In his new book Wings of Fury, Robert Wilcox describes a successor program to the Have Drill and Have Doughnut programs of Soviet aircraft evaluations at Groom. Called Constant Peg, it looked especially at MiG 23s and in his telling was based at Tonopah beginning mid-Eighties. The group involved was the familiar 4477th TES or Red Eagles. The program was supposedly concluded in 1988. Wilcox, who described earlier MiG programs at Groom in his previous book, does not discuss relationship of Constant Peg to Groom, or suggest that it replaced Groom programs.
