>In 1961 while viewing through binoculars, I, along with three
>other witnesses, saw what appeared to be a "spinning" saucer.
>Closer examination revealed the following phenomenon. Around the
>perimeter of this unknown luminous aerial object (seen at night)
>were a series of (we'll call them pipes) at the end of each was
>a red light (or what passed for same). This light went on and
>off sequentially around the perimeter of the object. Due to
>persistence of vision it looked like the red light was moving
>around the object. I have since read similar descriptions of
>this phenomenon.

In addition, anyone interested in whether or not UFOs actually spin should have a close look at the Moreland case from 1959.

This close observation provides many interesting details in a clearly witnessed, close range observation.

Obviously, these cases still leave room for observations of "spin", but as Richard Haines [Observing UFOS, 1980] pointed out, observation of spin requires a specific reference marking on the surface in question.

In cases like the two cited above, the reason for the apparent "revolving" motion of luminous sources remains unknown, and no correlations with anything other than behavior have been found.
