

Abolition 2000: A Global Network to Eliminate Nuclear Weapons is a dynamic international citizen's movement that calls for conclusion by the year 2000 of negotiations on a treaty to eliminate nuclear weapons within a time-bound framework. In April 1995, during the first weeks of the Non-Proliferation Treaty Review and Extension Conference, activists from around the world recognized that the issue of nuclear abolition was not on the agenda. Activists representing non-governmental organizations (NGOs) from dozens of countries around the world met together to write the following statement that has become the founding document of the Abolition 2000 Network. Over 1,000 NGOs on six continents have now signed it and are actively working in twelve working groups to accomplish the eleven points listed in the statement."
