April 24th, 1964,

New Mexico State Police Officer Lani Zamora

36

is in hot pursuit of a speeding car

37

when something catches his attention.

38

He saw a strange light in the sky and heard a roaring sound,

39

rather like a rocket.

40

Zamora breaks off his pursuit of the speeding car

41

and is concerned that the roaring sound

42

is a local dynamite shack exploding.

43

But then, he sees an object above him.

44

He broke off his pursuit and decided to follow this strange object.

45

He lost sight of it for a while,

46

and then when he came over a hill,

47

he encountered this most extraordinary scene

of what looked like a spherical or oval-shaped silver object

He stops his patrol car, gets out of his car,

He sees it and describes it as this white-and-color,

53

spherical or saucer-shaped craft.

It had definitely landed on the ground.

And then he sees bodies actually exit the craft,

56

walk out into the field as he approaches

57

whomever these beings were.

He describes it as like he startled them

59

or kind of scared them a little bit,

60

and that they got back into the craft and took off.

The craft accelerates out of sight at an incredible speed.

62

As the craft was taking off,

63

he remembered that there was some type of flame

64

or maybe an engine of some kind

65

that was underneath the craft as it took off.

And as he approached where the object was,

67

he saw that there was actually trace evidence

68

or evidence that was left behind that something was there.

Zamora's training takes over.

70

He gets on the radio and calls in.

71

This really was almost a perfect storm

72

of what makes a UFO case compelling a police witness,

73

a landed UFO, and physical traces.

74

His testimony about the flame

75

underneath the craft was backed up

76

by the evidence that was left in the field.

So we had scorched ground, scorched vegetation

78

The Zamora sighting quickly becomes

There was an area of the desert

87

And when the U.S. government looked at this,

91

Noted Project Blue Book astronomer,

93

Alan Heineck arrives on the scene.

Heineck has years of experience

95

investigating not only aerial phenomena,

96

but the people who witnessed them.

97

Heineck called officers Zamora an unimpeachable witness,

98

00:05:15,000 --> 00:05:18,000

and I think that there's a couple reasons for that.

99

He was a very honest and trustworthy police officer,

100

00:05:21,000 --> 00:05:25,000

but on top of that, you also had physical trace evidence

101

that you can touch, feel, and back up his testimony.

102

Critics find it hard to dismiss Zamora's testimony.

103

When he didn't know something, he said, I don't know.

104

When he didn't see something, he said, I didn't see it.

This was a man who did not guess,

106

and Heineck said, witnesses don't get any better than this.

107

There are also other eyewitnesses

108

who describe seeing and hearing the same object

109

in the same area at the same time.

People hire up the chain of command,

111

would look at a case like this

112

and still dismiss UFOs as just misidentifications and hoaxes.

Famously, Heineck went on to say

114

the Air Force doesn't know what science is.

But the Air Force's formal public report

116

rejects some elements of the testimony

117

and attempts to discredit the other eyewitnesses,

118

even Zamora himself.

119

There were some theories that were put around about Zamora.

120

They were pretty insulting, actually.

121

Maybe he had been the victim of a practical joke.

Maybe he'd been in on some hoax

123

to try to bring tourism to the area.

None of these theories stood up.

125

He had nothing to gain by this

126

00:06:46,000 --> 00:06:49,000

and probably everything to lose.

127

But a secret report prepared for the CIA states

128

there is no question about Zamora's reliability.

129

In the later years, Zamora became so disillusioned

130

with both the Air Force and indeed with the UFO community

131

that he really dropped out of the whole scene.

132

He just wanted an explanation and he never got one.

133

They are credible.

134

But what happens when over two dozen police officers

135

witness something unexplainable in the sky?

The Cosford incident.

138

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:44,000

March 30th and 31st, 1993.

139

Devon, England.

140

The Cosford incident from the UK in March 1993

141

00:07:51,000 --> 00:07:55,000

is one of the best evidenced waves of UFO sightings

142

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:57,000

in recent years.

