75th Ranger Battalion, FBI, the CIA.

340

You had units from the military that have very specific tasks when it comes to nuclear security.

341

McGowan suspects the crate contains some kind of nuclear material.

342

A realization that becomes even more concerning one night during his deployment when he's scanning the sky with night vision goggles.

343

All of a sudden, I saw a pinpoint of light in the night vision goggles that shot from my six o'clock.

344

It goes straight up to the apex of my vision and then does a 90 degree turn and shoots off to my nine o'clock.

And it happened multiple times.

I'm seeing something that is going from my visual horizon to another visual horizon with a 90 degree turn in the middle of the apex.

To Elizondo, the observables displayed by the object do not obey the laws of physics.

If you're looking at a fighter jet or a helicopter as it's turning, it's going to have an arc.

351

It's going to have a radius to that turn.

352

00:29:40,000 --> 00:29:45,000

Why would the things you witnessed not be a satellite?

353

00:29:45,000 --> 00:29:53,000

Satellites go in orbits in very circular paths and directions. This was not that.

354

McAllen says he believes the object may have been tracking what's in the crate.

355

It was my belief that this was probably targeting the crate.

356

It was able to look down and select certain radiation signatures.

357

The government still has not told us what was in the crate.

They probably never will.

But after speaking with the people that I've spoken to, I have personally no doubt that this was a recovered warhead

I have to be a little careful how I discuss this aspect just like he does.

367

But there is some reason to believe that inside that crate was what we refer to as a broken arrow, potentially a nuclear device.

368

Whatever it was, Jeremy McAllen is convinced that what he saw in the night sky was no normal aircraft.

When you look at an aircraft with night vision goggles, you can see the wing strobes, you can see the front strobes, you can see everything.

This was not identifiable.

371

This had no strobing effect.

372

00:31:35,000 --> 00:31:36,000

It had no flash patterns.

373

It had nothing except a point of light that moved extremely quickly from horizon to horizon.

374

If there are things that can move like this, they do pose a national security threat.

375

00:31:51,000 --> 00:31:53,000

I would take it a step further.

376

00:31:53,000 --> 00:31:54,000

Is this a global threat?

377

00:31:54,000 --> 00:31:58,000

Is this something that affects everybody regardless of borders?

378

These things don't seem to obey the laws of physics.

379

They're sure as hell not going to obey the laws of politics.

380

The team has now heard four different accounts describing UFOs with advanced capabilities hovering near nuclear assets.

381

They believe it's information members of the government need to be aware of.

382

Especially Lou Elizondo's mentor, the man who started the Pentagon's secret UFO program.

Lou Elizondo and Chris Mellon have spent months gathering new evidence of UFOs hovering near America's nuclear assets.

Now they're in Washington, D.C. to sound the alarm.

They can't avert their eyes to these anomalies any longer.

386

So we can stimulate that interest on the Hill by bringing some of the latest information to them as

well as to the executive branch.

The team has briefed top lawmakers before and now some of those lawmakers are paying attention.

You have two people from very different walks of life, both of whom have dedicated their careers to public service and national security.

They've really opened this issue up at senior government levels.

393

They're the pathfinders here. If you see Lou Elizondo as the Kirk, then you should see Chris Mellon as Spock.

Elizondo and Mellon have started the conversation, but have yet to convince the U.S. government to view UFOs and their connection to nuclear assets as a national security threat.

395

I did have one very brief meeting saying they're seeing UFOs. Do I believe it? Not particularly.

396

We're seeing something in our skies that we don't know what it is, and yet for some reason our national reaction has always been very dismissive.

Nothing to see here, folks. Don't pay attention to that.

The American people are going to demand it.

Elizondo meets with the man who started it all, the creator of the Pentagon's Advanced Aerospace Threat Identification Program, former Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid, to strategize how to get congressional attention.

This for me is probably one of the most important interviews that I've had, frankly, to date. If it wasn't for Senator Harry Reid, there never would have been a name tip. There never would have been the truth.

402

The former Nevada senator has been battling cancer, and Elizondo is eager to sit down again with his friend and mentor.

403

Elizondo brief Senator Reid on the new eyewitness accounts he believes suggest a stronger connection between UFOs and nuclear assets.

So whether these are UAPs buzzing in and around our missile silos or around our nuclear triad capabilities, there does seem to be now empirical data showing conclusively that there is some sort of interest.
