My copy of 'The Zeta Reticuli Incident' on page 19 lists the above pattern stars, but also lists Zeta Tucanae, Gliese 59, Gliese 86.1, Gliese 95, Kappa Fornax.

Page 9 lists the 46 nearest stars similar to the sun.

The best ever star distance data obtained by the Hipparchos (sp.?) satellite was published within the past year and undoubtedly slightly changes some of the distances in the tables which are derived from the 1969 Gliese Catalog of nearby stars.
