

Born in London in 1942, Timothy Good first became interested in UFOs in 1955, when his passion for aviation and spaceflight led him to read a book by Major Donald Keyhoe detailing sightings by highly qualified observers such as military and civilian pilots. Now regarded as a leading authority, he has researched the subject worldwide, interviewing key witnesses and amassing a wealth of evidence, including several thousand declassified intelligence documents.

Timothy Good has given lectures on UFOs at universities, schools, and to many organizations, including IBM, the Institute of Medical Laboratory Sciences, the Royal Canadian Military Institute, the Royal Naval Air Reserve Branch, Shell, the House of Lords All-Party UFO Study Group, and the Oxford and Cambridge Union Societies. He has acted as associate producer for a number of television documentaries on the subject and is known to millions worldwide through his numerous television appearances.

Timothy Good's first book, [Above Top Secret: The Worldwide UFO Cover-up](#) (1987), became an instant bestseller, and is regarded by many as the definitive book on the subject, together with the fully revised edition which replaces it, [Beyond Top Secret: The Worldwide UFO Security Threat](#) (Macmillan, 1996), which remained for five weeks on the Sunday Times bestseller list. 
