lead guitarist and singer-songwriter

for the popular grunge band Nirvana.

Cobain apparently died of a shotgun blast to the head.

27

An autopsy later revealed a nearly lethal dose of heroin

28

00:02:08,940 --> 00:02:10,580

in his bloodstream.

29

00:02:10,580 --> 00:02:13,820

The official ruling was suicide.

30

00:02:13,820 --> 00:02:16,740

I don't believe Kurt Cobain committed suicide.

31

00:02:16,740 --> 00:02:19,700

I believe there was someone with him in that room.

32

00:02:19,700 --> 00:02:21,900

I believe it was someone that he knew.

33

00:02:21,900 --> 00:02:23,980

They were doing heroin together.

34

00:02:23,980 --> 00:02:27,620

I believe at a certain point, more heroin

35

00:02:27,620 --> 00:02:30,260

was injected into Kurt Cobain than what he wanted

36

00:02:30,260 --> 00:02:32,700

injected into himself.

37

00:02:32,700 --> 00:02:35,740

And after that point, he was shot with a shotgun

38

00:02:35,740 --> 00:02:38,700

once he had become totally incapacitated.

39

There was a very thorough, comprehensive investigation

40

00:02:41,940 --> 00:02:43,980

done from the very beginning.

41

00:02:43,980 --> 00:02:48,060

And everything that the detectives encountered

42

indicated to them that this was a suicide.

43

00:02:50,740 --> 00:02:54,100

We actually found nothing to indicate

44

00:02:54,100 --> 00:02:57,300

that this was anything but a suicide.

45

However, this wasn't Cobain's first brush with death.

46

A month earlier, this photograph was

47

taken as Cobain was being rushed to a hospital in Rome, Italy.

48

He had overdosed on sedatives and alcohol and nearly died.

49

His family and friends persuaded him

50

00:03:13,380 --> 00:03:15,380

to check in the drug rehab.

51

But after two days, he walked out and disappeared.

52

The next day, Cobain's wife, fellow rocker Courtney Love,

53

is said to have contacted Tom Grant, a Los Angeles-based

54

00:03:26,980 --> 00:03:29,820

private investigator, and asked him to find her husband.

55

00:03:32,540 --> 00:03:34,900

Courtney asked us, of course, not to contact him,

56

00:03:34,900 --> 00:03:37,340

not to make any contact with him, just to report back

57

00:03:37,340 --> 00:03:41,300

where he was and what was going on.

58

00:03:41,300 --> 00:03:44,900

But Tom Grant didn't find Cobain soon enough.

59

00:03:44,900 --> 00:03:48,020

Kurt's lifeless body was discovered by an electrician

60

00:03:48,020 --> 00:03:52,820

working at his house three days after he died.

61

00:03:52,820 --> 00:03:56,340

I contacted the police the day the body was found.

62

00:03:56,340 --> 00:03:57,860

They basically told me on the phone,

63

00:03:57,860 --> 00:04:01,140

hey, we know a suicide when we see a suicide.

64

00:04:01,140 --> 00:04:05,300

Grant quickly switched from surveillance to investigation.

65

00:04:05,300 --> 00:04:07,300

The more he discovered, the more he

66

00:04:07,300 --> 00:04:12,980

became convinced that the official cause of death was wrong.

67

Grant believes that he has found important inconsistencies

68

00:04:16,580 --> 00:04:18,100

in the case.

69

00:04:18,100 --> 00:04:20,620

Number one, Cobain's credit card appears

70

00:04:20,620 --> 00:04:23,500

to have been used after his death.

71

00:04:23,500 --> 00:04:26,580

There was an attempt made on April 6.

72

00:04:26,580 --> 00:04:29,700

There was another attempt made on April 8.

73

00:04:29,700 --> 00:04:33,540

Kurt had died sometime on April 5.

74

00:04:33,540 --> 00:04:35,780

Who was using the credit card?

75

00:04:35,780 --> 00:04:38,740

The information we've been able to receive from the bank

76

00:04:38,740 --> 00:04:41,700

has only been able to identify for us

77

00:04:41,700 --> 00:04:45,940

when the information was logged onto their mainframe computer

78

00:04:45,940 --> 00:04:48,980

and not specifically when the attempt was made

79

00:04:48,980 --> 00:04:51,860

or who it was made by.

80

00:04:51,860 --> 00:04:53,620

Now after the body was discovered,

81

two other cards were found in the wallet.