143

00:07:57,000 --> 00:08:00,000

There were several dozen UFO sightings,

144

00:08:00,000 --> 00:08:03,000

many of which were from serving police officers

145

00:08:03,000 --> 00:08:05,000

and military personnel.

146

00:08:05,000 --> 00:08:07,000

The high point of the Cosford wave

147

00:08:07,000 --> 00:08:10,000

saw two Air Force bases directly overflown

148

00:08:10,000 --> 00:08:12,000

by an unknown craft.

149

00:08:12,000 --> 00:08:15,000

And the UK Ministry of Defence's very own

150

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:19,000

UFO investigator, Nick Pope, was on the case.

151

00:08:19,000 --> 00:08:23,000

The UFO was seen by a patrol of military police officers

152

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:28,000

and they said that this thing passed directly overhead

153

00:08:28,000 --> 00:08:33,000

and was triangular in shape and of immense size.

154

But at the second base,

155

00:08:35,000 --> 00:08:38,000

Shawerbury, the meteorological officer,

156

00:08:38,000 --> 00:08:40,000

reported to me the following morning

157

00:08:40,000 --> 00:08:46,000

that he had seen a huge triangular shaped craft

158

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:50,000

flying maybe no more than 200 feet above the ground.

159

00:08:50,000 --> 00:08:52,000

But what the officer sees next

160

00:08:52,000 --> 00:08:54,000

shakes him to the core.

161

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:58,000

He saw a thin beam of light

162

00:08:58,000 --> 00:09:01,000

fire down from this UFO to the ground

163

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:03,000

and then track backwards and forwards

164

00:09:03,000 --> 00:09:05,000

as if it was looking for something.

165

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:08,000

And then he said, from a very slow speed,

166

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:11,000

maybe no more than 50 miles an hour,

167

00:09:11,000 --> 00:09:14,000

the beam of light retracted

168

00:09:14,000 --> 00:09:16,000

and the UFO from this slow speed

169

00:09:16,000 --> 00:09:21,000

accelerated away to the horizon just in an instant.

170

00:09:21,000 --> 00:09:24,000

His voice, by the way, was still shaking

171

00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:27,000

as I interviewed him the following morning.

172

00:09:27,000 --> 00:09:29,000

Nick Pope digs deeper into the case

173

00:09:29,000 --> 00:09:31,000

and his reports reached the leaders

174

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:33,000

of the Ministry of Defence.

175

00:09:33,000 --> 00:09:36,000

We were all completely baffled.

176

00:09:36,000 --> 00:09:40,000

There was nothing tracked on radar.

177

00:09:40,000 --> 00:09:44,000

There were one or two possibly vague pings,

178

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:48,000

but nothing that we could say with any certainty

179

00:09:48,000 --> 00:09:52,000

were any kind of aircraft that we were familiar with.

180

00:09:52,000 --> 00:09:54,000

Police officers were instrumental

181

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:56,000

in convincing authorities

182

00:09:56,000 --> 00:09:59,000

that something violated UK airspace.

183

00:09:59,000 --> 00:10:01,000

Police officers played a huge part

184

00:10:01,000 --> 00:10:04,000

in bringing the Cosford incident to light.

185

00:10:04,000 --> 00:10:07,000

It was a report from a patrol

186

00:10:07,000 --> 00:10:12,000

of Air Force police officers at RAF Cosford

187

00:10:12,000 --> 00:10:16,000

that really was one of the key incidents

188

00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:18,000

of that whole night.

189

00:10:18,000 --> 00:10:21,000

Police officers in the surrounding area

190

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:27,000

were able to say that civilians had seen this thing, too.

191

00:10:27,000 --> 00:10:32,000

So it was the police that drew together the strands of this.

192

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:35,000

One of the key factors in gathering evidence

193

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:39,000

was the UK's implementation of a standardised police form.

194

00:10:39,000 --> 00:10:42,000

Every single police station in the United Kingdom

195

00:10:42,000 --> 00:10:45,000

had a standard operating procedure,

196

00:10:45,000 --> 00:10:49,000

and indeed a form whereby we in the Ministry of Defence

197

00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:52,000

had given them the questions that we wanted answered.

