There is very little attention put into the China Lake NAWS facility. I live here and I can honestly say that a lot happens out here, but none of us like to talk about it. Also, there has been (3) bids by the A.F. to take over the base due to it's overwhelmingly huge airspace not viewable by highway or in parts for several valleys by dirt road. I would again say a trip out here could be worth it during the right times of year...

The best areas to "view" high tech and "unknown" are to the East in the Panamints. The reason for the interest relates to the military's version of the X-33.
