>something that doesn't exist?

How many flaws of logic can you find in this message?

>Another thing is why just come out and write a book on this? Why not hire
>an investigator to try and get some evidence....anything that he could get
>from the location of the training center to names of new recruits? Medical
>tests on himself to prove the tampering by aliens? After obtaining
>evidence he could have gone to the news media to present his case.

>Its a good story, but without a shred of evidence or without any knowledge
>of Mr. Sherman's character, I would have to say that I am not a believer.

That's a believer I think we can all do without.

Why does everyone have to be either a "believer" or "disbeliever"?
What's wrong with just being curious?
