All instructions in italics and brackets below should be removed. Information appearing in [brackets] in final page always refers to a source for the information. This can be a link or a text description of the source. Sources are defined in [Internet Character Reporting](#).]

[Ufologist pages consist of two parts: the "Profile" which is the highly structured block of data described below, and "Topics" which is a more free-form section of anything that might relate to this person.]

Profile

[The aim of the profile section is to list basic info about the person in a compact and consistent form. Each item should be limited to one or two lines, with no blank lines between them (unlike in the annotated version below). More in-depth info can be given in "Topics" section at the bottom of the page or in linked documents.]

1. UFO Role:

[Brief summary here of his/her role and specialty in ufology. This summary must be neutral--a statement of fact that both supporters and opponents would agree with. No more than a few sentences.]

2. Editor's Choice:

[This is a quote or a pointer to a document which the page editor believes best captures this subject's personality. This document may be written by the person themselves or may be a direct description of their actions. It may be a repeat of a documents that is listed elsewhere on this page. A link to a rebuttal will be provided upon request.]

3. Upcoming Appearances

[To protect subject's privacy, residential addresses should not be published unless they have been published previously or permission is obtained (or implied) from subject. No permission is needed to publish PO Box addresses, however, since these are assumed to offer adequate protection of privacy. If address may be old, give date when it was last known to be correct.]

[Home phone can be given only by permission of the subject. Fax and business phone can be given if already published.]

[Any alternate contact mode can be listed here (after Newsgroups). Home phone should be given only by permission of the subject. Fax and business phone can be given if already published.]

5. Biography

- **Name:**

[Subject's legal name goes here only if it differs from his commonly known name which appears at top of page. (Field not needed otherwise.) Example: "Bill Cooper" at top of page would be given as "Milton William Cooper" on this line.]

- **Alias:**

[Any other names the subject has gone under, along with description of the circumstances in which that name was used.]

- **Summary:**

[The place to link any biographical summaries from book jackets, conference blurbs, autobiographies, etc.]

- **Born:**

[Year Here. For privacy reasons, no exact dates. Place of birth can be given if known.]

- **Occupation:**

[Subject's current primary occupation or source of income. Usually a one-line description. More info can be given if occupation is relevant to UFO field.]

- **Prior Occupations:**

[List any that are relevant.]

- **Organizations**

[List of UFO or other relevant organizations subject belongs to, along with position.]

- **Education**

- Graduate of XXX College, BA in English. [Self]

[Educational credentials are so often misrepresented that the source must always be given, even if only "Self."]

- **Military Service:** None.

[List "None" only if it is known that subject did not serve. If subject did serve in military, a description of position can be given.]

- **Family:**

[Any significant family connections to other ufologists or public figures. Limited to relevant family information. e.g. fact that subject is married to another prominent ufologist or is son of a famous politician is relevant here, but the names of children is probably not relevant.]

- **No Relation To:**

[An opportunity to list people with similar names or who could be otherwise confused with the subject but who the subject is not connected to.]

- **Photos:**

[Links to portraits of the subject can be given here.]

- **UFO Income:** Apparently negligible. Minor royalty income from book.

[This section provides any available info on how much money the subject is making from the UFO field. Possible options are: None, Negligible, Insufficient to Support Expenses (the money he spends to conduct research exceeds income), Major Portion of Income, Primary Source of Support (the UFO field is how he makes his living). This section can provide any other available information on the subject's income from the UFO field. "UFO" in this case can include all UFO, paranormal and New Age fields. Specify source where possible.]

- **Awards & Distinctions:**

[Any significant awards or historical connections can be listed here. Links to any available resume or biographical summary.]

- **Plans**

[A place to record anything the subject has announced he plans to do. If the plans are never completed, then the original plan can be recorded in the "Reversals" section below, along with what actually happened.]

- **Criminal Record:** He says he has no felony criminal record.