82

00:04:55,620 --> 00:04:58,940

But the actual credit card that someone was attempting to use

83

after we now know Kurt was already did was not found.

84

A second inconsistency, the autopsy showed

85

Kurt Cobain's blood contain 1.52 milligrams per liter

86

00:05:12,500 --> 00:05:16,740

of the tranquilizer diazepam and helm.

87

00:05:16,740 --> 00:05:19,180

Some medical experts say that much heroin

88

00:05:19,180 --> 00:05:21,820

could kill a person three times over.

89

00:05:21,820 --> 00:05:25,820

Could he, with that much heroin and diazepam in his system,

90

00:05:25,820 --> 00:05:28,700

could he even pick up that shotgun?

91

00:05:28,700 --> 00:05:32,540

Wouldn't he be incapacitated within seconds?

92

00:05:32,540 --> 00:05:36,620

Dr. Ronald Ray inspected Cobain's body at the scene.

93

00:05:36,620 --> 00:05:38,100

It's really an issue of tolerance,

94

00:05:38,100 --> 00:05:41,740

how much is this person used to if a person is gradually

95

00:05:41,780 --> 00:05:47,020

over months or years increased the dose,

96

00:05:47,020 --> 00:05:52,100

a person could function with that amount of drugs,

97

00:05:52,100 --> 00:05:54,740

narcotics or whatever it is present in the system.

98

Again, so much of it depends upon individual tolerance

99

00:05:58,740 --> 00:06:00,700

over a period of time.

100

00:06:00,700 --> 00:06:04,860

A third inconsistency, police found no legible fingerprints

101

on the shotgun, the shotgun shells or the pen used

102

00:06:07,980 --> 00:06:10,380

to write the note.

103

00:06:10,420 --> 00:06:12,460

Could they have been wiped clean?

104

00:06:12,460 --> 00:06:14,740

The official interpretation is.

105

00:06:14,740 --> 00:06:16,940

Well, I think it's clear that anyone who is familiar

106

00:06:16,940 --> 00:06:20,060

with firearms and their use would know

107

00:06:20,060 --> 00:06:23,260

that as they hold a weapon that frequently that weapon will

108

00:06:23,260 --> 00:06:25,100

move in their hand.

109

00:06:25,100 --> 00:06:27,180

Additionally, when that weapon is discharged,

110

that causes a jerking motion, which

111

causes the hands to move over the surface of the weapon.

And all of those factors could cause any fingerprints

Inconsistency number four, the alleged suicide note.

Tom Grant believes it was actually a retirement letter

116

to Cobain's fans.

117

There were rumors that Cobain was feeling burnt out

118

00:06:53,820 --> 00:06:57,100

and was planning to adopt a lower profile.

119

00:06:57,100 --> 00:07:00,260

He had just recently pulled out of the annual Lala Pallusa

120

00:07:00,260 --> 00:07:02,820

tour.

121

00:07:02,820 --> 00:07:06,700

This is a copy of the note that has been widely circulated.

122

00:07:06,740 --> 00:07:09,380

Tom Grant suggests that only the last four lines

123

00:07:09,380 --> 00:07:11,020

indicate suicide.

124

00:07:11,020 --> 00:07:13,460

They read, please keep going, Courtney,

125

00:07:13,460 --> 00:07:16,860

for Francis, for her life which will be so much happier

126

00:07:16,860 --> 00:07:17,980

without me.

127

00:07:17,980 --> 00:07:19,140

I love you.

128

00:07:19,140 --> 00:07:21,500

I love you.

129

00:07:21,500 --> 00:07:24,180

We asked handwriting expert Marcel Matley

130

00:07:24,180 --> 00:07:27,820

to compare a copy of Cobain's alleged suicide note

131

00:07:27,820 --> 00:07:32,860

with two pages of lyrics handwritten by Cobain.

132

00:07:32,900 --> 00:07:36,740

Matley believes the bulk of the note was written by Cobain.

133

00:07:36,740 --> 00:07:37,780

However.

134

00:07:37,780 --> 00:07:41,820

As to the last four lines, there are more than a dozen

135

00:07:41,820 --> 00:07:44,620

differences that should give us pause.

136

00:07:44,620 --> 00:07:47,940

And we would have to reasonably explain these differences

137

00:07:47,940 --> 00:07:51,740

before we can conclude that the same person wrote the four

138

00:07:51,740 --> 00:07:54,580

lines that wrote the body of it.