198

00:10:52,000 --> 00:10:57,000

So this came to us in a strictly regimented format

199

00:10:57,000 --> 00:11:00,000

so that we had all the raw data that we needed

200

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:06,000

in terms of date, time, location, height, speed, description,

201

00:11:06,000 --> 00:11:08,000

sound, etc.

202

00:11:08,000 --> 00:11:12,000

The quality of the police testimony played a critical role.

203

00:11:12,000 --> 00:11:17,000

I interviewed many of the police, civilian and military.

204

00:11:17,000 --> 00:11:20,000

Their testimony was second to none.

205

00:11:20,000 --> 00:11:24,000

These people were trained observers,

206

00:11:24,000 --> 00:11:27,000

and when they relayed this to me,

207

00:11:27,000 --> 00:11:30,000

I was able to say with a high degree of confidence

208

00:11:30,000 --> 00:11:33,000

this is exactly the way that this happened.

209

00:11:33,000 --> 00:11:35,000

After such an in-depth investigation,

210

00:11:35,000 --> 00:11:39,000

the UK government comes to a stunning conclusion.

211

For the first time that I can recall,

212

we put in black and white in our assessment

213

00:11:45,000 --> 00:11:49,000

that an uncorrelated target,

214

00:11:49,000 --> 00:11:52,000

an unidentified craft,

215

00:11:52,000 --> 00:11:57,000

penetrated the UK's sophisticated air defence network

216

00:11:57,000 --> 00:12:02,000

and flew with apparent impunity for hours over the United Kingdom.

217

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:07,000

So it's arguably the only government assessment of UFOs

218

00:12:07,000 --> 00:12:12,000

that directly contradicts the party line, the official line.

219

Police officers can yield more questions than answers.

220

00:12:42,000 --> 00:12:46,000

Unsealed case file, the St. Clair Triangle,

221

00:12:46,000 --> 00:12:50,000

January 5, 2000, Southern Illinois.

222

00:12:50,000 --> 00:12:55,000

Officer Ed Barton responds to a 4 a.m. call from dispatch.

223

00:12:55,000 --> 00:12:59,000

Witnesses claim they have seen a UFO in the night sky.

224

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:02,000

When Officer Barton arrives at the location,

225

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:05,000

he witnesses a black triangle

226

00:13:05,000 --> 00:13:08,000

beaming powerful lights to the ground.

227

00:13:08,000 --> 00:13:11,000

He claims the triangle emits no noise

228

00:13:11,000 --> 00:13:14,000

and does not behave like conventional aircraft.

229

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:18,000

Suddenly, the triangle accelerates out of sight

230

00:13:18,000 --> 00:13:23,000

and it is picked up by another police officer in the next town.

231

00:13:23,000 --> 00:13:27,000

Here you've got many of these police witnesses

232

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:31,000

describing a vast triangular shaped craft

233

00:13:31,000 --> 00:13:34,000

just hanging there in the sky

234

00:13:34,000 --> 00:13:39,000

and suddenly accelerating away to the horizon at high max speeds.

235

00:13:39,000 --> 00:13:43,000

What really made this compelling

236

00:13:43,000 --> 00:13:48,000

was that not only were some of the witnesses, police officers, out on patrol,

237

00:13:48,000 --> 00:13:53,000

but these police officers were radioing back to their dispatchers

238

00:13:53,000 --> 00:13:55,000

what they were seeing

239

00:13:55,000 --> 00:13:58,000

and they were also coordinating the investigation

240

00:13:58,000 --> 00:14:01,000

when it came to sightings from the public.

241

00:14:01,000 --> 00:14:05,000

And they were able to actually document where this craft was heading

242

00:14:05,000 --> 00:14:09,000

and then have other police officers essentially pick up the chase

243

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:11,000

and follow this craft wherever it was going.

244

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:16,000

Five police departments spanning a large area of Southwest Illinois

245

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:18,000

tracked the triangular UFO.

246

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:20,000

And it was that type of communication

247

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:24,000

which ultimately became a very powerful tool for them

248

00:14:24,000 --> 00:14:27,000

to essentially track this UFO to try and figure out what it was.

