

Credibility = Very High: In general, this category is a rating of the author's intellectual discipline and the strength of his argument (which are very high), not the veracity of his claims (which could be false in spite of the strong argument).

Clark records the history of UFO theories, especially the ongoing conflict between the "extraterrestrial hypothesis" -- the claim the UFOs are operated by alien visitors -- and the "occult hypothesis", which supposes that UFOs are manifestations of other dimensions. UFO hypotheses are a human phenomenon: They have little to do with evidence, only psychology, and they evolve with society. This research report chronicles the major UFO theories since the beginning of the UFO phenomenon. With a long list of source materials, this report can be a useful reference for "who believed what when." -- *Glenn Campbell*