139

00:07:54,580 --> 00:07:57,100

Handwriting expert Reginald Alton also

140

00:07:57,100 --> 00:07:59,620

compared copies of Cobain's handwriting

141

00:07:59,620 --> 00:08:01,500

to a copy of the note.

142

00:08:02,260 --> 00:08:06,660

In a five page written report, Alton pointed out more than a

143

00:08:06,660 --> 00:08:08,620

dozen discrepancies.

144

00:08:08,620 --> 00:08:11,780

He believes the bulk of the note was written by Cobain,

145

00:08:11,780 --> 00:08:16,460

but raises questions about the first line and the last four

146

00:08:16,460 --> 00:08:18,820

lines.

147

00:08:18,820 --> 00:08:21,540

His report states, there are many indications

148

00:08:21,540 --> 00:08:25,140

that there may have been a second hand at work.

149

00:08:25,140 --> 00:08:28,140

We did take the note from the scene

150

00:08:28,260 --> 00:08:33,460

and have it examined at the Washington State Crime Lab.

151

00:08:33,460 --> 00:08:36,180

And their handwriting analyst has

152

00:08:36,180 --> 00:08:40,300

indicated that it is her belief that this note was

153

00:08:40,300 --> 00:08:44,500

written by Mr. Cobain.

154

00:08:44,500 --> 00:08:48,140

Kurt Cobain had made an important decision in his life.

155

00:08:48,140 --> 00:08:50,900

He wanted out of the entertainment business.

156

00:08:50,900 --> 00:08:52,140

He didn't want to tour anymore.

157

00:08:52,140 --> 00:08:53,980

He didn't want to perform anymore.

158

00:08:53,980 --> 00:08:55,020

He wanted to be left alone.

159

00:08:55,020 --> 00:09:00,820

He never liked that aspect of being a performer.

160

00:09:00,820 --> 00:09:03,620

This decision that he had made was going to affect a lot

161

00:09:03,620 --> 00:09:05,580

of other people.

162

00:09:05,580 --> 00:09:09,180

He was no longer the money machine that he once was.

163

00:09:09,180 --> 00:09:13,740

Now Cobain was worth more dead than he was alive.

164

00:09:13,740 --> 00:09:16,580

But who would have wanted Cobain dead?

165

00:09:16,580 --> 00:09:19,620

Could it have been the mysterious user of his credit card

166

00:09:19,620 --> 00:09:23,060

and did that same person add critical lines to Cobain's

167

00:09:23,100 --> 00:09:25,940

alleged suicide note?

168

00:09:25,940 --> 00:09:31,420

For now, those questions remain unanswered.

169

00:09:31,420 --> 00:09:34,620

The Seattle police consider the case closed.

170

00:09:34,620 --> 00:09:37,340

Tom Grant does not.

171

00:09:37,340 --> 00:09:40,420

He believes that the investigation should be reopened

172

00:09:40,420 --> 00:09:46,820

and the inconsistencies resolved once and for all.

173

00:09:46,820 --> 00:09:51,300

Next, murder at a massage parlor with a police involved.

174

00:09:53,060 --> 00:09:56,940

And later, a feud over drug money spirals out of control.

175

Our next story is about sex, murder,

176

00:10:09,380 --> 00:10:11,700

and charges that the police may be involved

177

00:10:11,700 --> 00:10:14,100

in the killing of two prostitutes.

178

00:10:14,100 --> 00:10:16,540

At the center of this unsolved crime

179

00:10:16,540 --> 00:10:22,340

is a madam who won't stop until she gets some answers.

180

00:10:22,340 --> 00:10:24,260

I don't think the murders were ever meant to be solved.

181

00:10:24,260 --> 00:10:25,660

And they thought if it got solved,

182

00:10:25,660 --> 00:10:28,780

it would be a really big embarrassment

183

00:10:28,780 --> 00:10:32,780

to have police officers arrested for killing two prostitutes.

184

00:10:32,780 --> 00:10:35,940

Bring somebody the proof and the evidence needed

185

00:10:35,940 --> 00:10:39,300

for indictments or convictions.

186

00:10:39,300 --> 00:10:43,020

I will assist any agency in their apprehension.

187

00:10:43,020 --> 00:10:47,740

Until then, I'm not going to point fingers at anybody.

188

00:10:47,740 --> 00:10:50,740

Straddling the border between Kentucky and Tennessee

189

00:10:50,740 --> 00:10:52,580

is Fort Campbell, Kentucky.

