1. **Population:** 4130 (March 1994 estimate)
2. **Telephone Book:** 18 pages of listings
3. **Registered Voters:** 2314. (1881 voted on Nov. 8, 1994.)
4. **Land Area:** Bigger than Rhode Island?
5. **Location:** Bordering Utah, about 60 miles north of Las Vegas

  - Pioche. County seat. ZIP: 89043

7. **Unincorporated settlements** (each 100 residents or less): Rachel, Hiko, Richardville, Eagle Valley, Mt. Wilson
8. **History:** Boom and bust since the 1800s, driven mostly by the mining industry.
9. **Industry:** Almost none. Mining has all but died. Ranching limps along. Most residents, if employed, work for the federal, state or county governments, including some who are employed at the secret Area 51 base.
10. **Religion:** Predominantly Mormon (Latter Day Saints)