[This section lists all felony convictions for the subject. Each conviction must be substantiated with a reference either to a court record or a newspaper article. Explanation: A person's criminal record can have great bearing on his credibility as a ufologist, especially when the crime involves some allegation of fraud. There is a legitimate question whether crimes not related to fraud should be listed: e.g. sex crimes. We take the position that all felony convictions are a part of a person's permanent public record and should be listed. At least this provides an opportunity to dispel the rumors and say exactly what happened. If the subject or any of their supporters wishes to write an explanation or response to the charges, we will provide a link to that response upon request, as well as a link to any rebuttal by opponents. And we will ALWAYS correct any factual errors in this or any other section if they are brought to our attention.]

[Misdemeanor convictions and arrests not leading to conviction will be listed only if they bear some reasonable connection to one's credibility as a UFO researcher. E.g. fraud arrests may be listed but not misdemeanor sex crimes.]

- **Personal Philosophy:**

[Links to any documents that might describe subject's personal philosophy, apart from UFOs.]

6. Positions

[This is also the place to list **first-hand** witnesses who the subject supports or agrees with. These are listed as "Claims of..." It is sometimes a fine distinction whether a UFO witness (like Billy Meier) belongs in the subject's "Positions" or "Relationships" section (below) or both. In general, "Positions" evaluate the claims and not the witness themselves. The subject need not have met the witness to support or oppose his claims, but he does need to have had personal contact with the witness for a relationship. Only first-hand witnesses can be listed in the Positions section. If the subject disagrees with another ufologist's theories or secondhand reports, this belongs in the relationships section.]

[UFO cases listed here are ones that the subject believes are fakes or erroneous, as evidenced by the subject's articles, statements at conferences or personal conversations. If available, links can be provided or a brief explanation given in italics. This is also the place to list witnesses who the subject dismissed or ufologists whose he disagrees with but has not directly interacted with.]

- **Claims & Opinions**

[This section contains a series of one-sentence summaries of the subject's stated position or opinions, where they cannot be listed adequately in the

Supports/Dismisses section.]

- **Other Interests**

- Investigated Kecksberg incident

[This is a residual category for listing specific topics and cases--not listed under "Supports", "Dismisses" or "Opinions"--that the subject has taken an active public interest in but has apparently not formed an opinion on. This is a neutral list drawn by the public record that the subject themselves would probably agree with. If this is the only category under "Positions" the word "Other" is dropped.]

7. References

[All references are listed by date within each category, with the LATEST FIRST. Items below are broken into three major sub-categories base on the amount of control the subject has over the medium. "Works" are those products that that subject has total control over; he can say anything he wants without challenge. "Interviews" record the subject responding to an uncontrolled interaction; he can say anything he wants, but he might be challenged. "Reports by Others" are reports controlled entirely by a third party, who could be highly critical and selective in presenting subject. Each type of article can be useful in its own way: You want to hear what the subject has to say in isolation, but also what others have to say about him.]

[Due to limitations on sponsor's resources, the listings in this section are not expected to be exhaustive. They are only a sampling, focussing on items that might reflect on the subject's personality or credibility. If subject (or any other party) desires a more exhaustive bibliography, he may provide a URL, and it will be linked here. In that case, the listing on this page would only include residual items and items of contention not found on subject's own page.]

[Commercial Note: Where ordering information for a book or other product is given, the page sponsor reserves the right to link to its own ordering center. (This is part of the advertizing that supports this page.) The same products will also be listed in the advertizing section at the bottom of the page.]

- **Works**

[This section lists articles and presentations made by the subject which he has direct creative control over. Subject fully controls the questions he answers and the subjects he covers. These references generally represent the subject as he chooses to be seen.]

Articles also do not belong here unless they are strictly Q&A.]

8. Events & Exchanges

This is also the place for unpublished investigations of subject's claims, allowing space for rebuttal, and also for the subject's own ongoing investigations. All items in this section must be dated.]

9. Relationships

10. Reversals

[This section reports instances in which the subject declared a public position on a case or issue and then later reversed himself. This might be a UFO case that the initially announced was genuine and the they later regarded as fake, or another ufologist they once supported but have now become estranged from. Important to show consistency and a track record]

 - Current Position: Declared the Roswell film a fake in Nov. 1, 1995 radio show on KSSS-FM, Dallas.