190

00:10:52,580 --> 00:10:55,740

It's one of the largest army bases in the world.

191

00:10:55,740 --> 00:10:59,140

And just down the road is the little town of Oak Grove,

192

00:10:59,140 --> 00:11:03,180

home of the New Life Massage Parlor.

193

00:11:03,180 --> 00:11:04,180

Hi.

194

00:11:04,180 --> 00:11:05,060

Welcome to New Life.

195

00:11:05,060 --> 00:11:09,940

Here, a handful of girls give comfort to the troops.

196

00:11:09,940 --> 00:11:13,220

Tammy Papler is the owner of the New Life Massage Parlor.

197

00:11:13,220 --> 00:11:16,100

Hi, baby.

198

00:11:16,100 --> 00:11:18,900

Though prostitution is illegal in Kentucky,

199

00:11:18,900 --> 00:11:22,900

Tammy says the police didn't bother her because, well,

200

00:11:22,900 --> 00:11:25,020

they got quite a few benefits.

201

00:11:25,020 --> 00:11:27,380

The police department would pick out specific things for us

202

00:11:27,380 --> 00:11:29,460

to buy, and they would order them.

203

00:11:29,460 --> 00:11:32,580

I know there were lights for just about every car,

204

00:11:32,580 --> 00:11:38,020

shoes, uniforms, canine t-shirts, Christmas parties,

205

00:11:38,020 --> 00:11:40,220

Christmas bonuses.

206

00:11:40,220 --> 00:11:41,820

They get basically what they want.

207

00:11:41,820 --> 00:11:45,260

Those little seven or eight police officers and the mayor

208

00:11:45,260 --> 00:11:46,460

run the whole town.

209

00:11:49,900 --> 00:11:50,900

Hi, Ed.

210

00:11:50,900 --> 00:11:54,900

Tammy says one Oak Grove police officer, Ed Carter,

211

00:11:54,900 --> 00:11:56,900

took excessive advantage.

212

00:11:56,900 --> 00:12:01,900

Carter has denied the accusations you are about to hear.

213

00:12:01,900 --> 00:12:03,900

So what can we do for you today, Ed?

214

00:12:03,900 --> 00:12:05,900

Oh, well, it's just in the neighborhood.

215

00:12:05,900 --> 00:12:09,900

Ed Carter would ask a lot more than the other officers would.

216

00:12:09,900 --> 00:12:11,900

So he wanted services, and it was like, well,

217

00:12:11,900 --> 00:12:12,900

I know what's going on.

218

00:12:12,900 --> 00:12:14,900

You know, I'm a police officer.

219

00:12:14,900 --> 00:12:15,900

Who are they going to believe?

220

00:12:15,900 --> 00:12:17,900

You are me.

221

00:12:17,900 --> 00:12:21,900

According to Tammy, once Carter got started, he didn't stop.

222

00:12:21,900 --> 00:12:23,900

He insisted that she contract with him

223

00:12:23,900 --> 00:12:27,900

for janitorial services.

224

00:12:27,900 --> 00:12:30,900

And when she went on vacation, Tammy says Ed Carter virtually

225

00:12:30,900 --> 00:12:35,900

took over control of the massage parlor.

226

00:12:35,900 --> 00:12:37,900

Ed, what are you doing?

227

00:12:37,900 --> 00:12:38,900

Hold up.

228

00:12:38,900 --> 00:12:39,900

Just making sure I'm going to talk.

229

00:12:39,900 --> 00:12:40,900

You're telling my money, Ed.

230

00:12:40,900 --> 00:12:41,900

What's going on?

231

00:12:41,900 --> 00:12:42,900

It was like he was the madam.

232

00:12:42,900 --> 00:12:43,900

I wasn't the madam anymore.

233

00:12:43,900 --> 00:12:44,900

It was actually like he was.

234

00:12:44,900 --> 00:12:46,900

He was the one that was in charge of the parlor.

235

00:12:46,900 --> 00:12:47,900

He was running it.

236

00:12:47,900 --> 00:12:48,900

Ed, put down my money.

237

00:12:48,900 --> 00:12:49,900

Look, I've helped you from day one.

238

00:12:49,900 --> 00:12:51,900

And how much money have you taken?

239

00:12:51,900 --> 00:12:53,900

I was furious with him.

240

00:12:53,900 --> 00:12:55,900

I didn't want him around my business anymore.

