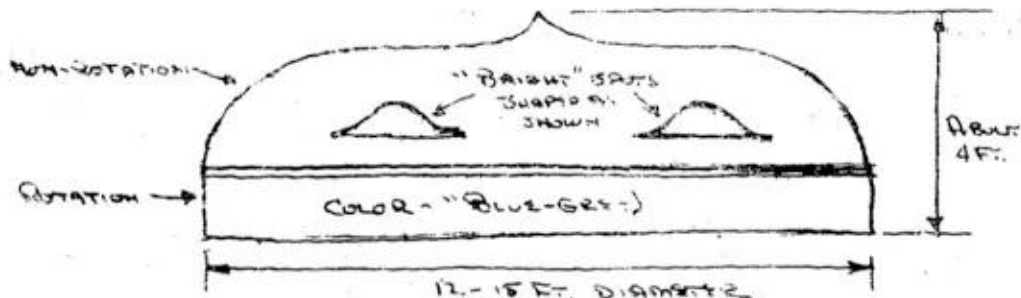


The following sketch represents what he described. I draw such a sketch at the time and he confirmed that it was a pretty fair picture of what he saw.
