Credibility = Moderate: The book is credible in the sense the locations appear to be accurate and each summary is faithful to its sources. Each ghost story is subject to debate, of course.

Research Value = Very High: For people in search of haunted places in a particular region, this is the best book to start with.

Visual Information = Moderate: Snapshots of buildings, mostly.

Silliness = High: Although the information is faithfully reported here, we are not sure it has any practical value, apart from tourism. Ghosts, it seem, could be anywhere.

This is a state-by-state and city-by-city directory of haunted buildings. Each entry summarizes the claims made at a particular location, along with direction how to get there and bibliographic sources for the information.