241

00:12:55,900 --> 00:12:57,900

I didn't want him around the girls.

242

00:12:57,900 --> 00:12:59,900

I informed the girls you keep the door locked.

243

00:12:59,900 --> 00:13:01,900

If he comes in, you just shake your head, no.

244

00:13:01,900 --> 00:13:03,900

Don't allow him to come inside this business.

245

00:13:03,900 --> 00:13:04,900

Get out of here.

246

00:13:04,900 --> 00:13:06,900

Get out of here.

247

00:13:06,900 --> 00:13:08,900

I told him, don't ever come around here again.

248

00:13:08,900 --> 00:13:10,900

You stay away.

249

00:13:10,900 --> 00:13:12,900

And I made sure we had had a meeting,

250

00:13:12,900 --> 00:13:14,900

and I informed each and every one of them this.

251

00:13:14,900 --> 00:13:16,900

You do not allow him around here anymore.

252

00:13:16,900 --> 00:13:17,900

It's the end of it.

253

A few weeks later, the bodies of 22-year-old Candy Belt

254

00:13:25,900 --> 00:13:28,900

and 18-year-old Gloria Ross were discovered

255

00:13:28,900 --> 00:13:30,900

in a back room of the brothel.

256

00:13:30,900 --> 00:13:36,900

Both were shot execution style, and both had their throats

257

00:13:36,900 --> 00:13:37,900

slashed.

258

00:13:39,900 --> 00:13:43,900

Earlier that same evening, Ed Carter stopped by the massage

259

00:13:43,900 --> 00:13:44,900

parlor.

260

00:13:44,900 --> 00:13:45,900

Good evening, ladies.

261

00:13:45,900 --> 00:13:46,900

Slow night, huh?

262

00:13:46,900 --> 00:13:49,900

He told investigators that he went home to his wife

263

00:13:49,900 --> 00:13:52,900

at 3 AM, well before the murders, which

264

00:13:52,900 --> 00:13:56,900

occurred around 4 AM, according to the coroner's report.

265

00:13:56,900 --> 00:13:59,900

Carter and his wife have since been divorced.

266

00:13:59,900 --> 00:14:03,900

She now claims that he got home well after 3 AM.

267

00:14:03,900 --> 00:14:07,900

He came in a few minutes after 4.

268

00:14:07,900 --> 00:14:10,900

I made it a habit of looking up at the clock when

269

00:14:10,900 --> 00:14:12,900

he came in.

270

00:14:12,900 --> 00:14:14,900

Mary and I are going to grab some drinks.

271

00:14:14,900 --> 00:14:15,900

Do you want to go with us?

272

00:14:15,900 --> 00:14:16,900

No, no thanks.

273

00:14:16,900 --> 00:14:19,900

The two women were shot with a small caliber gun.

274

00:14:22,900 --> 00:14:25,900

Ed Carter told police he owned no such weapon.

275

00:14:25,900 --> 00:14:29,900

Again, his ex-wife disagrees.

276

00:14:29,900 --> 00:14:33,900

Ed did own a small caliber gun.

277

00:14:33,900 --> 00:14:37,900

He kept it under the mattress for my protection.

278

00:14:37,900 --> 00:14:39,900

It was not there that night.

279

00:14:39,900 --> 00:14:44,900

I had not seen it from the Christmas before the shootings.

280

00:14:44,900 --> 00:14:48,900

Ed Carter voluntarily took a polygraph exam a few weeks

281

00:14:48,900 --> 00:14:51,900

after the murders.

282

00:14:51,900 --> 00:14:55,900

I can't tell you whether or not he passed or failed

283

00:14:55,900 --> 00:14:57,900

his polygraph.

284

00:14:57,900 --> 00:15:00,900

The only thing I can tell you is that he did resign

285

00:15:00,900 --> 00:15:03,900

from the police department and that he did secure

286

00:15:03,900 --> 00:15:06,900

an attorney after the polygraph.

287

00:15:07,900 --> 00:15:08,900

Mr. Carter's never run.

288

00:15:08,900 --> 00:15:10,900

He's never fled the area.

289

00:15:10,900 --> 00:15:11,900

He's never left the area.

290

00:15:11,900 --> 00:15:14,900

Whenever he was questioned, he always cooperated.

291

00:15:14,900 --> 00:15:16,900

I feel like Ed Carter killed him.

292

00:15:16,900 --> 00:15:17,900

I honestly do.

293

00:15:17,900 --> 00:15:22,900