249

00:14:27,000 --> 00:14:32,000

When you have multiple police officers that are able to essentially track a UFO

250

00:14:32,000 --> 00:14:36,000

and they can stay in contact with each other through radio contact

251

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:39,000

that brings another level of credibility to this.

252

00:14:39,000 --> 00:14:43,000

I can't say with any certainty that this was extraterrestrial

253

00:14:43,000 --> 00:14:46,000

we have no definitive proof

254

00:14:46,000 --> 00:14:48,000

but sometimes with a sighting like this

255

00:14:48,000 --> 00:14:52,000

you're really left with the feeling there's not much else it can be.

256

00:14:52,000 --> 00:14:57,000

But some experts believe the Illinois Triangle can be explained.

257

00:14:57,000 --> 00:15:01,000

I think at the end of the day it's that probably a military aircraft

258

00:15:01,000 --> 00:15:03,000

because when you look at our technology

259

00:15:03,000 --> 00:15:06,000

when you look at the F-117 stealth fighter

260

00:15:06,000 --> 00:15:10,000

and you look at what we have flying in the skies

261

00:15:10,000 --> 00:15:13,000

or what ultimately could be a top secret aircraft

262

00:15:13,000 --> 00:15:15,000

it is very similar in design.

263

00:15:15,000 --> 00:15:18,000

So I think the Black Triangle UFO phenomena

264

00:15:18,000 --> 00:15:22,000

what we're seeing is maybe a peak into technology that's being developed

265

00:15:22,000 --> 00:15:25,000

but the military hasn't told us yet.

266

00:15:25,000 --> 00:15:30,000

Whatever it was, some experts believe that even the most credible testimony

267

00:15:30,000 --> 00:15:35,000

will always be met with a certain degree of skepticism.

268

00:15:35,000 --> 00:15:38,000

I think there's another factor at play here.

269

00:15:38,000 --> 00:15:40,000

This is human variation.

270

00:15:40,000 --> 00:15:45,000

Different witnesses have different memories.

271

00:15:45,000 --> 00:15:48,000

They have different belief systems, different perceptions.

272

00:15:48,000 --> 00:15:53,000

I think almost everyone is going to see and perceive something

273

00:15:53,000 --> 00:15:57,000

particularly something exotic outside their normal frame of reference

274

00:15:57,000 --> 00:15:59,000

in a different way.

275

00:15:59,000 --> 00:16:03,000

The irony is that this is something every police officer will tell you.

276

00:16:15,000 --> 00:16:19,000

The credibility is really raised for a particular case

277

00:16:19,000 --> 00:16:23,000

because you do have that level of honesty and reliability

278

00:16:23,000 --> 00:16:29,000

and essentially training that if they saw something that they cannot explain

279

00:16:29,000 --> 00:16:32,000

I think that's something that we have to look at.

280

00:16:32,000 --> 00:16:38,000

However, even the most highly trained police personnel are not immune to skeptics

281

00:16:38,000 --> 00:16:43,000

something the officers involved in the St. Clair Triangle incident know all too well.

282

00:16:43,000 --> 00:16:46,000

In the aftermath of the Illinois UFO sightings

283

00:16:46,000 --> 00:16:52,000

many of the police witnesses, many of the police officers who investigated this

284

00:16:52,000 --> 00:16:57,000

and saw things themselves, they had headaches, they had anxiety, depression,

285

00:16:57,000 --> 00:16:59,000

they became the butt end of jokes.

286

00:16:59,000 --> 00:17:04,000

If you start getting made fun of or somebody completely discounts what you saw

287

00:17:04,000 --> 00:17:06,000

the next time you see something like that

288

00:17:06,000 --> 00:17:12,000

my guess is you're going to be pretty apprehensive to coming out and explaining what you saw.

289

00:17:12,000 --> 00:17:14,000

I think you're looking at the tip of the iceberg.

290

00:17:14,000 --> 00:17:17,000

There's a whole bunch of other police sightings out there

291
